Our flat roofed adobe style building was constructed in the late 1940s and was altered many times as a means to attract passersby on historic Route 66. It had teepees on the roof line, a burro wandering in the parking lot, big arrows sticking out of the ground, even a stuffed bear at the door.

In the early 1970s, the property was converted into a campground. The building was used as a backdrop for several mediocre films, and recently our Hudsons and vintage travel trailers were featured in a Route 66 travel video. We are proud of our heritage and honor the past by displaying a collection of memorabilia throughout the property and the building, so enjoy.

While here take advantage of the area and its culture. We have Indian Ceremonials, Spanish Markets, a Balloon Fiesta, even a UFO festival worth seeing. New Mexico is home to 19 Pueblos, 26 scenic byways, 28 vineyards, and cuisine that can't be beat. Within minutes you could be at Old Town, the Aquarium and Botanical Garden, or on a high speed train to Santa Fe.

Our front desk is your key to the area. We can recommend anything from restaurants to churches and give you directions. One more thing... Albuquerque is almost entirely a grid with most streets running North-South or East-West, and the Sandia Mountains are always to the east. *Happy Trails!*

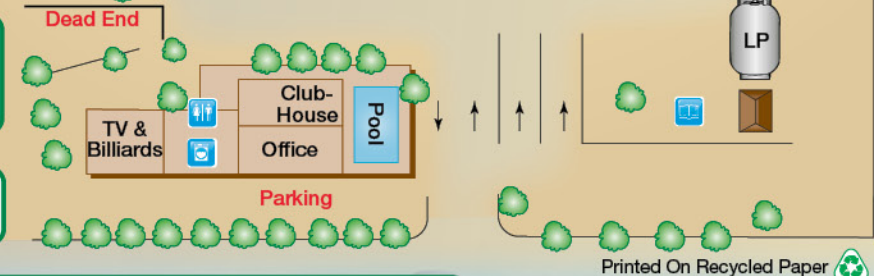
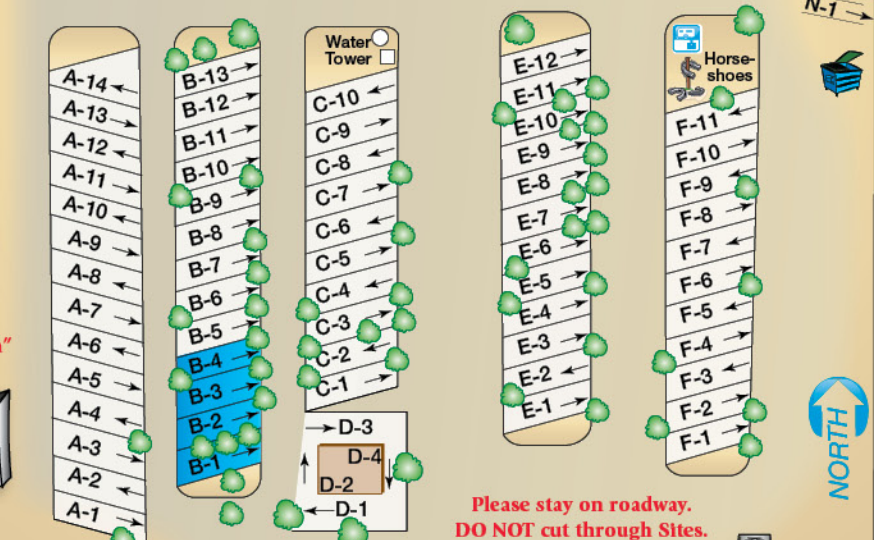
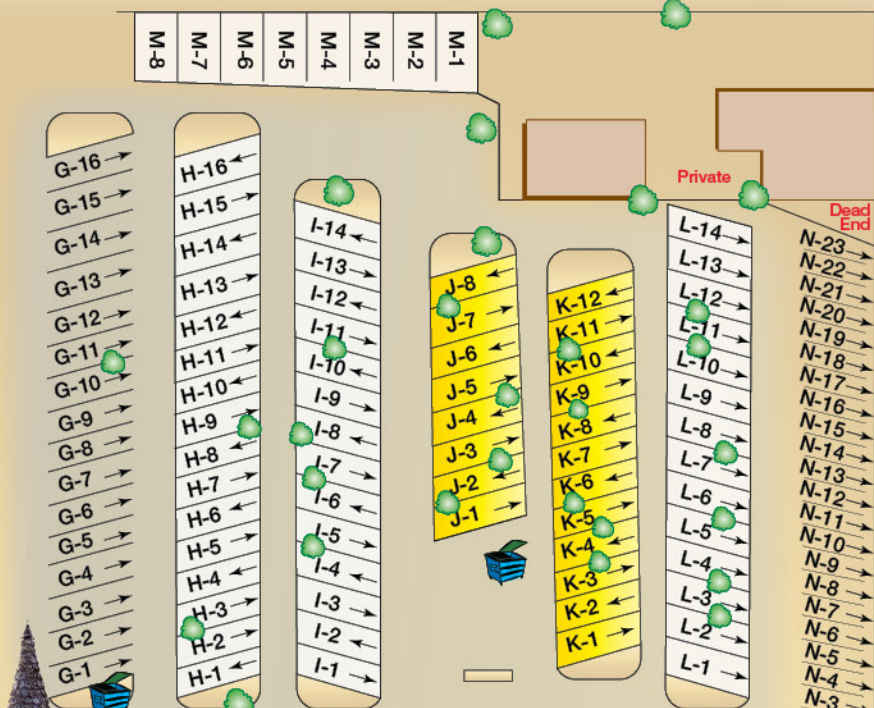
