

Campground Rules

- **ALL VEHICLES: PLEASE STOP AND REGISTER AT THE OFFICE.**
- **SPEED LIMIT:** 5 mph throughout the park. **Be alert for children.**
- **CHECK IN: 2 p.m. CHECK OUT: 12 noon. LATE CHECK OUT:** Stay until 4 p.m. for an additional fee as long as your site is available. Please check with office. After 4 p.m. would be charged the nightly fee.
- **SITE USE:** The site fee is for 2 adults and their children OR 4 adults. Extra people will be charged a per day fee. Children under 2 are free. One RV or tent per site. A second tent may be used for a \$10 fee per day. Please do not dump gray or black water on the ground.
- **VEHICLES:** 1 RV and 2 cars allowed on each site. Any other vehicles can be parked in the parking areas provided. Please do not park on other sites. **ATV's** may be ridden in and out of the park only, to and from the trails.
- **VEHICLE WASHING:** No vehicle washing. It's ok to clean the bugs off your RV without using a hose.
- **VISITORS:** Your visitors can come visit you at the park after registering at the office, but there is a fee if they'd like to swim. All visitors must exit the park by quiet hours.
- **POOL USE:** Swim at your own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty. Children 16 and under need to be accompanied by an adult. No glass, no alcohol, no smoking and no pets in the pool area. No food on pool deck. No diapers in the pool (swimmies are ok) **Pool Hours: 10 a.m. – Dusk.** Opens Memorial Day weekend til just after Labor Day. Pool will be closed during inclement weather.
- **QUIET HOURS:** 10 p.m. – 8 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. 11 p.m. - 8 a.m. on Fridays, Saturdays, and Holidays.
- **CHILDREN:** should be back at campsites by 10:00 p.m. please. No bike riding after dark.
- **STORE HOURS:** See store door for exact hours. Generally 9 a.m. - 9 p.m. M-S.
- **RESTROOMS:** Closed for cleaning 12:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m. daily.
- **LAUNDRY: Laundry hours: 9 a.m. - 8 p.m.** Located in the back of the building near the pool. Book exchange, dining guide, games and magazines located here.
- **INTERNET:** Wi-Fi, Summer Breeze Campsite, no password is required.
- **PETS:** Please keep your pets on a 6' leash at all times. There is a \$25 fine if SBC staff has to clean up after them. Do not leave them outside at night or unattended and please don't let them wander into other campsites. Do not tie dogs to trees.
- **SMOKING:** No smoking in any of the buildings or the pool area. No cannabis/Marijuana consumption (smoking/vaping) on SBC property. Any violation will result in immediate departure with NO REFUND and no future camping privileges. Obnoxious odors and smells are at the discretion of SBC staff.
- **CAMPFIRES: The campfire pits are for burning FIREWOOD ONLY!** There is firewood for sale at the office. **Please don't move firepits** without permission. No relocation of fire pits! Relocation will result in a \$100 fine for lot restoration by SBC staff. Do not leave your campfire unattended. If your fire ring is filled with ashes, let us know and we will clean it out for you. Please make sure your fire is out prior to your departure.
- **GARBAGE:** Please use the dumpster for all trash and garbage. It is located at the dump station. **Please don't burn garbage.**
- **TREES AND VEGETATION:** Please do not cut down trees or dig up plants. Let the office know if branches are in your way and we will assess/trim them.
- **FIREWORKS:** No fireworks allowed in the park. Sparklers are ok.
- **ALCOHOL:** Alcohol is permitted but please act responsibly! Anyone acting in a drunken or obnoxious manner will be asked to leave the park immediately.
- **REFUNDS:** No refunds for early departure. There will be no refunds for the discomforts of Mother Nature.
- **DEPARTURE:** When leaving the campground, please leave your site clean and make sure your **campfire is out** and your water turned off.
- **CARPETS: Please don't leave your carpets down for more than 3 days, on grass sites. Our goal is to keep sites grassy.**
- **ELECTRIC VEHICLES: CHARGING ELECTRIC VEHICLES AT OUR PEDESTALS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
- **ROPES/CLOTHESLINES:** No ropes or clotheslines in trees please.

Please respect other people's property, sites, campers, and vehicles. Do not cut/walk through sites or remove any property including firewood from other sites. Do not drive through or park on neighboring sites. We reserve the right to refuse service and/or camping privileges to anyone for no reason.
