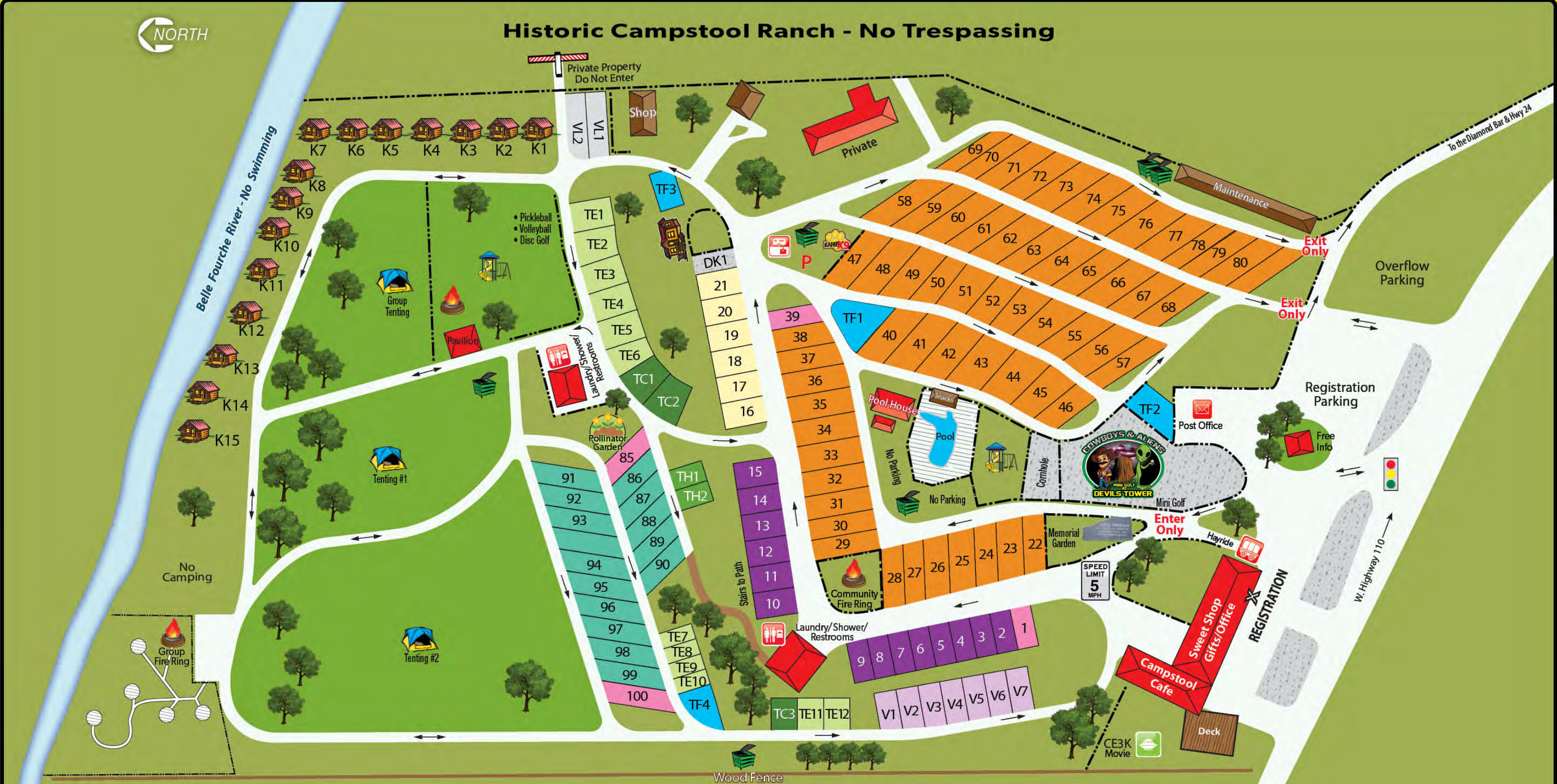





*The Driskill family welcomes you to enjoy the beauty of the historic of the historic Campstool Ranch and Devils Tower National Monument. We are excited to share our western legacy with you. We hope you enjoy your stay but if for any reason you are not satisfied with our campground, please let us know so we can appropriately address your concern. We happily honor KOA's One Hour Refund Policy.*

- **Roads and Speed Limit:-** Please observe the direction of travel on our roads and respect the speed limit of **5MPH**.
- **Your Site:** Your site should be ready. If anything is amiss, notify the front desk immediately. Park according to site layout and centered over the pad. No parking, carpets or rugs on grass areas. RV and vehicle work including oil changes and mechanical repairs is prohibited. ONE camping unit per site unless otherwise noted.
- **Children:** Children are the responsibility of the registered guest. Children under the age of 12 must be supervised in all areas of the campground.
- **Pets:** Quiet, well-mannered pets with responsible owners are welcome. All pets are required to be on a leash held by an adult at all times unless penned or in Kamp K9. No pets allowed in any buildings or recreational areas. All animal waste should be properly disposed of. Sites left with pet waste will be charged for removal (\$).
- **Water:** The campground water is supplied by a well and all water is potable. Please help us conserve our water supply by using it responsibly. Washing of vehicles and campers is prohibited.
- **Septic:** Due to our rural location, our campground is on a septic system. Please only flush biodegradable material.
- **Garbage:** Properly bag and dispose of all garbage in dumpsters. Disposal of large or hazardous items is prohibited. No curbside pickup due to raccoon raids. Sites left with garbage will be charged for removal (\$).

- **Laundry & Showers:** Laundry, showers and restrooms are located in the upper and lower campground areas. Facilities are available 24 hours/day, no code required; vending and coin machines available. We take pride in keeping our facilities clean and in good repair; if anything requires attention, please notify the front desk immediately.
- **Recreational Areas:** Observe all posted rules in recreational areas. No pets, glass containers or smoking allowed in those areas. The use of skateboards, rollerblades, bikes, scooters, hoverboards etc. is prohibited. Safe use of all equipment is required.
- **Pool & Pool house:** The pool and pool house are open seasonally. Observe all posted rules. No lifeguard, swim at your own risk. Children under the age of 12 must have adult supervision.
- **Firearms/Fireworks/Drones:** Firearms, fireworks and drones are expressly prohibited on the property. Use of these will result in immediate removal from the campground with no refund and may result in a trespass charge.
- **Night Skies:** Our area has pristine night skies and we want you to enjoy the spectacular experience of camping under the stars! Please, minimize your light pollution.
- **Fires:** Fires are allowed in designated areas only and are required to be in a grill or fire ring. Propane fires only in RV sections. Fire bans will be followed as issued. \$50 fee for fire violations.
- **Campstool Cafe:** Open seasonally. Full menu for breakfast, lunch and dinner. To Go available. 10% discount for registered campers.

**This campground has a NO REFUND policy. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. Violations of campground guidelines may result in removal from the campground without a refund. Damage or destruction to any property will result in fines and legal action.**
