

Brantley Lake State Park is located in the Chihuahuan Desert region of southeastern New Mexico. Facilities include picnic areas, developed campsites with shelters and electric hook-ups, a dump station and Visitor Center. Boat ramps and docks provide lake access for boaters, fishing enthusiasts and water skiers.

The park offers special events from spring through fall. Saturday Evening campground programs are held throughout the summer. The park also offers over 2 miles of trails taking about 1-1/2 hours to hike. The trail from the Campground to the Visitor Center has a self-guided "Track Trail" brochure available at the V.C. or Campground Trailheads.

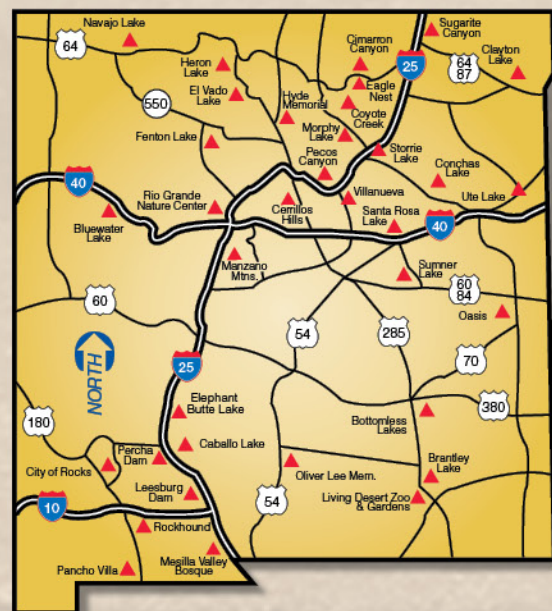
Rules

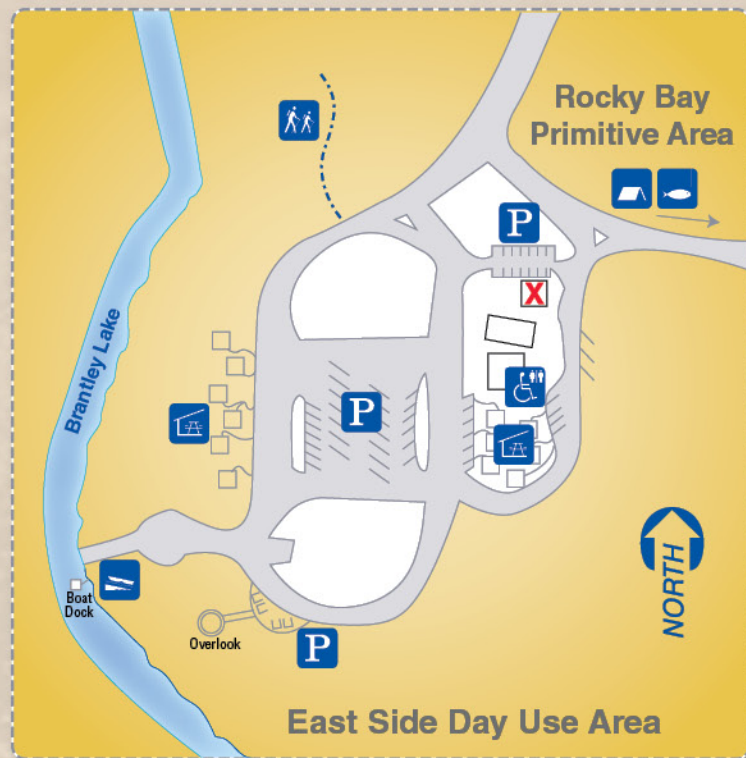
