1. Park rules and regulations are posted throughout the park.
2. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
3. It is unlawful to possess or discharge fireworks or explosives.
4. It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees.
5. Pets must be on a leash (no longer than six feet) or under physically restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets that threaten or harass wildlife. Please clean up after your pet.

GENERAL CAMPGROUND POLICIES

- Alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed in South Carolina State Parks.
- Destruction of Park property, including trees, is illegal.
- Nothing other than wood is to be burned in fire rings. NO firewood is allowed to be brought into Croft State Park from a distance of greater than 30 miles.
- All trash must be taken to garbage dumpsters. LEAVE NO TRACE.
- All fires must be put out completely upon leaving.
- NO excessive noise which will disturb other campers; This includes pets.
- All visitors not staying overnight must pay Park admission fees.
- \$5 fee for use of Dump Station for those not staying in campground.

GOLF CART USA

- Operating Restrictions:
 - Visitors may only operate golf cart during daylight hours.

- Operator must have a valid driver's license.
- Must be driven on secondary public roads only. Golf carts can not go on any trails within the state park.
- Must be operated by owner(s) only.
- SCDMV Golf Cart Registration must be carried when the golf cart is being operated.
- This information can be obtained at the DMV.
- For more information regarding golf cart rules and regulations, please see Park Ranger.

PET POLICIES

- Pets must be restrained by leash or other device at all times.
- Park visitors MUST clean up after their pets.
- No horses in the campground areas.

PARK OFFICE

- Ice, firewood, shavings for horse stalls and souvenir items for sale.
- Boats, kayaks and canoes for rent (jackets and paddles included).
- Games (Horseshoes, Corn hole, Bocce ball) free to borrow.

LAKE INFORMATION

- No swimming in lake.
- SC Fishing License required (Age 16 and up).
- Fish limits apply (please see Office for guidelines).

PRIMITIVE CAMPING (TENTS ONLY)

- Respect other groups nearby (their gear and space as well as noise levels).
- No feeding or petting horses at horse stables.
- Vehicles can drop gear off at beginning of stay and pick up gear at end of stay.
- During stay, vehicles must park in designated parking location behind Show Ring.
- General Campground Policies and Pet Policies above apply to Primitive Camping area.
