GENERAL INFORMATION

Dear Campers,

We welcome you to **Boone KOA Holiday** Campground. We know your stay will be a pleasant one. There is much to see and do in our area. If we can be of help to you, please feel free to stop by the office.

Thank you for staying with us. **The Management**

- No flushable wipes. Flushable wipes do not work with septic systems and are creating clogs. Please do not flush or dump anything other than RV toilet paper.
- Check-out time is 12:00 noon for sites and 11:00 a.m. for cabins/rental units.
- Please respect quiet hours from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. (at all times be considerate of your neighbors and keep noise to a minimum - i.e. your music, etc., should not be heard at their site).
- No motorbikes, go-carts, etc.
- One camping unit per site.
- Please do not build fire rings with rocks. Use the fire pits that are provided.
- One car per campsite. Please park second vehicle in front of mini-golf course.
- No fireworks allowed in park.
- Please no washing of cars or campers.
- Please empty port-a-potties at dump station.
- Please place trash in dumpsters at entrance to park.
- Please do not move picnic tables from sites.
- Please do not leave children under 18 on campground premises without adult supervision. All children must be on their site by 9:00 p.m. or accompanied by an adult. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children.
