**RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

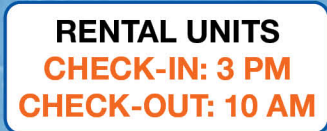
- Registration:** All campers, visitors, & guests must register at the office. All visitors/guests must check-in at the office before proceeding to their appropriate sites. No visitors will be allowed through the gates after 9 p.m. **Any visitors staying later than 9 p.m. must be checked in as an overnight guest with fees paid.** The registered camper assumes all responsibility for their visitors and guests. **Maximum occupancy on any site is 6 people (4 adults, 2 kids), 2 vehicles, & 2 dogs.** Exceeding maximum occupancy will require the reservation of an additional site.
- Check-In Time:** Check-in is between 1 p.m.-9 p.m. Out of courtesy of other campers will not allow check-ins after 9 p.m. Please make your travel plans accordingly. **Check-in time for rental trailers is between 3 p.m.-9 p.m.**
- Check-Out Time:** Check-out is 12 noon. Check-out for rental trailers are 10 a.m. Anyone checking out after the designated check-out time will be subjected to a late check-out fee.
- Gate Keys:** After hours park entry will require a gate key. Gate keys are issued to, and for the use of, **registered campers only.** They are not intended to let visitors/guests into the park. Any violation of this rule may result in the immediate eviction of the camper and his/her party. There will be a fee of \$20 if the gate key is not returned upon check-out.
- Campfires:** Fire rings are to be used for cooking fires only, and must be contained within. **No bonfires allowed!** Fire rings must be kept on your designated site only. Only dry firewood or charcoal may be used for burning. No brush, leaves, limbs, artificial logs, etc. may be burned at any time. No construction material may be burned. Areas around the fire ring must be kept clear of dead vegetation and camping equipment at all times. Due to the spread of invasive insects, **ABSOLUTELY NO OUTSIDE FIREWOOD MAY BE BROUGHT INTO OUR CAMP!** Firewood is available at the camp store. Management reserves the right to prohibit fires at any time. Only persons 18 years or older may have a fire. **Fires must be attended at all times, and all fires must be put out with water by 11 p.m.**
- Sites:** Sites must be kept clean at all times. No trash may be left outside at any time. Please make sure all hookups (water, electric, and sewer) are properly connected and functioning correctly. Please alert management if any utility needs attention and we will be happy to help. **Please, no clotheslines or hammocks may be attached to our trees.** Free standing clotheslines and hammocks will be allowed on your designated site only. **ABSOLUTELY NO NAILS, SCREWS, ETC. MAY BE USED IN OUR TREES!**
- Quiet Hours:** 10 p.m.-8 a.m. **No generators are allowed at any time.**
- Children:** Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behavior of their children. Climbing trees, playing around bathhouse, or playing in parking lot is not allowed. Riding bicycles without headlights after sunset is not permitted. Bicycles may only be used on the roads, and no jumps/skidding please. Bicycle helmets are required by law for any child 16 years of age or younger. The playground closes at dusk. Children must be at their campsites during quiet hours.
- Trash/Recycling:** We recycle all clean plastic, glass, paper, cardboard, and aluminum. Please separate household trash from recyclable material and place in their proper dumpsters next to restrooms.
- Bathhouses:** Please utilize the restrooms in the main building during cleaning hours. **Please use outside sinks, not restroom sinks, for dishwashing.**
- Fish Cleaning:** Please use our Fish Cleaning Station for cleaning fish. **All fish carcasses must be sealed in trash bags before being placed in the dumpster!**
- Speed Limit: 5 MPH.** Main loop (Bayside and Oceanside Drives) is one way, in a clockwise direction. Atlantic Ave. is a 2 way street. All other roads are one way from Bayside Drive to Oceanside Drive.
- Pets:** Well behaved pets are allowed, but must be pre-approved with reservation. Current rabies certificate is required at registration. Dogs must be leashed, contained, & under control at all times. Dogs must not be left unattended, even in your RV. Excessive barking will not be tolerated. Dog waste must be picked up and disposed of properly, in a receptacle, this includes the dog walk area and dog park. If these rules are not followed, or if the dog is a nuisance to other campers, you will be required to board your dog at a kennel for the remainder of your stay or leave the campground. **NO PETS IN THE RENTAL UNITS. VISITOR'S PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED.** The Dog Park hours of operation are 8 a.m. till dusk.
- PROFANE LANGUAGE, EXCESSIVE NOISE, OR SPEED IS NOT ALLOWED.** Any disorderly conduct, illegal activity, underage drinking, use and/or possession of any illegal substances will result in the immediate eviction of the camper and his/her party.
- NO REFUNDS/CREDITS FOR EARLY DEPARTURES, for any reason.**
- LIABILITY DISCLAIMER:** This property is privately owned and the management reserves the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason. Shady Knoll and Atlantic Oaks Campgrounds reserve the right to evict any person or party it deems necessary, based on violations of Park rules, or behavior management deems inappropriate or disturbing to others. Guests are responsible for their own safety; please abide by the rules and regulations and observe the posted speed limit of 5 MPH. Shady Knoll and Atlantic Oaks make every reasonable effort to provide a secure environment, but the security of my person, my belongings, and all persons registered in my party is my sole responsibility, and I agree to hold Shady Knoll and Atlantic Oaks harmless in any and all claims arising from any incidents that may occur during my stay.
