GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

Please review the following guidelines with members of your party so that everyone has a safe and fun stay at our campground.

CHECK-OUT IS 11:00 AM. All campers must leave the park at that time. Anyone remaining on site after check-out will be charged an extra night's stay. Late check-out MAY be available upon request at additional cost.

RV CHECK-IN IS 1:00 PM.

CABINS CHECK-IN 3:00 PM.

CAMP STORE AND OFFICE: Camp store and office open daily for ice, coffee, groceries, camping supplies, gifts, RV supplies, firewood.

Our guests may have visitors between 9 AM and 10 PM. Visitors must register upon arrival. Unregistered visitors will be asked to leave and the guest's account will be charged the visitor fee regardless. All visitors must have a parking pass and a wristband, as applicable.

Two tents maximum on any tent site, if space allows.

10 MPH SPEED LIMIT throughout the park. Please watch for bikes and pedestrians.

QUIET HOURS 10 PM - 8 AM. Please be considerate of your neighbors at all times by avoiding loud music, bright lights, and walking through occupied sites. All game areas, swimming pools, and playgrounds are closed.

SWIMMING POOL (seasonal). Registered guests only. Swimwear is required. No cutoffs, boxers, bras, etc. allowed. Children in diapers must be wearing swim diapers—no exceptions. Children under 16 years MUST be accompanied by an adult at ALL times. No lifeguard on duty - use of pool is at your own risk! Follow all posted rules at pool. Do not bring glassware or pets into the pool area.

CHILDREN: Adults are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. All children must be at their campsite by dark unless accompanied by an adult.

PETS: No aggressive breeds or mixes allowed. Management has the final decision on whether a dog is allowed. Dogs of any breed that are hostile or aggressive will be asked to leave the campground, along with their owners, without refund. Dogs must be kept on leashes no longer than 6 feet when outside their owners' vehicles or rental units. Do not leave a tethered dog unattended. If your pet is too vocal, you'll need to find other accommodations. Cameras are in use throughout the park. There will be a \$10 cleaning fee charged to your site without notice for each time our staff has to pick up after your pet. No pets in the playground area or swimming pool area.

ELECTRIC VEHICLES: Charging electric vehicles (EVs) at our pedestals is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED.** Doing so has the potential to damage our electrical infrastructure, your vehicle, or both. We respectfully ask that you refrain from plugging in. Violators will be directed to immediately unplug their vehicle, are subject to any damages, and/or will be evicted without refund.

NOISE: No generators. No loud music.

NO SMOKING: Thank you for not smoking in restrooms, buildings, cabins, pool, or playground and game areas.

PLEASE use only RV toilet tissue and do not place any other wipes or feminine products in your toilet or ours.

CAMPFIRES are permitted in fire rings only and must be attended at all times. No high blazing fires. Wood must fit inside of fire ring. All fires must be fully extinguished by midnight. Please note: to prevent spread of invasive species, only locally, commercially bundled firewood is allowed to be brought into the campground. Bundles of firewood are available in the KOA store. **NO GATHERING** of sticks or wood from the property. We offer free delivery to your site.

Flower picking is prohibited. Please do not walk or climb in the flower beds.

WE LOVE OUR TREES. Help us protect them by not cutting any branches, limbs, or bark from any tree in the park. Driving nails into, cutting, chopping, or bark peeling of trees or branches (whether the tree is alive or dead, as long as it is standing) is not allowed in any of our woods.

GOLF CARTS must be parked on your campsite by 10:00 PM. Operation of a golf cart or vehicle is restricted to licensed drivers only.

NO FIREWORKS in park.

TRASH: Fire pits are not trash cans or ash trays! Littering fine of \$25 will be charged to your site without notice. Place garbage in plastic bags, tighten securely, and leave at the end of your site for pick-up between sunrise and 5:00 PM. Place in dumpsters after 5:00 PM, located toward the back of the park. Do not put out after 5 PM.

PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE ATVs or dirt bikes in the park.

RV/VEHICLE WASHING is permitted with a charge for water usage and an approved hose that turns off at the nozzle. See office first.

FREEZE WARNINGS: If the temperature drops below freezing, water must be turned off AND the hose disconnected at the spigot. Any damage to the water line from your failure to disconnect a hose during a freeze will be charged \$250.00 for replacing the hydrant.

Dumping of sewage, gray water, or garbage on the ground, or in a fire ring is not permitted. A dump station is available free to guests.

Report any accidents and any problems with site or utilities to the office immediately.

Management reserves the right to refuse service to and/or remove, at our discretion and without refund, any person(s) whose conduct is objectionable or violates campground rules or applicable laws.

Campground staff are the final arbiters of these rules and their decisions are final.
