

Recreational Activities & Amenities

- The park's location on the Chesapeake Bay offers visitors unexcelled crabbing and fishing opportunities. Licenses may be required and can be purchased at a local vendor, on-line at compass.dnr@maryland.gov, or by calling 1-855-855-3906 (available 8:30 AM-4:30 PM, Mon. - Fri.).
- Janes Island Marina boat slips are available to campers for a small fee, inquire at check-in. A boat ramp is available to all. Day-users must pay a launch fee, but campers may launch at no charge. Maryland State Park Passport and MD Golden Age Pass are honored for free boat launching.
- The Terrapin Run Recreation Trail is one and a half miles from the park and suitable for walking and biking. The 4.5-mile section between Crisfield and Marion Station is complete. This paved trail is well-maintained and offers parking at each end. Ask the park staff for directions.
- The Whitetail Trail is a self-guided nature trail of approximately one mile in length. The trail will take you through a mature Loblolly Pine forest and along the Daugherty Creek Canal. You are sure to observe some of the local flora and fauna that call the Lower Eastern Shore home. Biting flies and ticks can be a seasonal nuisance, so come prepared.
- The Janes Island Water Trail is a network of seven color-coded canoe/kayak trails totaling over 30 miles in length. Canoes and kayaks may be rented seasonally at the park (weather permitting). A water trail map is available for purchase at the park.
- Janes Island offers more than 5 miles of sand beaches with excellent access to the water. The beaches are unguarded. Swim at your own risk. Be careful, jellyfish can be a problem at certain times of the year. Swimming areas at the park are only accessible by boat.
- Waterfowl hunting is permitted on Janes Island. All other hunting is prohibited.
- The Park Store is open seasonally and offers basic camping needs including ice, firewood, bait, snacks, fishing and crabbing gear and souvenirs. There is also a multipurpose room with Wi-Fi and a break from the heat. Great view of the marina and the Daugherty Creek Canal.
- Environmental Education programs are offered seasonally and by special request at the Ranger Julie Schweikert Nature Center. A 24-foot observation tower near the Nature Center has a great view of Janes Island.
- The park has 105 campsites that are suitable for most types of camping units. 50 sites are equipped with electrical hook-up (30 amp, 115 volt). All sites have a picnic table, lantern post and a fire ring with grill. The campground has three heated bathhouses, a dump station and hydrants with municipal water.
- The youth group camping area is a sparsely wooded primitive site located off of the Whitetail Trail. The site can accommodate 30 occupants and is equipped with a group charcoal grill, fire pit and picnic tables. Parking and restrooms are located nearby.
- Four full-service waterfront cabins are available year-round. Each sleep six people and has 2 bedrooms, a loft, full kitchen, full bathroom, gas log fireplace (seasonal), air-conditioning and heat, and screened porch. Cabins 1 and 2 are pet friendly.
- Three waterfront camper cabins are available during the camping season. Each sleep four people and are equipped with AC, heat, electric, table and chairs, either 2 sets of bunkbeds or a full-size bed and one set of bunkbeds, ceiling fan, picnic table and fire ring. Restrooms are shared with the campground and water is available nearby. Camper cabin C is pet friendly.
- The Daugherty Creek Lodge has an overnight capacity of 16 people and a meeting/dinner capacity of 65 people. Four bedrooms, three and a half bathrooms, two fireplaces, a fully equipped kitchen, a second floor deck, a screened porch, picnic tables, outside charcoal grill, and fire pit make this an ideal site for family or business retreats. Contact the park directly for reservations and availability. Pets are not permitted at the Lodge.
- A picnic area with tables and charcoal grills is available at no charge.
- Two sheltered picnic pavilions, each with a capacity of 120 people, are available by reservation.
- The recreation area features a swing set, baseball field, and volleyball court.
- Some of our buildings and campsites are accessible to persons with disabilities. Call ahead if you need special accommodations.
- Alcohol is prohibited in the campground and day-use areas. Some exceptions may apply.
- Pets are welcome in all day-use areas of the park and must be on a leash at all times.

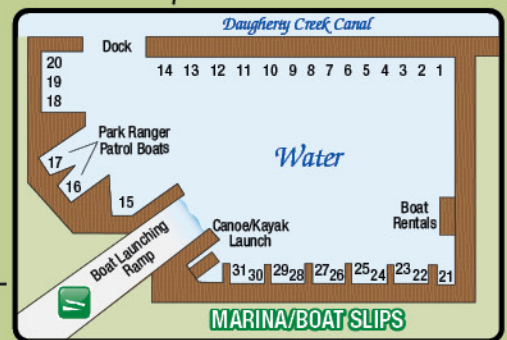
