



Guidelines for an Enjoyable Stay

PLACE TRASH IN TRASH CONTAINERS LOCATED THROUGHOUT CAMPGROUND

GENERAL

1. Reregister by 11:00 a.m. or check-out by noon.
2. Curfew/Quiet Hours: 11:00 p.m.-7:00 a.m. Please be considerate of others. No loud music or loud conversations. If your neighbor can hear your music, it is too loud.
3. Do not move tables or fire rings.
4. **Place trash in containers located throughout the campground. Don't put trash in fire rings.**
5. Dishwashing sink in laundry and outside of upper bathhouse.
6. Do not exceed 5 MPH speed limit or go wrong way on the one-way roads.
7. One unit per site. Do not turn unit backwards or exchange sites. You will be responsible for any damages.
8. Stay with your campfires. Don't leave them unattended at any time.
9. No metal detectors, 4 wheelers, fireworks, weapons of any kind or generators.
10. Please accompany and stay with your children while they are at the bathrooms, hot tubs, pool and playground. Their safety is your responsibility.
11. **Do not chase, throw rocks at, handle, or otherwise disturb the squirrels or rabbits. This is their home.**
12. Do not cut any trees (dead or alive). Trees are to enjoy, not to destroy.
13. **No climbing on the waterfall.**
14. All coolers containing alcohol must remain at your site.
15. **Alcoholic drinks must be covered in koozies or cups. No smoking in any structure, on the mini-golf course or at the swimming pool.**
16. ATM in the office.
17. Honey Wagon - Register at Campground Store before 11:00 a.m.

GOLF CARTS

- **NO GAS GOLF CARTS, SCOOTERS OR UTILITY VEHICLES MAY BE OPERATED IN CAMPGROUND.**
- Electric golf carts must be approved and registered by the office.
- Special use permits available.
- Golf cart drivers must have a valid driver's license.
- **Golf carts must be kept on graveled roads and/or paved roads. No carts on grassy areas.**
- Golf carts must remain on your campsite after 11:00 p.m.
- **No alcoholic beverages, open or closed, allowed on golf carts.**
- No one under the influence of drugs or alcohol allowed on golf carts.
- No texting while driving golf cart.
- CAMPGROUND ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE CAUSED BY, OR TO, GOLF CARTS.
- Rent golf carts at the Campground Store.

FISHING IN OUR 3/4 ACRE LAKE

- Lake is stocked with Rainbow Trout, Largemouth Bass, Carp, Channel Catfish, and Sunfish.
- Trout fishing hours are sunrise to sunset. **Three (3) trout limit per person per day.** You may not carry, handle, or have more than three (3) trout at any time.
- You may not cast a fishing rod after you have reached your limit
- of 3 trout or help anyone else catch their limit.
- Catch & Release fishing must be done with a barbless hook.
- **All fish, other than trout, are Catch & Release.**
- One (1) fishing rod, stringer/creel per person.
- Your fishing rod, creel and fish must be in your possession at all times.

PETS

- Your pet is welcome as part of your family.
- Keep it on a leash no longer than 4 feet at all times.
- Take doggie bags with you while walking and clean up its mess. Do not dispose of in fire rings.
- Never leave your pet unattended.
- Guard dogs are to be kept in your unit at all times.
- Do not allow your pet to disturb other campers or animals.
- **NO PETS ALLOWED AROUND POND, IN PLAYGROUND, SWIMMING AREA OR BUILDINGS.**

VISITORS

- Visitors are welcome. A daily visitor fee is required.
- No visitors admitted after 9 p.m.
- Visitors must register in the office before entering the campground.
- Visitors must park in the "Extra Vehicle Parking" lot.
- **Visitors may not bring pets to the campground.**
- You are responsible for the actions of your visitors while on campground property.

No Glass Containers and No Alcohol
No Food or Drink in Pool
Do Not Put Chairs in Water
No Running or Horseplay
No Smoking
No Diving
Adult Supervision Req'd for Children

HOT TUB

HOURS: Varies by Season
No Food, Drink or Alcohol
Shower Before Entering
Watch Step: Floor & Tubs are Slippery
No Cut-off Jeans
Bathing Suits are Required
No Smoking
Be Considerate of Others
Adult Supervision Req'd for Children
