



GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

- **Check-In:** 2 PM • **Check-Out:** 11 AM
- Charged 1/2 day rate after 12:00pm. Full day rate after 1:00pm.
- **Quiet time** is 10:00pm to 8:00am.
- **Generators** are not to be operated while in the park.
- **Speed limit** is 5mph.
- Do not leave your children unattended.
- Vehicle washing is not allowed.
- Do not tie clotheslines to trees.
- No pets or smoking are allowed in any buildings on this campground.
- **When pulling into your site, please pull forward of the utilities. We may need to back someone in behind you.**
- **NO FIRE RINGS ALLOWED ON THE GRASS.**
- **Guests** are welcome; however, state law and insurance requires all guests to register at the main office before arriving at your campsite. There is a charge per person, \$8 for adults and \$5 for children.
- Be respectful to the campground.
- Bikes and skateboards are not allowed in the playground, around the main building, or on the grass.
- **No carpets, tarps or mats allowed on the grass.**
- **We reserve the right to evict any person from our campground for failure to abide by park rules or policies, or for violation of laws without refund.**

- **Swimming Pool**
- Open Memorial Day thru Labor Day.
- **Pool Hours:** Hours 9:00am to 8:00pm.
- NO RUNNING, JUMPING, OR DIVING.
- Children age 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult in pool area.
- There is a fee per person/per day for all non-registered (Visitors) guests to use the pool.
- Swimmers must dry off prior to entering restrooms/laundry/store.
- No food/drinks/smoking or pets inside fenced pool area.
- Follow all directions in the pool area.
- **General Campsite Rules**
- One camping unit and one vehicle per site.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 8:00am. Be considerate of your neighbors.
- **Bag garbage and place in dumpster behind office or leave at site prior to 10:00am for staff pickup.**
- Wastewater must be discharged at dump site or in sewer site. No discharge on ground - **it is illegal.** Fines assessed for ground discharging.

- **Pets:** We welcome your pets to our Campground. However, our insurance carrier forbids Pit Bulls, Bull Terriers, Dobermans, American Bulldogs and Rottweilers.
 - Your pet must be on a leash at all times and NOT LEFT OUTSIDE UNATTENDED in accordance with State and County Law.
 - Use designated pet walk areas in the back of the Campground.
 - Clean up after your pet; receptacles are provided in the pet walk area.
 - No pets allowed in any buildings, or inside fenced pool area.
 - Maximum 3 pets allowed per site.
 - K9 Park
- **Restrooms (cleaning hours are 11am - 1pm)**
 - Please do your part to help us maintain the cleanliness of our restrooms.
 - Let the office know if there is a problem that needs attention.

- **Laundry**
 - Open 24 Hours - quarters available at the office.

- Area Attractions**
- Golden Spike National Historic Site** - The spot where the east met the west in 1869. Live reenactments in summer.
 - Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge** - 74,000 acres of prime birding with hundreds of species sighted.
 - Thiokoi Rocket Display** - On display are several of the rocket motors of America's space program.
 - Historic Train Depot Museum** - Built in 1907, this was the largest shipping center for the Union Pacific.
 - Box Elder Tabernacle** - Site chosen by Brigham Young in 1868, this "Mormon Gothic" style building still serves the local population for meetings.
