



GENERAL INFORMATION

For the best interest of all our guests, we ask for your cooperation by observing our policies and rules. Thank you!

- No refunds due to weather or early departure. Please keep our campground as clean as when you entered.
- Quiet time: Sun.-Thur. 10 PM - 7 AM, Fri.-Sat. 11 PM - 7 AM.** Please respect your neighbors.
- Check-out time is 11 AM. Please notify the office by 10 AM if you would like to stay another night.**
- Early check-ins and late check-outs may be possible for a fee. Please check with the office.
- All visitors must register. There is a fee. Visitors must leave by quiet time.
- Parking - Please do not change your assigned space without office approval.
- No parking or driving on grass.**
- No rugs or mats on grass.**
- Only one camping unit per site. Park only on your site or in extra visitor parking. Storage fee applies for extra vehicles.
- You are responsible for damages to sites and grounds.
- Speed limit posted 5 MPH. Please, no dust.
- Garbage: Deposit in dumpster or nearby garbage cans.
- Do not place any garbage or cigarette butts in fire pits. Please dispose of properly.
- Do not drain any type of water on the ground. This is TN Law.
- Small campfires may be built and completely enclosed in the fire pit provided.
- Do not move fire pits. Stay with your campfires (do not leave them unattended).
- Do not cut, carve or deface trees in any way.
- Firewood restrictions posted in office. Do not leave firewood behind on your site. There will be a disposal fee.
- Do not haul any firewood out of the woods. Gathering of wood allowed at your site only.
- Parents are responsible for the behavior and welfare of their children at all times.
- Parents must supervise children when using any campground facility.
- The use of motorbikes, ATVs, firearms, BB guns, drones, pellets, airsoft, paintball guns and slingshots, bows & arrows, or fireworks is strictly prohibited.
- Pool hours are posted. Children under 14 not allowed without an adult.
- Alcoholic beverages must be consumed at your site only. THIS IS A STATE LAW.
- Sex offenders are prohibited from use of property.
- No fences or pens of any kind.
- No stakes in the ground.
- Additional fee for charging electric cars. See front office for Management approval to charge electric cars, do not charge at your site.
- Your site and RV must remain clean and free of clutter and trash during your stay.
- Vehicle washing, generators, clotheslines and repairs are prohibited. Windshield washing is okay.
- No electric vehicle charging on campsites. A \$200 fine plus damages will be charged. See Office about how to charge your EV.
- Pets are welcome with the following restrictions:
 - 1) Must be non-aggressive.
 - 2) Not allowed in any campground facility buildings.
 - 3) Must be kept on leash at all times.
 - 4) Do not leave unattended at campsite.
 - 5) Keep off playground and pool area.
 - 6) Clean up after your pet.
 - 7) Owners are responsible for their pet's actions.
- Games & Rec equipment may be checked out at store.
- Management reserves the right to discharge any person, without refund, for failure to abide by the rules or for objectionable behavior.
- Management assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries, or losses from any cause to guests or visitors.
- Firearms: Discharging, using, exposing, brandishing, or handling firearms where others can see is strictly prohibited. Lawful concealed carry is permitted.
- The safe use of golf carts is permitted, providing the operator has a valid driver's license, follows the campground road rules, and the golf cart is fully insured.
- Autotransformers/ Autoformers and all similar devices are prohibited from use on campground property.**

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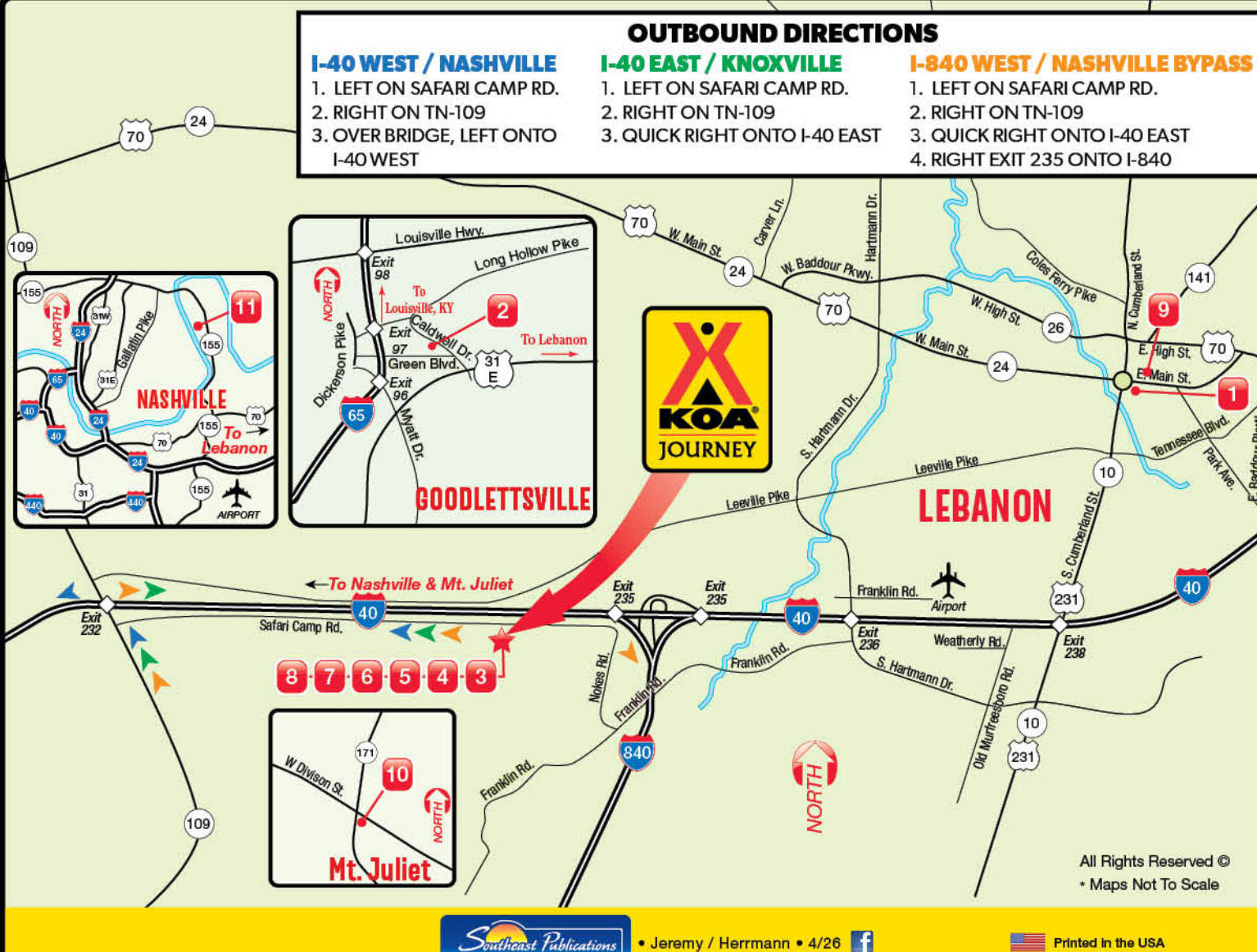
