



Welcome Guests!

During your stay here at Timberline Lake Park Campground we want you to have fun and utilize our facilities. We do have regulations you must abide by though, especially with our beautiful pool! Please take the time to review these rules below. If there are any issues while you are on the pool deck, please let the office know immediately. Thank you! Timberline Campground Management.

Campground Rules

We have established some rules in order that your stay with Timberline Lake Park Campground will be a pleasant one.

- There is no use of water to wash any equipment, vehicle, RV, filling of pools of any size, or to run sprinklers. This rule must be strictly enforced to conserve water as we are on a private well.
- The Speed Limit is 5 MPH. Please keep your speed down for the safety of all residents, including children and pets.
- 3) There is only one camping unit allowed per site. This includes tents (one tent per site). If you have an RV and you want to pitch a tent for the kids (as an example), you must get permission from the office.
- Parking one vehicle per site. If you have more than one vehicle, please inform the office and park one of them in the designated parking areas.
- Site fees are for registered campers only and includes up to four (4) people per site. Every additional person, whether adult or child, is \$5.00 per person per day.
- Restrooms and showers are reserved for registered campers of Timberline Lake Park Campground.
- Please build fires in the fire rings provided at each site and never leave the fire unattended. Please do not move the fire rings to a different area.
- Please keep your campsite clean of debris, garbage, and litter of any kind. Dispose of any remaining garbage prior to checkout.
- 9) Use of alcoholic beverages is restricted to your site.
- Minors must be at their site by 9:00pm. Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult in all areas of the campground. Conduct, behavior and control of children are the parent's responsibility.
- 11) Quiet time all noisy activity (music, revelry, loud voices, etc.) must cease by 10pm. You are welcome to continue to enjoy your campfire conversation after 10pm but it cannot bother other campers.
- RV sites shall be kept neat and clean without an excess of accumulated items visible to other guests.
- 13) Please observe site boundaries.
- 14) Swimming pool users must follow all rules and regulations on the separate swimming pool rules form.
- The dump station is free for all campers that are staying on property. Off the road use of the dump station will incur a fee of \$25.00.

Visitors

Timberline Lake Park Campground campers have the privilege of sharing the campground with their guests under the following conditions:

- Day Guests visiting a camper must report to the office. They will be charged \$5.00 per person or \$8.00 per car, and must leave by 8:00pm, or their host will be charged an additional \$5.00 per person per night.
- 2) All Overnight Guests will be charged \$5.00 per person per night.
- 3) No visitors will be admitted after 8:00pm.
- 4) Any camper or guest that willingly or through negligence defaces or destroys property or equipment of the campground, or that of another camper or guest will be held responsible for full value thereof.

Pets

We appreciate that many people consider their pets as their "children". We kept that in mind in the creating of our pet policy. Aggressive or incessant barking dogs, or any aggressive pets, will not be allowed here at Timberline Lake Park Campground. If your dog or pet meets either of these categories, we will have to ask you to remove the pet from our premises. All pets are to be kept on a leash any time the animal is outside the owner's camper and please clean up after your animals. Pets are prohibited from entering any of the campground buildings or the pool area.

Notifications

- There will be a cancellation charge of 1 nights stay for all confirmed RV, trailer, cabin, cottage, rental RV, or tent reservations. We do not give refunds for early departure or cancellations of Holiday weekend reservations.
- Inform office of visitors, deliveries, requests to alter a site, missing picnic table or fire ring, or any potentially hazardous condition.

Golf Carts

- Proof of insurance must be provided to office management prior to using within the park.
- Operator must be 18 years old or older.
- 3) You must have working headlights to operate after dusk.
- Owner of golf cart is responsible for all persons operating the cart.
- You may not operate the golf cart under the influence of any kind of drugs or alcohol.
- No golf cart racing allowed on the property.

Firearms/Fireworks

No firearms or fireworks are to be discharged in the campground or on camp property.

Trees

Please do not deface, injure, cut, or tie anything to our trees. No clotheslines.

Childrens Safety Policy

Parents will be notified of any unsafe behavior. Bike helmets are required for children 14 years and under. No bike riding through sites or after 8pm. No rollerblades or skateboards allowed. Accompany children to the restroom, playground, jump pad, river, store and pool.

No unsupervised persons 16 and under allowed at any time.

CHECK-OUT TIME FOR CAMPER SITES IS 12 NOON. CHECK-OUT TIME FOR RENTALS IS 11 AM

Rules For The Swimming Pool

- Two or more adults, 18 years of age or older, must be present at the pool when the facility is in use. There must be one adult on the pool deck.
- Children less than 16 years of age, MUST AT ALL TIMES, be accompanied by an adult responsible for their safety and behavior while at the pool deck or bathing facility.
- NO DIVING!! Our pool is less than 8 feet deep and per NYS guidelines, you are not permitted to dive in.
- Telephone is located to the left as you enter the pool deck. This telephone is for emergencies only. Call 911.
- Pollution of the swimming pool is prohibited. Urinating, discharge of fecal matter, expectorating or blowing of the nose is not allowed.
- No glass or sharp objects (jewelry, hair pins, etc.) in the swimming pool or deck area.
- 7) Swimming pool bottom must be visible at all times.
- No suntan oil in the pool.
- 9) No running or jumping in the pool.
- 10) No alcoholic beverages or food of any kind in the pool area.
