





- Check in 3:00 p.m.
- Check out 12:00 p.m.
- Quiet Hours 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- Camping: Allowed in designated areas only.
- One vehicle per campsite and one extra vehicle per campsite for an additional fee.
- Tires on the asphalt. Protect the desert vegetation by keeping vehicles and trailers on the park's roadways. No parking off the asphalt.
- · Speed limit: 10 mph throughout entire park
- Invasive Species: All boats must be inspected by a State of Utah employee prior to launching
- · Fireworks: Not Allowed
- Campfires: Allowed only in designated metal fire rings. Fires are not allowed on the exposed beaches. DO NOT leave fires unattended.
- Wastewater: Gray and black water must be deposited into an approved dump station facility.
- Pets: Do not leave pets unattended in the park. If they poop, you must scoop! Doggie bags can be found throughout the park.
