

Park Rules

These rules are for the safety and protection of you and our fragile environment.

- The park is open from 8 a.m. to sundown.
- Sewage and gray water must be disposed at the dump station.
- Site limits are: 1 RV/trailer plus 1 tent, or 2 tents. Two vehicles, max of 8 people.
- Respect wildlife. Do not feed or approach wild animals.
- Help us protect our vegetation by not tying or nailing anything to trees.
- Keep your camping rig or tent within the confines of the site. Do not park or place equipment on grassy areas/vegetation.
- Tent Only sites 44, 46, 48, 50 are intended for tent camping and have a max vehicle length of 17 feet. Pop-ups or trailers are not permitted.
- If your camping rig doesn't safely fit on the site you reserved, you may be asked to move or leave the park.
- The beach dunes are a highly fragile and essential natural area. Never walk, drive or park on them and always use dune walkovers to access the beach.
- Washing vehicles, filling pools or hot tubs and use of outdoor showers is prohibited on campsites.
- All garbage must be disposed of in the common dumpster, not in the bathhouse nor left on your site.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited outside of the campground.
- All visitors and extra vehicles must register with the ranger station.
- For your safety, do not give the gate combo to unregistered guests or campers.
- Additional vehicles must park in overflow or day use areas and may not stay in the road.
- No firewood or kindling may be collected within the park boundaries. Bags of firewood are available from the campground host.
- Maximum camping stay is 14 consecutive nights.
- Fishing may require a Florida fishing license which can be purchased online at www.myfwc.com/license/

PET RULES

- Pet owners must pick up after their pets and properly dispose of waste.
- Pets must be well behaved, confined, leashed and under the physical control of a responsible person.
- Leashes may not exceed 6 feet in length.
- Pets may not be left unattended for more than 30 minutes on a campsite.
- Pets must be confined in camping rig/tent during quiet hours of 11 p.m. – 7 a.m.
- Pets are not permitted on beaches or in buildings.
- Any pet that is noisy, dangerous, intimidating or destructive will not be allowed to remain in the park.
- Service animals are welcome in all areas of the park.

RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

- **CAMPING:** Camping areas are located on both the beachside and the riverside of the park for your enjoyment.
- **PICNICKING:** The picnic area is located along the Intracoastal Waterway.
- **KAYAKING:** Kayak tour information available at ranger station. An accessible kayak launch is provided in the park.
- **SWIMMING:** Enjoyed in the Atlantic Ocean. No Lifeguard on duty. Exercise caution.
- **BOATING:** A boat ramp is provided on the Intracoastal Waterway.
- **FISHING:** Pompano, whiting, drum and bluefish may be caught in the surf along the beach. Speckled trout, redfish and flounder are often caught along the Intracoastal Waterway.
- **LAUNDRY:** Facilities located at each bathhouse.
