Recreational Activities



Our day use area is a great place for picnics, fishing, swimming, birding or simply relaxing along the shoreline and soaking up some sun. A diver down flag is required for snorkelers.



Kayaks, paddleboards and hikes are great ways to explore the park! Ask staff at the Ranger Station about educational programs and events.

We have a self-serve kiosk near the kayak launch area to rent kayaks.



Enjoy a paddle trip through our mangrove tunnel or paddle around Deer Key to look for wildlife. Paddling info and recommended routes are available at our day use kiosks and at the ranger station. Paddlers are encouraged to use the designated kayak launch area. Only self-propelled vessels may be launched at the park. Kayaks, paddleboards, etc., cannot be left unattended and must be stored on your site.

All vessels must follow U.S. Coast Guard rules for navigation and safety. Most park waters are designated as no-motor zones. Motorized vessels must follow all applicable boating laws, including no-motor zones. Boats may not be beached or tied to trees or other objects within the park. Any boat within park waters, must not be anchored within 100 feet of the shoreline (Administrative Rule 62-D).



Kiteboards may be launched from the beach in the day use area only. Kiteboards must remain in designated areas while in use. Kites must be rolled up while not in use. Contact the ranger station for additional info about designated kiteboard areas and rules.

Camping Information

- Reservations can be made by calling 800-326-3521 (8 a.m. to 8 p.m.) or by visiting our website at Reserve.FloridaStateParks.org
- No more than eight people may occupy a campsite. Each site is limited to two vehicles. All vehicles, campers and boats must fit on your site. The park does not provide an overflow parking area.
- Only one RV/camper/van may be plugged into the electric pedestal per site.
- All campsites are back-in only.
- All plants and animals within the park are protected.
- Please obey traffic laws such as stop signs. Speed limit within the park is 15 mph, 5 mph within the campground.
- Please conserve water and electricity. RVs, vehicles, boats and boat motors may not be washed within the park. Use the bathhouse sink to wash dishes. Small pools, outside showers and outside sinks are prohibited.
- Firewood may be purchased at nearby grocery stores and used in the community fire ring at the west end of the beach. Firewood may not be gathered within the park. Wood fires are not permitted on campsites.
- Pets must be kept on a 6-foot hand-held leash, confined or under the physical control of a person. Tethered pets must not be left unattended for more than 30 minutes. Pet owners must pick up after their pets and properly dispose of all pet droppings in trash receptacles.
- Alcohol is not permitted except in overnight accommodations areas.
- We are a "Campground Host" park. If you are interested in volunteering, please inquire at the ranger station.
- Take nothing but pictures, leave nothing but footprints.
