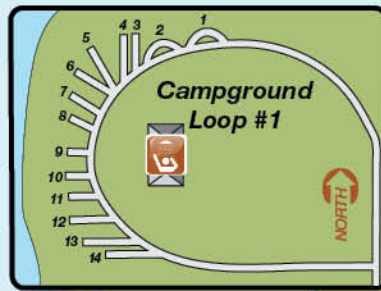
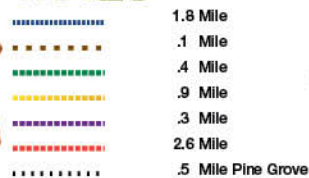

CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given. Changes are not permitted unless requested at least four days in advance for camping. Early departures are subject to cancellation policies. Transaction fees are non-refundable.
- Registered campers may not change sites without permission from park staff.
- Senior citizens (ages 65 and older) and disabled residents may register for a campsite at a reduced rate. The qualifying individual must be present for the duration of the stay.
- All camping parties must be registered.
- A campsite is considered occupied when at least one member of the party, at least 18 years of age, is present on the site with the camping equipment, or camping equipment is in place and the party is engaged in opportunities provided at or near the park.
- Campers are allowed a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent OR two tents per site, and a maximum of 2 vehicles. No more than six (6) persons may occupy the same site and must be in designated area.
- Camping equipment left unoccupied overnight is prohibited.
- Two sites designated for use by disabled persons are available at each park.
- Camping check-in is 2 p.m. Check-out is 12 noon.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.
- Maximum length-of-stay on a particular site during periods of high demand is 14 nights.
- Camping parties may not register for more than twenty-eight nights out of sixty consecutive nights.
- It is unlawful to dispose of any waste (including gray water) in places or receptacles other than those specifically designed for that purpose (Dump Station).
- All fires must be confined to designated grills or areas.
- Roadside parking is prohibited. Do not park on unoccupied sites for any length of time.
- Pets must be on a leash (no longer than six feet) or under physically restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets that threaten or harass wildlife. Pets are not allowed in cabins or cabin areas.
- No pets in comfort stations or restrooms.
- Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay the admission fee.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees.
- Possession of firearms is prohibited except by certified park rangers and other authorized personnel.
- It is unlawful to possess or discharge fireworks or other explosives.
- Only licensed vehicles may be operated in a state park and must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic. Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times, and only be operated by a licensed driver.
- A detailed listing of rules and regulations are posted throughout the park on bulletin boards.

To ensure that your State Park experience is enjoyable, please be aware of the dynamic characteristics of the natural environment. There are some areas that may be potentially hazardous. All visitors should exercise caution when visiting any state park. Anyone who is unsure about possible hazards should contact a Park Ranger.

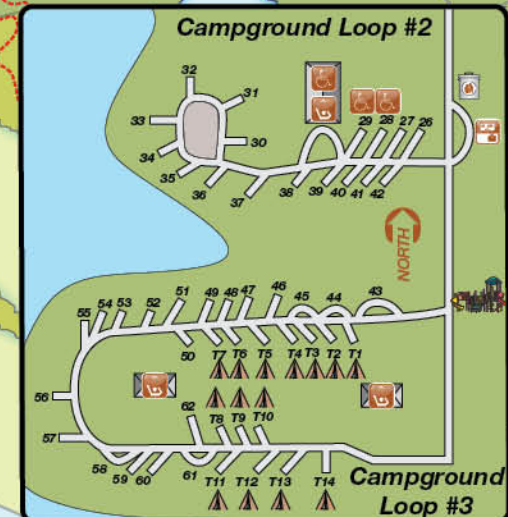
