## Leave No Trace

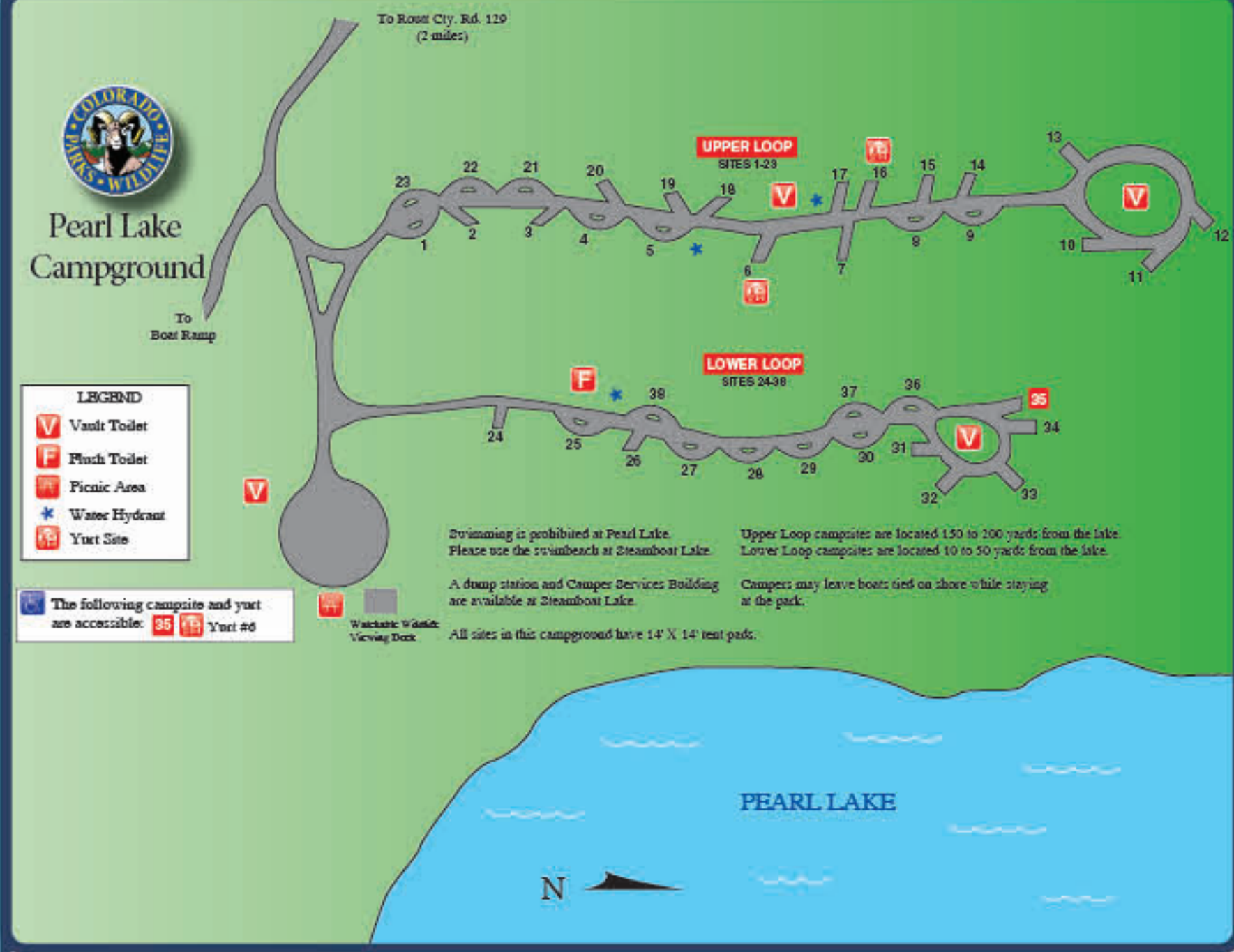
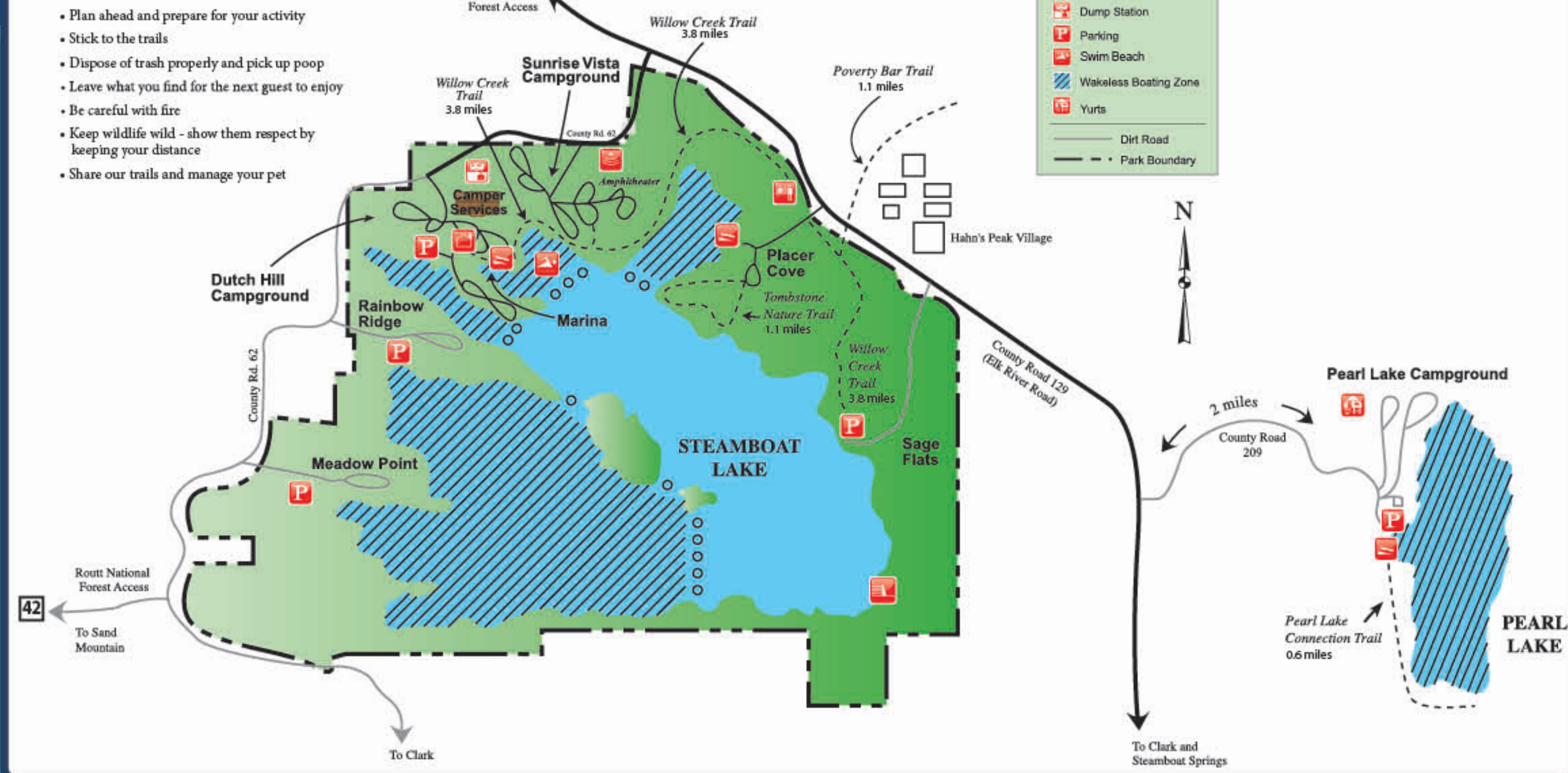
- Plan ahead and prepare for your activity

**Park Information and Regulations:** *Space does not permit printing of all rules and regulations governing the parks. If you have a question, please consult a park ranger or contact the visitor center at 970-879-3922.*

**Quiet hours:** 10 pm to 6am.  
**Speed limit:** Please observe all speed limits (10 -15mph).  
 Off-highway vehicles (OHVs, golf carts) are prohibited.

