COURTESY RULES

- Quiet hours are 10:00 pm to 8:00 am.
- Check-in time is 2:00 pm. Check-out time is 11:00 am.
- \$5.00 cancellation fee.
- Late check-outs may be accommodated, based on availability. Please inquire at the office on the morning of departure for availability.
- Failure to check out on time may result in charges. In the event where failure to depart disrupts the arrival of the next guest, the occupying guest can be fined up to \$100.00 as well as the possibility of being towed at the owner's expense.
- Do NOT wash vehicles in the park. If you are found washing, there will be a \$50 charge for excessive water usage.
- All children must be at their designated campsites by 9pm.
- Your reservations are guaranteed, however, your site number is not guaranteed unless you've locked your site.
- No washing of dishes or pans or utensils in the bathrooms.
- There is to be NO cutting of trees or stripping of bark from any tree at any time. Power saws are NOT allowed in the park. If you, or anyone in your party, are found cutting or stripping trees, you will be asked to leave immediately, with forfeiture of any payments made and there may be additional charges to repair/replace any damaged trees.
- We are not responsible for loss or damage of property.
- Carpets that do not allow sun to pass through to the grass may only be used for a maximum of 2 days.
- Pets are welcome, but they must be kept on a 6' leash maximum. Please keep your pets quiet in consideration of your neighbors. You must pick up after your pet and they must ALWAYS be on a leash.

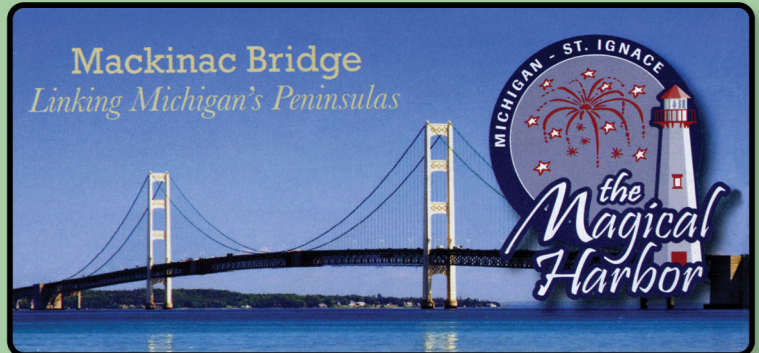
- Open Seasonally May 1 - October 31

MACKINAC BRIDGE

Since 1864, when building a bridge across the straits was first proposed, until November 1, 1957, Mighty Mac was known as the "bridge that couldn't be built." On that day, the U.P. and lower Michigan were permanently tied together. There were more obstacles to overcome and problems solved in designing and building the Mackinac Bridge than any comparable project. Yet it is one of the most beautiful structures ever built and the most beautiful in the U.P. There are 33 foundations resting on bedrock supporting the 4-mile long uninterrupted steel superstructure. The 2 huge tower foundations descend more than 200 feet below the water and were built out on the water using boats, barges and ships handling the men, machinery and materials.
