GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT

CAMPGROUND posted speed limit is 5 MPH. This is a family campground so please watch for children. Parents are responsible for the behavior and welfare of their children at all times. Parents must supervise children when using any campground facility.

HOURS: Check-out time: 11:00 AM. If you would like to extend your stay, please see the office by 10:00 AM. Late check-out may involve a fee.

Quiet time: 10:00 PM - 7:00 AM. Store, Recreation Room, Laundry: times are posted at the office. Pool/Hot Tub: 9:00 AM - 8:00 PM.

TRASH: is picked up at your site between 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. Please do not leave trash out at night. Dumpsters are located at the entrance/exit to our Campground.

VISITORS: Please have them check in at the office for a pass.

TENTS IN RV SITES: Guests in an RV Site need to check with the Registration Desk to see if their site qualifies for a tent in their site. There is a \$15 fee to add a tent to an RV Site. **No tent stakes!!**

CAMPFIRES: Due to the changing regulations, please check in the office before lighting any fire. Firewood can be purchased at the office and delivered to your site. Campfires are allowed in grills or BBQs only, **do not leave any fire unattended**, and ensure it is completely out before leaving your site or going inside.

PETS: Pets are always welcome but must be leashed and kept under control at all times. Pets must never be left unattended at your site. **Remember to clean up after your pet. Pets are not allowed in buildings, bathrooms, playgrounds, or in pool area.** Owners of dogs showing aggressive behavior will be asked to remove them immediately.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: Ice, firewood and propane are sold at the store. Dishwashing sink (with hot and cold water) is located behind the laundry room. Porta-potties are to be emptied in the dump station. We are on a well system - vehicle washing of any kind is strictly prohibited. Please help conserve water.

RESTROOMS: Open 24 hours for your convenience. Please observe our cleaning schedule. **NO PET WASHING. NO RINSING OF BEACH SAND IN EITHER BUILDING.** Please help keep both areas clean for the next guest. Children under the age of 8 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

WASHROOMS/SHOWERS & LAUNDRY: NO PET WASHING. NO RINSING OF BEACH SAND IN EITHER BUILDING. Please help keep both areas clean for the next guest. We are on a well system, please limit your shower.

INTERNET ACCESS: Wireless internet is available throughout the park, but not guaranteed. Our system allows normal emailing, surfing the web.

POOL/HOT TUB: Registered guests only. Visitors must register. No lifeguard on duty. No running, diving or horseplay. No glass containers, food, or alcohol. Swim attire only. T-shirts, cutoffs, are not allowed. No diaper changing in pool area. All diapers used in pool area must be proper swim diapers. Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult. No pets allowed in pool area.

FLOWERS, TREES, AND BUSHES: Please leave the flowers, mushrooms, and toadstools as some are TOXIC!

SMOKING: No smoking is allowed in any of the buildings, including cabins, the bathrooms, pool area, and laundry room or within 20 feet of any doorway. Please pick up butts. Cannabis on campground property, inside personal RV or tent. Campground has the right to make you leave.

NO FIREWORKS OR FIREARMS OR FOUL LANGUAGE.

GENERATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.

MANAGEMENT reserves the right to evict any person from the campground for failure to abide by Camping Guidelines or for any unlawful acts. NO REFUNDS GIVEN. The owners and management assume no responsibility for accidents, injuries or losses from any cause.
