CAMPSITES

- You must be 18 years of age to rent a campsite.
- Campsites can be reserved online, by telephone or in our office.
- There is a six-person maximum per campsite. This includes campers & visitors.
- Please check in at our office before going to the campsite. Check-in time is between 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. You must have your RV at the time of check-in.
- Late arrivals are not permitted.
- Check-out time is noon. Late check-out is not permitted.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. 7 a.m.
- There is a two-vehicle maximum per campsite. This includes campers & visitors.

CAMPGROUND POOL

- Only registered campers are permitted to use the pool. No visitors.
- Arm bands may be required to enter the pool area during holidays.
- There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times. Supervising adult must be 18 years of age or older.
- Vaping, smoking, pets and glass containers are not permitted in the pool area.

SAFETY

- Only concealed handguns possessed under the provisions of a valid concealed carry permit are allowed in open areas, unless otherwise posted.
- All other firearms or deadly weapons, whether openly displayed or concealed, are prohibited. (NCGS 14-415.23 and Ordinance 12.1.5)
- Alcohol and illegal controlled substances are not permitted.
- Please observe posted speed limits.

 You must be 16 years of age to operate a golf cart or motorized vehicle in the campground. ID is required.

- Oak Hollow Lake is a water reservoir for the City of High Point. Due to runoff concerns, washing of vehicles and campers is not allowed.
- Campsites must be left clean after use. Trash must be put in dumpsters located in A & B sections.
- All tents must be placed on a tent platform.
- Campfires must be built in a raised fire pit.
- No swimming in the lake.
- All water vessels must be registered and launched at Oak Hollow Marina. Vessels can only be operated during Marina hours.
- Fishing is permitted in designated areas only. All fishermen must abide by NCGS 113-270.1B.

PETS

- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. (Ordinance 12.2.1)
- Approved portable enclosures (pens, fences, crates) may be allowed on the campsite as long as the pet is both supervised and under the control of the owner at all times.
- Vaccinations are required; proof may be requested at any time.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area or bathhouses.
- Pet waste must be disposed of in dumpsters located in A & B sections.
- Campers with aggressive animals may be required to remove the animal or vacate the campground. (Ordinance 12.2.17)

VISITORS

- All visitors must register at the office before visiting a campsite.
- A visitor tag must be displayed on vehicles while in the campground.
- Visitors are not permitted during quiet hours. (10 p.m. – 7 a.m.)
