GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

OUR RULES ARE FEW BUT IMPORTANT TO YOU, TO YOUR CAMPING NEIGHBORS AND TO US. WE SINCERELY ASK FOR YOUR COOPERATION IN THEIR OBSERVANCE.

CHECK-OUT TIME - 11 AM. Please notify the office by 10 AM if you are staying another day so we may properly place new guests without confusion. Anyone remaining on-site after 11 AM could be charged for an extra day.

BATH CLEANING TIME - Our front bathhouse will be closed from 12 Noon to 2 PM, approximately, for as long as it takes for a thorough cleaning. Back bathhouse, approximate cleaning time from 2 PM to 4 PM.

QUIET HOURS - 11 PM to 7 AM. The St. Ignace/Mackinac Island KOA is a family-oriented campground. 11 PM signals the start of "Quiet Time." We appreciate your cooperation.

CAMP STORE - Discount ferry tickets, ice, groceries, camping supplies, firewood and gifts.

SPEED LIMIT - 7 MPH. Please remember that there are many children in the camp.

GUESTS - Your guests are most welcome, but they must be registered at the office.

CHILDREN - All children must be accompanied by an adult or at their campsite by 10PM or dark whichever is first. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children.

FIREWOOD - Please NO outside firewood. Please do not enter woods to retrieve fallen branches. Firewood can be purchased at the camp store and can be delivered free during office hours.

PETS - Pets are welcome, but they must be kept on a leash at all times. They must be walked in areas away from your site, as well as other sites. Droppings must be cleaned up at once and put in trash bag. **BARKING MUST BE CONTROLLED.**

SEAGULLS - Please DO NOT FEED the seagulls as their droppings may damage your cars and camping equipment.

GARBAGE - Put your garbage in a plastic bag. Drop the bag in the dumpster west of the main building or next to the back bathhouse. No on site pickup.

TREES - Please DO NOT cut standing trees or debark birch trees. The beauty of the campground is due in part to the thoughtful campers who stay here.

VEHICLE WASHING - Please do not wash RVs or cars on site.

DISCOUNT FERRY TICKETS & FREE SHUTTLE TO FERRY: Come to the office.

PLEASE NOTIFY US IF YOU OBSERVE ANY TREE CUTTING OR DEFACING OF PARK FACILITIES. WE PROMISE FIRM, IMMEDIATE ACTION.
