

CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

REGISTRATION AND GUESTS OF CAMPERS

- Express Check-in is available with full pre-payment.
- All campers and guests must register immediately upon arrival with the office.
- Check-in is 1 PM. Check-out is 12 PM.
- Fees will apply to early check-ins, late check-outs, and extra guests and vehicles.
- There is a limit of 4 persons per site. All others must register as guests. Fees will apply for all extra persons over the age of 4 years.
- Guest passes may be purchased in advance if the camper wishes to pay for their guest. A day pass is \$10.00. An overnight pass is \$15.00.
- There is a limit of 1 RV or tent and 1 tow vehicle per site.
- Your campsite registration card must be placed under the clip on the electrical pedestal of your assigned site.
- All cars, utility trailers, and extra vehicles must be registered and parked in an assigned designated area with a VALID PASS clearly visible in the front window of the vehicle.
- No parking is permitted on the grass unless authorized.
- Any non-registered vehicles will be towed away at owner's expense.
- Park facilities are intended for the use of registered guests only. The use of the restrooms or facilities requires a pass. Fees will apply.
- Parents are responsible for their children. Children must be supervised at all times.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- Reservations made online are prepaid. Cancellations prior to arrival are refundable minus a \$25.00 cancellation fee, unless within 10 days of arrival.
- Cancellations within 10 days of arrival will be charged a one-night stay fee.
- Cancellations or changes must be made by phone or in person. No emails, please.
- All holiday stays are prepaid and are non-refundable.
- No refunds are given to early departures.

ROAD AREA

- The SPEED LIMIT is 5 MPH. Please obey all traffic signs and regulations throughout the park.
- Do not drive on the grass.
- No bicycles shall be ridden after dark, and no off-road vehicles are permitted in the park.
- For your safety and the safety of others, please use your flashlight or lantern when walking through the park after dark.
- Golf carts must be registered with the park office, and you are required to provide proof of insurance.

PETS

- Pets are not allowed in public buildings or on other campers' sites.
- Pets must be on a leash at all times and walked on a leash in designated pet walking area.
- Droppings must be cleaned up and disposed of properly. Dog boxes are located throughout the park. DO NOT put animal waste into the trash containers in restrooms!
- No leashes shall be fastened to trees, shrubs, water hydrants, etc.
- Pets must be kept quiet and not left unattended. Pets are not permitted to dig holes.
- Our neighboring farm animals may have restricted diets, so please do not feed them.

SEVERE WEATHER INFORMATION

Shipshewana is located in LaGrange County Indiana (see map). Local TV weather information is available on channel 22-3 WSBT. NOAA weather radio channels are 162.425, 162.550 and 162.400 or local FM 105.5. Always put your awning up when leaving. Bathhouses are unlocked and open 24 hours a day.

If you are outdoors:

If possible, get inside a building. If shelter is not available or there is no time to get indoors, lie in a ditch or low-lying area, or crouch near a strong building. Be aware of the potential for flooding. Use arms to protect head and neck.

If you are in a vehicle, camper, tent or RV:

Never try to outride a tornado in a car or truck or RV. Tornadoes can change direction quickly and can lift up a vehicle and toss it through the air. Get out of the vehicle, tent or RV immediately and take shelter in a nearby building. If there is no time to get indoors, lie in a ditch or low-lying area away from any vehicle, or crouch near a strong building. Be aware of the potential for flooding.

SITES

- Use care when pulling onto your site; watch your turning radius when entering and leaving your site. The weight of your mobile unit and tow vehicle will cause damage to park property if you are not centered on the hard surface of your campsite.
- Quiet hours are from 10 PM to 7 AM. Keep your radio, TV and stereo volume low, so fellow campers are not disturbed.
- According to the Indiana Board of Health regulations, the dumping of any waste waters onto the ground is not permitted. Use the dump station.
- Do not move picnic tables from campsite.
- Trash shall be tied in plastic bags and disposed of only in the trash dumpster by the office.
- The use of your own ABOVE GROUND fire ring is allowed if placed on your pad so the grass is not burned. All fires must be extinguished when unattended. All ashes are to be placed in the community fire pit. You will be charged for any damage to park property.
- Fires are allowed at the community fire pit. All fires must be extinguished when unattended. DO NOT burn a large fire. Any misuse may result in park expulsion.
- Wood must be purchased at the office. No outside firewood is permitted.
- Smoking is prohibited in all public areas.
- No washing of cars, trucks, campers or RVs on your site. No RV detailing or outside vendors without prior permission.
- The use of private Wi-Fi and/or mobile Wi-Fi systems (Mi-Fi) is permitted in the park as long as your system is set to channel 11 and encrypted so as not to interfere with the park system.
- Restrooms are for personal hygiene only. No dish washing or laundry washing will be permitted. Please leave restroom neat and clean.
- Drug use or public intoxication is not permitted. Alcoholic beverages shall be used only at your campsite. No drinking is permitted in the public buildings.
- All weapons are strictly prohibited, including but not limited to firearms, BB guns, bows & arrows, etc.
- No fireworks are permitted.
- The use of chainsaws is prohibited. No trenching or digging is permitted.
- Abuse of or damage to trees, wildlife, domestic animals, farm animals, campsites or any other campground property will be cause for eviction. Damages will be charged.

RULE ENFORCEMENT

- Any violation of the rules should be reported to the Camp office immediately.
- Violation of camp rules and regulations will be grounds for eviction from the park without a refund. You will be charged for any damages to park property.
- Park personnel have the right to refuse service or expel anyone for violation of any park policies or state and local laws and ordinance.

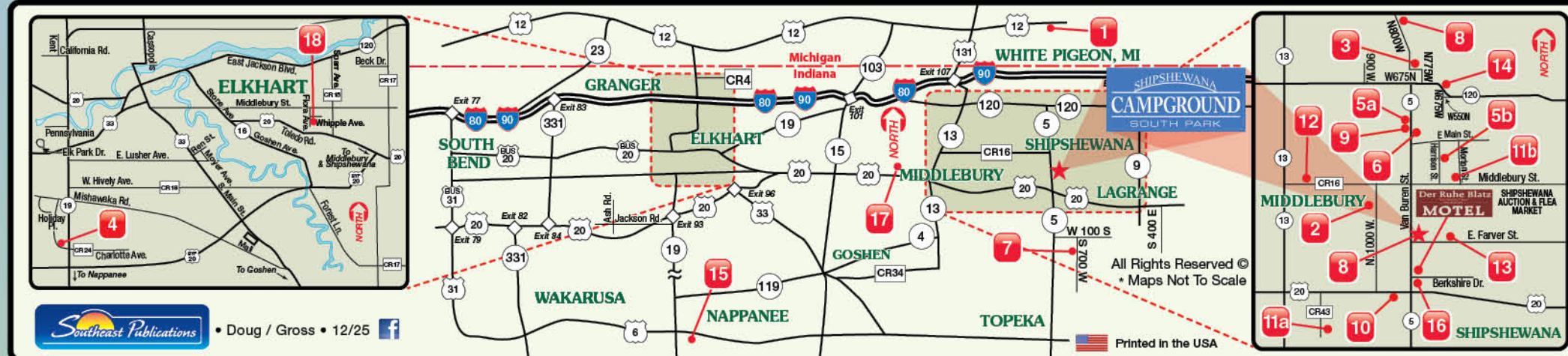