**Campfires:** are permitted at each campsite in the fire ring provided. All camp fires should be attended to. Please do not use fire pits as trashcans. An unattended fire is dangerous and illegal. Please be sure to completely extinguish all fires.

- Explosives and/or fireworks are prohibited.

**Pets:** Dogs are welcome in both parks:

- Pets must be attended at all times.
- Please clean up after your pet. If they poop you must scoop!
- Pets must be on a six foot or shorter leash at all times.
- Pets are not allowed within the beach area.

**Wildlife:** Sandhill cranes, waterfowl, elk, deer, bear, coyote, fox, beaver, birds of prey, and other small mammals make their home in the area.

- All plant and animal life is protected. Do not remove, deface, mutilate or molest. Please help protect your parks' forests by not hanging or tying things to the trees.

**Keep Your Parks Clean:** Please use trash receptacles. Recycling bins available.

## Hiking Trails:

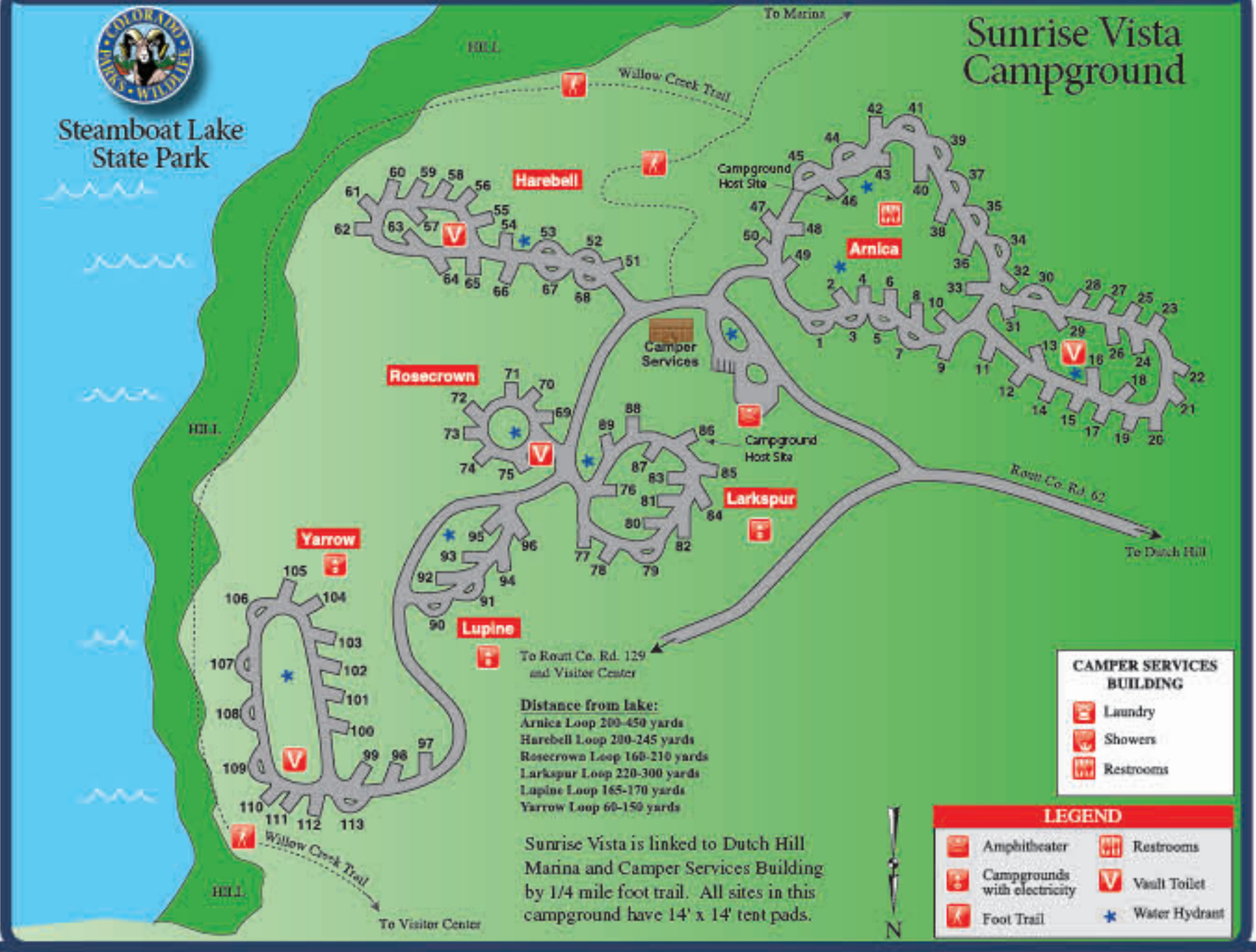
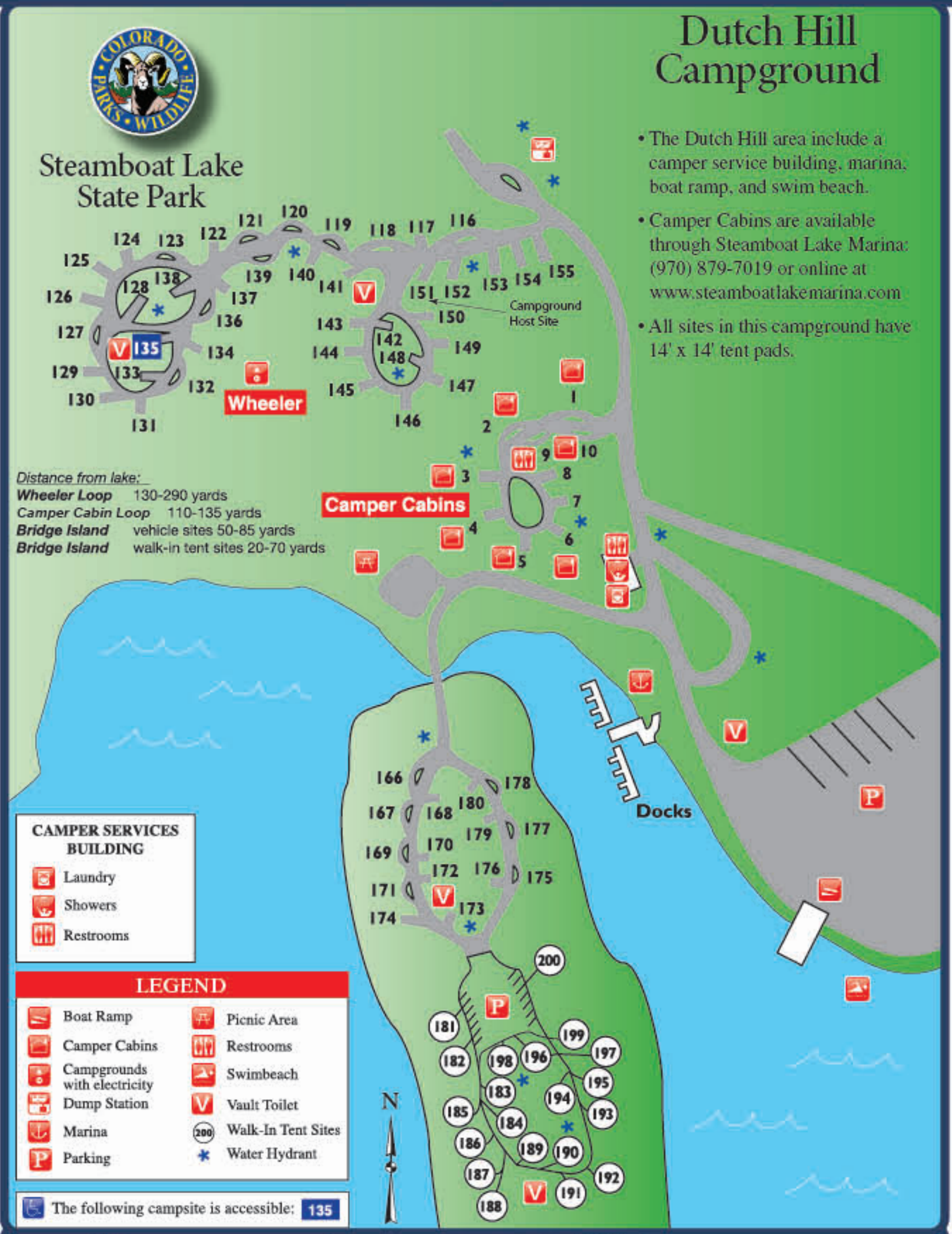
- The outstanding Tombstone Nature Trail, a 1.1 mile loop below the Visitor Center, is a self-guided trail that educates hikers on nature and history of the area.
- The Willow Creek Trail connects the Marina and Sage Flats and provides a nice view along the lake.
- The Poverty Bar trail connects to the Willow Creek Trail via Forest Service 409 and provides information about the history of mining in the area.
- The Pearl Lake Connector Trail is a 0.6 mile meandering trail that accesses thousands of acres of National Forest.

