Park Model & Cabin Rental Policy

- **There is no smoking allowed in cabins, park models or RV rentals.**
- **Pets are welcome to join you in the Maine, New Hampshire, New York, New Jersey, Campah and Mass Cabins only.**
- **Pets may not be left unattended in cabins unless crated.**
- **No cooking of any kind inside the units without full kitchens.**
- Please turn off the A/C when checking out.

Please be sure to take your food and drinks out of the fridge upon departure. Garbage can be disposed of in any of the dumpsters, see your site map for 3 locations. Please drop off the key at the office upon leaving.

Pet Rules

All pets must be on a leash at all times, no exceptions. Please clean up after your pet and throw waste in the dumpsters only. Do not leave droppings on your site, in the campground or on the side of the road outside of the campground. We are animal friendly, but barking dogs will not be tolerated and may not be left unattended at your site. **Maximum leash length is 6'.** No Extend-a-Leashes allowed, please!

Nightly Rules & Regulations

- **Check-out time is 11 a.m.** If a unit is left on site after this time without prior authorization, you risk additional charges and/or having your unit towed.
- Quiet time is from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. and is **strictly enforced!**
- Parents are responsible for their children/guests at all times.
- No washing of your vehicles or unit on site.
- All trash must be placed in a dumpster before you leave. See your site map for three locations.
- All wastewater from camping units must be contained according to State regulations and cannot be dumped on the ground.
- All fires must be contained in the fire ring and kept at a low level and supervised at all times. All fires must be completely extinguished before leaving your site or retiring for the night. Please do not move the fire ring. Damage done to the lawns by moving a fire ring will be your responsibility.
- Rates include a maximum of 4 people per site. Additional charges apply beyond 4.
- Only one vehicle is allowed per site, if you have additional, please park in the office lot.
- **The speed limit in the park is 5 MPH and is strictly enforced!**
- **NO motorcycles may be operated in the campground from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. - no exceptions!**
- **Pool Hours as posted and all children MUST have adult supervision at all times. No lifeguard on duty - swim at own risk. Positively no diving is allowed.**
- There is a game area in the hall with puzzles, board games, cable TV, VCR, DVD player, pool table and foosball. Basketball, horseshoes and other games are available at the office for your use.
- Only one camping unit per site. No tents may be erected on a site with another unit.
- Use of washer/dryers in your unit is prohibited. A laundromat is available in the service building.
- Any damage done to trees, tables, fireplaces, lawn or other campground property by you, a family member or one of your guests is your sole responsibility.
- **Any violations of the above rules shall be grounds for expulsion from the park without a refund.**
- Please respect your neighbors and do not cut through their lot. Please use roadway.
- If you are on a paved site, please use boards under your leveling systems. Boards are provided at your post.
- **No bicycles at night without proper front and rear lighting. All children under 16 must wear helmets at all times under Maine Law. Helmets must also be worn for scooters with NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Our goal is to maintain a safe, clean, **quiet** and relaxing campground. Only plastic water bottles are allowed in the pool area, and no inflatables are allowed in the pool. **ONLY ADULTS OVER 21 ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL BETWEEN 4P.M. AND 6P.M.** We hope you enjoy your stay with us. If you have any problems whatsoever, please notify the office immediately. If a problem arises after hours, please contact us at the manager's residence, 207-204-0654. For all medical or police emergencies call 911. These rules are made for your comfort and protection as well as your neighbors. If we can be of any service whatsoever - if you need reservations for dinner, directions, suggestions for things to do or see, please do not hesitate to ask! We are here to serve you!
