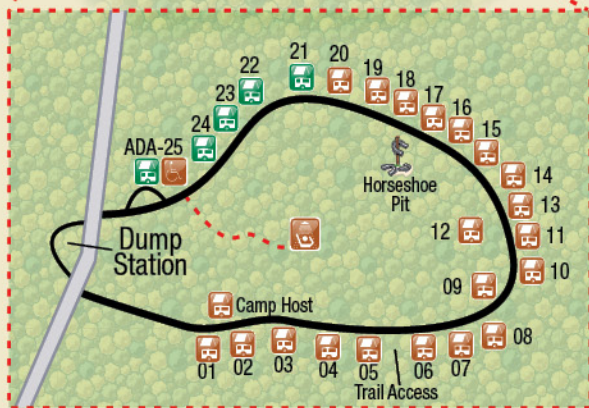

AMENITIES & ACTIVITIES

- Playground Equipment - located in main picnic area.
- Horseshoe Pits - located in main picnic area and in campground.
- Park Store/ Gift Shop - located in park office.
- Picnic Shelters with grill - (3)
- Picnic Pads with grill and table - (6)
- Swimming - (seasonal) located in main picnic area. Swim at your own risk, no lifeguard on duty
- Bird Watching - yes
- Wood and Boat Rentals available at store.
- Geocaching: An adventurous and entertaining way to explore the park. Using your smartphone or handheld GPS device, trek through the park finding designated GPS points where caches are hidden. Visit Geocaching.com to learn more and begin your next nature hunt.
- Biking: The main road is bike friendly and has become very popular with visitors.
- Artesian Wells: Aiken State Park features 1 artesian well for public drinking water.
- CCC Structures - located throughout the park.



- **Camping Reservations:** To make a camping reservation, call toll-free 1-866-345-PARK or make it online by clicking Park Reservation. Camping reservations must be made for a minimum of two nights. Reservations requested less than one (1) day in advance of check-in must be made directly through the park. For example: If today is Friday and you are making a reservation checking in on today, Friday, you must make the reservation by contacting the park directly.
- **Dump Station - yes**
- **Standard Sites:** There are 25 standard sites. Each site is packed sand and includes individual water, 20/30/50 amp electrical hookups, a fire ring with a hinged grill top, and a picnic table. The campground has a bathhouse with hot showers conveniently located in the center of the campground. There is also a dump station close by.
- **Rustic Tent Sites:** There are 3 rustic tent sites located at the Cabin Lake area. Each site has 3 tent pads, a fire pit, and a picnic table. This area has outhouses and water access.
- **Primitive Group Camp:** Located alongside the Edisto River. This area has 5 tent sites with 1 large communal group area. The communal area has an oversized fire pit, picnic tables, benches, and an outhouse. The other 5 tent sites have a fire ring with a hinged grill top, and a picnic table. Great for scouts and large, organized groups.
- **Pets:** Pets are allowed in most outdoor areas provided they are kept under physical restraint or on a leash not longer than 6 feet. Owners will be asked to remove noisy or dangerous pets or pets that threaten or harass wildlife.

- **Fishing:** Guests are able to fish in any of our 4 stocked ponds, as well as the Edisto River. A valid South Carolina fishing license is required for anyone over the age of 15. Bait is also available for purchase at park store.
- **Tackle Loaner Program:** This Park participates in the Tackle Loaner Program sponsored by the SC Dept. of Natural Resources. Rods and reels are available for loan at the park office.
- **Boating:** Non-motorized boats are allowed in any of the 4 ponds. Fishing boats, pedal boats, canoes, and kayaks are available to rent. Motorized boats are allowed on the river.
- **Canoe/Kayak Rentals:** canoes are available for rent at the park for \$20/boat. This includes life jackets and paddles. Boat reservations must be made in advance through the park.
- Stand up paddle boards are \$10 for 4 hours or \$20 per day.
- **Boat Ramp - yes**

TRAILS

- **Hiking:** Jungle Trail is a 3 mile loop through bottomland hardwood and Sandhill pine forests while exploring wetlands, plus plenty of wildlife to observe along the way. Trail includes dirt path and boardwalk sections.
- **Boating:** Canoe Trail is a 1.7 mile one-way canoe/kayak trail down the Edisto River. You may bring your own boat or rent from the park. Boat rentals include paddle and life vest.
