

SOME IMPORTANT PARK RULES

- Daily Use and Camping Fees are assessed per vehicle.
- Camping is permitted in designated campsites only. Designated campsites mean an established area within a state park or historic site with a state-provided picnic table and metal fire ring. Moving of state-provided picnic tables and metal fire rings is prohibited.
- Only one (1) camping unit is permitted to occupy a designated campsite. In addition to the camping unit, no more than two (2) licensed vehicles may occupy the designated campsite if they can fit within the confines of the designated site. One (1) additional tent for family (parents, grandparents and unmarried minor children) is considered part of a single camping unit. May not exceed 10 people per site.
- A camping unit means a portable structure, shelter or motor vehicle designed and intended for occupancy by persons engaged in RVing or camping. The basic camping units include, but are not limited to, travel trailers, motorhomes, tents, teepees, yurts and motor vehicles that will be occupied overnight.
- Quiet shall be maintained in all areas used for camping between the hours of 10pm and 6am.
- Glass beverage containers are not allowed.
- All trash must be deposited in containers designated for the purpose. Please consider "Pack it in. Pack it out."
- Leaving any property unattended for over 24 hours or the saving of campsites is prohibited. Sites must be occupied nightly.
- Fires are permitted only in park-supplied fire rings and must be completely extinguished before leaving. No fires on beaches.
- Alcohol quantities are limited.
- All pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
- The discharge of firearms is prohibited.
- The possession of and/or discharge of fireworks is prohibited.
- All motorized vehicles shall have license plates or proper permits and may be operated only on designated roads or areas.
- Only persons possessing a valid motor vehicle operator's license may operate a vehicle.
- ORVs must display a Wyoming ORV Registration Sticker and are restricted to designated roadways and entering/leaving campgrounds. These are available at local selling agents, as well as at www.wyo-park.com.
- It is the visitor's responsibility to know and follow the rules and regulations. Complete rules and regulations can be found at the fee booths, park headquarters, and online at wyo-park.com

CAMPING AREAS

RED HILLS CAMPGROUND: Campground area is rolling terrain partially forested with ponderosa pine and juniper trees. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Close access to the water with a sand and gravel shoreline. Group site available.

RENO COVE CAMPGROUND: Boat launching area with 21 designated campsites near the launch area. Reno Cove is a protected bay with a sewer pump-out station for boats. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Group sites are available. Reno Cove is a diverse area with open prairie at the top and partially forested areas near the waters edge.

CUSTER COVE: Camping area with shade trees and close access to the lake. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Sites are on a reservation basis. Close access to the water with a sand and gravel shoreline.

WHISKEY GULCH & SAGEBRUSH CAMPGROUNDS: Large camping areas along the south side of a large bay with boat launch facilities nearby. Cottonwood trees along the shoreline provide shade and good wind protection. Forty-nine campsites available, campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers.

TWO MOON CAMPGROUND: One of our largest campgrounds with 87 sites available. Located on a bluff overlooking the reservoir and Glendo Dam. Campground is forested with ponderosa pine and juniper trees. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Two Moon Campground has a playground area and non-motorized trails for biking and hiking. Group sites are available.

SANDY BEACH AREA: A large area with cottonwood trees above the high water line and approximately 2 miles of sandy beach for swimming and recreational boating. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Campsites are on a reservation and first-come, first-served basis with a total of 139 sites. Group sites are available.

ELK HORN CAMPGROUND: Boat launching area with 9 designated campsites located near the launch area. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Cottonwood trees and willows along the shoreline provide shade and wind protection. Close access to the water with a sand and gravel shoreline.

BENNETT HILL CAMPGROUND: Boat launching area with 44 designated campsites near the launch area. Open prairie with cottonwood trees along the shoreline. Close access to the water with a sand and gravel shoreline. Campsites are designated and designed to accommodate a variety of RV and tent campers. Group sites are available.

HISTORY

Glendo Dam construction began in 1954. The dam was completed in 1957 and the power plant in 1958. The dam is an earth-filled structure 2096 feet long and 167 feet high. In 2010 through 2015 the top of the dam was raised three feet and an auxiliary spillway was put in near Sagebrush Campground. The main purpose of Glendo Reservoir is for irrigation and downriver flood control. This causes the water level to fluctuate greatly throughout the recreation season. The water level is controlled by the US Bureau of Reclamation. Glendo Reservoir is on federal land but the recreational facilities are managed by Wyoming State Parks, Historic Sites and Trails. Glendo became a State Park in 1959.
