### **Campground Policies**

Check-in time is after 1:00 PM Check-out time is by 11:00 AM.

Speed limit on the grounds is 5 MPH.

**Rates** are based on 2 adults, 2 children, 2 pets. Additional people may be added for a fee with a max of 4 adults or 6 people on the site.

**Refunds** are only given in the case of a reservation being cancelled 2 weeks prior to incoming date.

Site occupancy is limited to 1 camper and 1 tent or 2 tents.

**Site appearance:** all trash should be brought to the dumpster, no tarps unless raining, no clotheslines.

Laundry is located in the back bathhouse. \$1.75 to wash, \$1.75 to dry.

**Vices:** Please discard cigarette butts properly. Alcohol must be kept on the campsite. Marijuana must be kept inside the camper or tent.

**Wastewater** is not permitted on the ground. Full hook-up sites should connect to septic. All other sites should transport wastewater to the dumping station. Honey wagon service is available on Mondays and Fridays for a fee.

Pool rules are posted at the pool.

**Pets** are limited to 2 per site with **NO** aggressive dogs and **NO** visitor pets. Dogs should be up to date on rabies vaccination, leashed, cleaned up after, and barking should be kept to a minimum. Cats must be kept inside.

**All Visitors** must register with the office, pay visitor fees, and obtain a visitor pass. Visitors must leave their pets home and leave the grounds by 10:00 PM.

**Campfires** must be attended. Firewood is sold at the office. No cutting of trees, use of chain saws or power saws, or dismantling of pallets to burn.

Quiet time begins at 10:00 PM.

**Children** under the age of 5 should be under parental supervision at all times. All children should be back to their sites by dark unless accompanied by a parent.

**Camp at your own risk.** The management assumes no responsibility for property loss or damages.

Non-compliant guests may be asked to leave without refund.
