To ensure that your State Park experience is enjoyable, please be aware of the dynamic characteristics of the natural environment. There are some areas that may be potentially hazardous. All visitors should exercise caution when visiting any state park. Anyone who is unsure about possible hazards should contact a Park Ranger.



Register at Nature Center for **ALL HIKES**.
 Access to Lakeside Trail is located next to Hillside Shelter.

All other trails start at Nature Center.
 Trails close 1/2 hour before sunset. Overnight camping is **NOT PERMITTED** on PARK TRAIL SYSTEM.

For the protection of park wildlife, pets must be on a leash no longer than 6ft at all times.

CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All sites are reservable and reservations can be made online by visiting www.southcarolinaparks.com.
2. All camping parties must be registered.
3. Each site must be occupied by one person 18 years or older.
4. Campers are allowed a maximum of one trailer/RV and one tent, OR two tents per site. No more than six (6) persons (or one family) may occupy the same site. No more than 2 cars per site. Tent must be placed on site.
5. Some designated tent sites are limited to one tent.
6. Camping equipment left unoccupied overnight is prohibited.
7. Camping is NOT permitted on the Park Trails.
8. ADA/Handicap Accessible sites are available by calling park.
9. Camping check-in is 2 pm; check-out is 12 noon.
10. Quiet hours are 10 pm - 7 am.
11. Maximum length-of-stay on a particular site during periods of high demand is 14 nights.
12. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
13. Pets must be on a leash (not longer than six feet) or under physically restrictive control at all times. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife. Pets are not allowed in cabin area, beach area or boats. All pet waste must be disposed of by owner.
14. It is unlawful to dispose of any waste (including gray water) in places or receptacles other than those specifically designed for that purpose.
15. All fires must be confined to designated grills or areas and not left unattended.
16. It is unlawful to cut, damage or remove plants, shrubs or trees.
17. Possession of firearms is prohibited except by certified park rangers and other authorized personnel.
18. It is unlawful to possess or discharge fireworks or other explosives.
19. Only licensed vehicles may be operated in a state park and must remain in areas specifically intended for vehicular traffic. Golf carts must display a valid permit at all times.
20. Cancellations and changes are subject to fees based on the notice given. Changes are not permitted unless requested at least four days in advance for camping and 15 days for cabins. Refunds are not issued due to change in weather or early departure. Transaction fees and taxes are non-refundable.
21. Registered campers may not change sites without permission from park staff.
22. Personal golf cart use incurs a \$5 per night charge based on the length of your stay. Up to two (2) golf carts may be registered with each reserved campsite.
23. South Carolina senior citizens (age 65 and older) and disabled residents may register for a campsite at a reduced rate. The qualifying individual must be present for the duration of the stay and ID shown at check-in.
24. Visitors not registered for an overnight stay are required to pay the admission fee.

Activities and Facilities

Camping We have 87 reservable sites and 6 camp host sites for a total of 93 sites with water and electrical hookups, which can be reserved up to 13 months in advance of check-in. Comfort stations are located throughout, and a sanitary disposal station is located near the park store. Pets must remain under physical restraint at all times and not disturb others in any manner. Pets must not be left unattended on site.

Cabins There are 14 cabins which can be reserved up to 13 months in advance of check-in. Capacity varies from four to eight people, and sizes range from one bedroom to three bedrooms. Tents are not permitted. Pets are not permitted in cabin/cabin area.

Fishing Two park lakes provide excellent fishing for bass and bream. Seasonal fishing boat rentals are available on Pinnacle Lake located near seasonal swimming area. Small launch ramp available from SC 11. Electric motors only. No private boats on Lake Pinnacle - no swimming. Private boats on Lake Oolenoy only - no swimming.

Trails Enjoy over 13 miles of trails ranging from moderate to strenuous in difficulty. The trail system includes the eastern access of the Foothills Trail. Access to the Palmetto Trail is located at Pinnacle Pavilion.

Activities During the summer season, seasonal swimming, rental kayaks, canoes and pedal boats may be enjoyed. Picnic tables and shelters are located throughout the park and available year-round. The shelters may be reserved in advance. Shelter rentals do not include park admission. Pets are not permitted in beach/swimming area or park boats.

Reservations

All sites/cabins may be reserved 13 months in advance.


