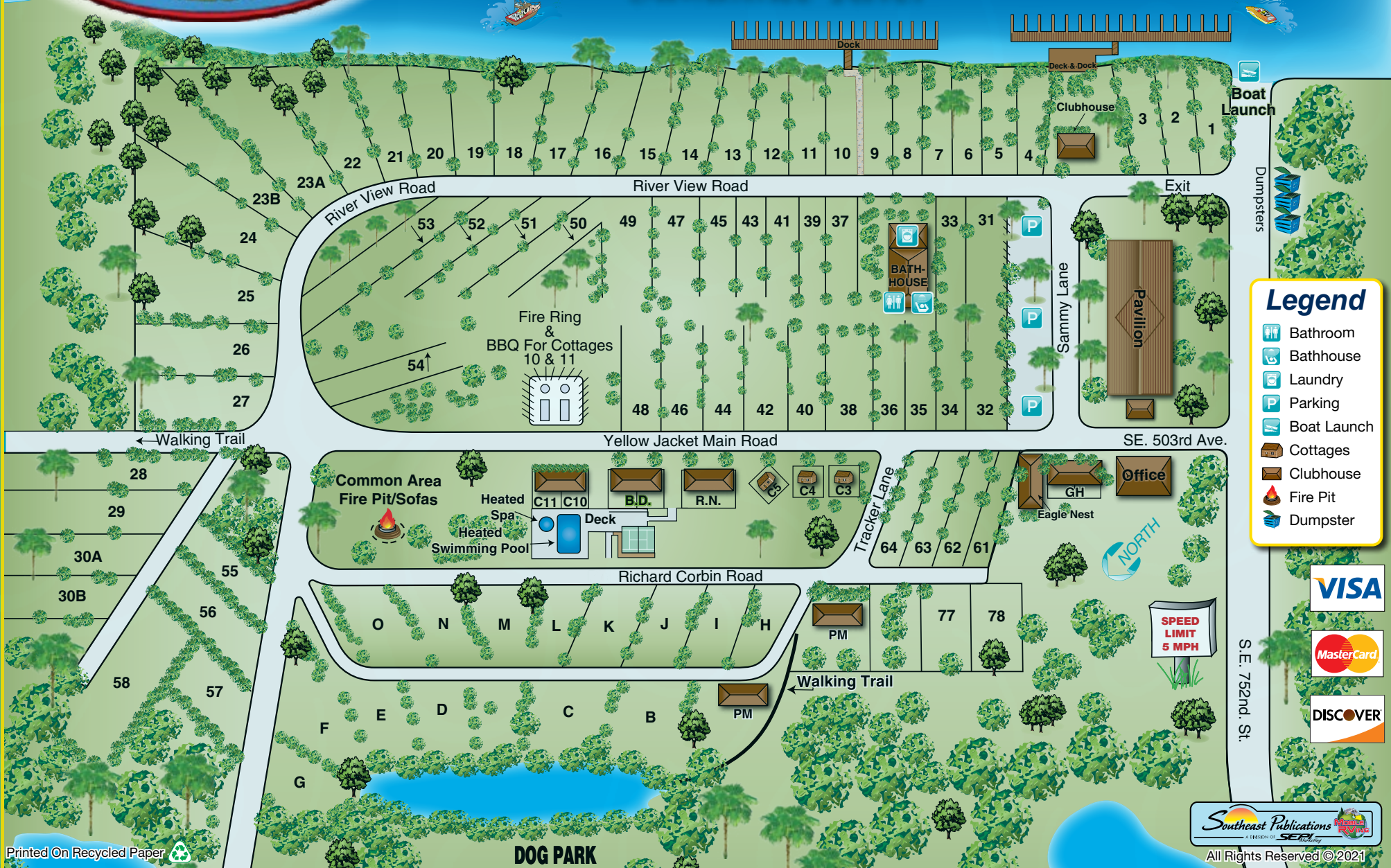

## PLEASE OBSERVE OUR GUIDELINES

### For the Safety and Enjoyment of Everyone!

- CHECK-IN time from 3:00 p.m. **CHECK-OUT time is no later than 11:00 a.m.** Quiet time is 10:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m.
- Park Speed Limit is 5 MPH.
- Only 1 RV and 1 vehicle per site. Parking in designated areas only. No parking on, or use of, vacant sites at any time. Respect the property of neighbors - do not trespass or cut through sites.
- Display Park Pass on your vehicle at all times.
- No ATVs or 4-Wheelers. Registered golf carts are allowed for seniors and handicapped. Licensed drivers only and must have insurance.
- No washing of RVs or vehicles.
- Visitor parking in designated area only. \$7 registration fee per visitor.
- Parents or guardians are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children and will be held liable to pay for damages or acts of vandalism by their children.
- Children must be accompanied by parents or guardians when visiting bathhouses and restrooms. Children under 16 are not allowed in laundry room.
- **Obey all rules in pool area. No diapered children allowed in pool or hot tub. Children under 12 years of age are not allowed in the hot tub. Floaters or any kind usable for sitting or laying on are not allowed in the pool/Hot Tub.** Inflatables of any kind and glass containers are prohibited in pool/spa and inside pool fence. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK IN POOL AND RIVER. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.
- Smoking is prohibited in all buildings and inside pool fence.
- Campfires in fire rings only. Do not move fire rings.
- Firewood quarantine in effect! Do not bring firewood of any kind into Park.
- No firearms or fireworks. Special permits available during hunting season for hunting equipment.
- Pets are allowed at all RV sites and in pet-friendly cottages. Pet owners are fully responsible for the behavior and safety of their pets. Pets are not permitted in tent areas, restrooms, bathrooms, laundry rooms, or in any buildings or inside fenced-in pool area. Cats are not allowed to be loose in the campground.
- Wi-Fi Security Codes are for Park Guests only!
- Guests are responsible for keeping their sites and cottages clean.
- Garbage must be taken to dumpsters by Boat Launch. No littering.
- No mechanical work allowed on RV sites. All RVs must be well maintained. No mold! No tarps!
- We do our best to clean up tree limbs. We are not responsible for damage caused by falling limbs or severe weather conditions.
- Clotheslines are permitted only under your awning.
- RV Park Management assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries or losses from any cause.
- RV Park Management reserves the right to evict anyone for behavior detrimental to the Camp and its guests/visitors.
- Your occupancy is subject to Florida Statutes 513.114, 513.117, 513.121, and 513.13.