- Camping:**
- Sites are by reservation only from Memorial Day Weekend through September 30<sup>th</sup>. Reservations can be made 6 months in advanced by visiting [www.cpwshop.com](http://www.cpwshop.com) or calling 1-800-244-5613.
    - o Outside those dates we are open for first come, first serve camping until winter conditions close down the main campgrounds.
  - The park has implemented the NO SHOW policy for camping. If you do not show up within 24 hours of your scheduled check in time, and you do not notify the park that you will be arriving late, your site may be resold and may not be available when you arrive. Any nights passed are non-refundable.
  - Two yurts are available year-round at Pearl Lake. The camping minimum night stay for the yurts is two nights.
    - o During the winter months, it is a 6-8 minute hike, cross-country ski or snowmobile trek to reach the yurts.
    - o Both yurts are heated and have electricity.
    - o Yurt #16 is pet friendly and requires a nightly non-refundable deposit.
  - Campers must have a camping permit and a vehicle pass.
  - Check in time: 1pm
  - Check out time: 12pm
  - Length of stay is limited to 14 nights.
  - All vehicles must be parked in established parking areas.

- Fishing:**
- Steamboat Lake offers excellent fishing of trout. Primarily Rainbow trout and Cutthroat trout. With occasional Cutbow, Brown and Brook trout.
    - o Daily bag limit is 4 fish with a possession limit of 8 total (no length requirement).
    - o Can use bait, fly, and lure.
  - Pearl Lake offers Cutthroat Trout, Brook Trout, and Grayling.
    - o Bag, possession and min. size is 2, 18 inches long (2 bag limit 2 in possession).
    - o Artificial flies and lures **ONLY**.

**Boating & Water Recreation:** Boaters at both lakes are subject to current Colorado Boating Statutes and Regulations.

- Motorized boating is allowed at Pearl Lake. The Lake is restricted to wakeless boating operation only.
- Personal Flotation Devices (PFDs): Children 12 years of age and younger are required to wear a PFD whenever their vessel is on the water. All Boaters must carry one wearable PFD for each person on board. This applies to canoes, kayaks, paddleboards and any other flotation device with or without motors.
