Port Huron Known as the "Maritime Capital of the Great Lakes," Port Huron embraces its waterfront location at the bottom of Lake Huron and on the St. Clair and Black rivers. The historic downtown district is home to numerous waterfront and unique outdoor dining experiences, antique and boutique-style shopping, museums and art galleries.

Highlights of a trip to Port Huron include:

Marysville The waterfront City of Marysville rests on the banks of the St. Clair River. This family-oriented town is abundant in commerce as well as recreation. Its dynamic city park includes events, a fantastic splash pad, picnic areas, pavilions, playgrounds, 6 baseball diamonds and fitness area. Chrysler Beach is a refreshing place to go on a hot afternoon and the gazebo is a prime location for freighter watching. A boardwalk winds through a menagerie of plants native to Michigan, part of the "Bridge to Bay" bike path perfect for biking, strolling or fishing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- SPEED LIMIT:** Our speed limit is **5 MILES PER HOUR**. This is for your safety and is radar enforced.
- CHECK-OUT TIME:** Site check-out time is 1pm and Cabin/Lodge check-out time is **11am**.
- QUIET HOURS:** All noise is to be kept at a minimum after 11pm. No golf carts after 11pm or without lights after dark.
- MESSAGES:** Messages will be placed in your registration rack. Only emergency messages will be delivered to your site.
- PETS:** Pets must be kept on a leash. There is a \$10 per day fee for pets to stay in Cabins/Lodges. **Pets are not allowed in playgrounds or any buildings, except approved service animals.** Pets are to leave the Campground with the owner. **OWNERS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR PET:** Barking and yelping dogs are not allowed.
- CAMPFIRES:** All fires must be contained within the fire rings. **FIRE RINGS ARE NOT TO BE MOVED.** Fires must be attended at all times. No grills of any nature to be used on the tables. No burning trash.
- FIREWOOD:** The cutting of any tree or bush will be treated as a criminal act. Firewood is available for purchase in the Front Store, Ice Cream Parlor or Western Store. No outside firewood.
- SWIMMING POOL:** Rules are posted at pool entrance and within pool area. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.**
- TRASH PICK-UP:** Please place trash at your site marker. Trash pick-up will take place throughout the day.
- RECREATIONAL VEHICLES:** Motorized vehicles or transportation devices are not allowed within the campground unless licensed for operation upon the state's roadways. Personal two-seat electric golf carts must be approved and permitted by the campground. All transportation devices must be operated only by licensed operators.
- CARS: ONE VEHICLE ON SITE MAXIMUM.**
- SITE CHANGES:** Site changes are not permitted without first obtaining approval at office. Only one unit per site; check office for exceptions.
- Please respect other campers and their site by not walking or traveling through their site.
- All reservations require a deposit, including groups.**
- The Public consumption, smoking, or use of marijuana, or any narcotics is specifically prohibited upon these premises of Port Huron KOA Resort/Sawmill City. Complete statement is available in office.
- No profanity.
- Noise/music must be kept at a decibel level of 60dB or below.
- Music must be family appropriate.
- The overall operating height of people operating transportation devices operated upon campground roadways shall not be less than 48". A flag pole may be used to attain the 48" requirement.

We have made every effort to provide our guests with a safe and enjoyable campground. However, all persons entering the campground do so at their own risk. Neither the owner of the campground nor its management assume any responsibility for damage, injury or loss, to either person or property. Parents are responsible for any damage or acts of vandalism committed by their children. **Children under 18 MUST BE AT THEIR SITE by 11pm.**

The ownership and the management reserve the right to refuse entry to any person who has evidence a disregard for the rules and reserved the right of dismissal from the campground for any violation or disregard of the rules. **No refund or transfers after one hour past check-in time.**

VISITORS/VISITING HOURS: Visiting hours are from 10am to 11pm (eight persons per site maximum - guests and campers). Visitors must park behind tan/blue building. An entry fee per person will be charged to all visitors. No visitor check-in after 9:30pm.
