Day Trips

West Yellowstone - Is an active tourist town sitting on the west entrance to Yellowstone Park. Attractions are the Discovery Center and National Geographic Theater, giving visitors the educational opportunity to view grizzly bears and wolves up close.

Quake Lake - The Hebgen Lake area was rocked by an earthquake that measured 7.1 on the Richter Scale on August 17, 1959. The effect of the earthquake was the formation of a lake. The earthquake Visitor's Center is located on Hwy. 287 near the lake. There are hiking trails in this area.

Lewis & Clark Caverns - One hour from Bozeman, the caverns offer you a chance to take a guided tour through the underground cave, offering visitors a unique look at nature's underground beauty. The park also offers an info center, fireside programs, a cafe, gift shop, and shaded picnic areas. Park open May 1 to Sept. 30.

Virginia City - Approx. 65 miles from the Campground on Hwy. 287. Virginia City was the original capital of the Montana territory, and it was once a booming gold mining town. History comes alive and your imagination will take over when you visit the restored buildings. Visit Boot Hill, the graves of 5 road agents that were hanged in 1864 by "vigilantes."

Nevada City - Just down the road from Virginia City is a reproduction of the mining camp that had first been there. A section of this town represents some of the many businesses that were once run by the Chinese. Both cities have attractions such as plays by the Virginia City Players and the Mechanical Music Machines. Ride a narrow gauge railroad from Virginia City to Nevada City. Nearby Alder Pond features an old gold dredge and allows

visitors a chance to pan for their own gold.

Three Forks - This area has some of the most colorful early history in Montana. Three Forks was the crossroads of Indian Trails. Learn about the Lewis and Clark Party that camped in the area. Visit the Headwaters State Park and the Heritage Museum in downtown Three Forks for history of the area.

Madison Buffalo Jump - This cliff was one of the larger Indian buffalo jumps used to secure meat on a mass scale before they had horses for hunting. This area has attracted the attention of the nation's foremost archaeologists.

Big Sky Area - Approx. 45 scenic miles from the Campground, Big Sky Area offers a variety of attractions year-round. Several mountain peaks in the area exceed 11,000 feet. Golf on the 18-hole Arnold Palmer designed course or play tennis on two of the courts in the Mountain Village or four courts in the Meadow Village. Also available are guided horseback trail rides, a scenic gondola ride, and hiking and bike trails. Special events take place all summer at Big Sky including the Big Sky Arts Festival.

Yellowstone National Park - The world's first national park contains within its border more than 2 million acres, a variety of natural wonders, wilderness settings and Earth's largest concentration of hydrothermal features including the spectacular Old Faithful. Visitors are treated to the sights of bison, elk, moose, deer, bighorn sheep, antelope, and a myriad of smaller wildlife and birds.

A small pool enjoyed only by a few in the late 1800s has evolved into a destination for area residents and tourists seeking a unique Montana experience.
