Dear Camper,

**If we were too busy to give you a warm welcome, please let us offer it to you now.** We hope your stay with us is relaxing and comfortable for you. As you know, government has a big say in what we (and you) are allowed to do. Even if we don't agree with all their rules/ laws and regulations, we will abide by them ... and we have no choice but to expect you to do the same. It may seem like a lot, however, many of the things listed involve "common sense" and "common courtesy." We really appreciate your efforts in following all the rules for a happier camping experience for all. Please treat our Campground as you would have us treat your home. If you are not sure what to do ... just ask us! We will be happy to help you! Thanking you in advance.

## GUIDELINES FOR HAPPY CAMPING

- **DO NOT** leave trash outside so wildlife can tear it up (Although rare, we have had black bears give us visits ... so please be careful not to leave an invitation!)
- **NO** firearms, fireworks (of any kind), explosives or ANY illegal substances allowed for any reason.
- **NO** alcohol consumption by anyone under the age of 21 permitted.
- **EACH RV** must have a sealed sewer connection or use a rubber donut.
- Because of our local noise ordinance, **generator use is prohibited.**
- Due to well water supply issues, **WASHING of ANY vehicle is NOT ALLOWED.**
- **ONLY ONE** RV/camper or tent and **ONE** car **PER SITE.**
- **CAMPFIRES** are only **ALLOWED** in **FIRE RINGS.**
- **QUIET TIME is 10:00 PM.**
- **NO SMOKING** allowed in any campground building.
- **SPEED LIMIT - RIGHT FOOT ON BRAKE** no need to say anything else .. right?!? Thanks!!! 10 MPH speed limit includes e-bikes.
- **Read the "Please remember ... " statement** in the right column.
- **Daily Garbage Pick-up** is between 8:00am to 11:00am.
- **NO** public use of drugs outdoors in public areas as well as campsites.
- **POOL** open noon to 9:00pm daily (weather permitting).

**NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY...** swim at your own risk. **NO** pets or alcoholic beverages, glass containers and/or smoking allowed within pool area. **A parent or legal guardian MUST ACCOMPANY children 14 and younger within the pool area.**

- **Campsites are assigned** so we don't have two campers parked in the same spot. No more than 1 tent or camper per site. **Thank you** for letting us make you comfortable in a site that suits you and your RV best!
- **PETS** are welcomed with a maximum 6 ft leash and an owner. Aggressive dogs of any breed are not welcome at our KOA. All dogs are required to be under the control and visual observation of their owner at all times. All pets (with the exception of Guide Pets) are to stay OUT OF BUILDINGS and SHARED AREAS. Pets do not like to be left alone and will share these feelings with all of your camping neighbors ... who in turn, will share their feelings with us ... then we will have to share them with you! Also keep in mind that NO ONE wants to be remembered for what their pet(s) leave behind... So we "thank you" in advance for cleaning up their acts.
- Only **DNR** approved firewood. Firewood is for sale in the store.
- **No parking is allowed on any grass area. If your vehicles do not fit in the gravel area of your site, please park additional vehicles and guests in the guest parking located behind the store. Tires need to be off the grass.**
- **Please remember...** management has the right to make, adjust or change these rules as it deems fit to operate the campground in the best interest of all concerned. These rules will be enforced and management has the right to evict anyone, without refund, not obeying these and other posted campground rules. Please notify us if you see anything that you think needs our attention. Thank you.

**VISITOR POLICY: ALL VISITORS MUST REGISTER AT THE OFFICE BEFORE GOING TO THEIR SITE.** There is a \$1.00 USD fee per person if the visitor is registered properly. If the KOA management has to remind a visitor to register the fee raises to \$6.00 USD per person. IF A VISITOR DECIDES TO STAY LESS THAN ONE HOUR, WE WILL GLADLY REFUND THE VISITOR FEE PAID. We do limit the number of visitors, so please choose your guests wisely. Some campers are late risers, so please no visitors before 9:00 AM. REMEMBER ... all visitors must leave by 10:00 PM. Thank you!
