

PARK RULES

Welcome to our overnight resort. In order to make your stay pleasant and comfortable, the following regulations must be observed:
State Law V.R.S. 31-002 through V.R.S. 31-064.

REGISTRATION: Everyone MUST register at the office before entering Park. Visitors must stop at office for pass.
NO CASH REFUNDS: With proper 48 hour notice a \$10 cancellation fee will be charged. Balance of deposit will be returned to the credit card used. One year redemption.
CHILDREN: Must be kept under control. All children are prohibited from playing around restrooms and facilities. Parents' cooperation with us will make this park a happy and safe place for your children.
VEHICLES: One motor vehicle per space; check with office for extra vehicles. You must park tow vehicle in space-not in street. No washing of cars or RVs in Park.
PETS: There is a 3 pet limit per site and a \$5 charge for each pet. No vicious or aggressive breeds allowed, including Pit Bulls or Rotweillers. All pets must be kept on a leash at all times, must never be left unattended, and owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
QUIET TIME: From 10PM to 7AM. Please refrain from making noise so as not to disturb other guests.
RESTROOMS: Maintained for guest convenience. Lavatories, showers, floors and walls must be left clean after their use. Children of preschool age must be accompanied to the restrooms by an adult. Turn off water after use.

GUEST LAUNDROMAT: We have a maintained laundromat for your convenience. No clotheslines or hanging of laundry at your space.
REFUSE: All refuse or garbage must be wrapped and placed in dumpster; no garbage cans allowed, use dumpster only. Please cooperate in keeping your space neat and sanitary. No burning of garbage in fire pits. Do not put garbage or sanitary napkins in sewer or toilets. Do not drain wastewater on ground (this is the Law). RV site shall remain uncluttered. No storage under rig except patio furniture.
CHECK-OUT TIME: 11AM (strictly enforced). Make sure your water, TV, electrical and sewer connections are unhooked before leaving your assigned space and replace sewer cap. Please leave your space clean.
PROPERTY: Anyone destroying the property or shrubs will be charged the cost of repair or replacement. Please do not climb banks, as it causes severe erosion problems. *The management is not responsible for damage, injury, or loss by accident, theft or fire to either the property or person of any tenant or guest. You enter the park at your own risk. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.*
