Located near historic Savannah, this park borders Skidaway Narrows, a part of Georgia's intracoastal waterway. The park provides camping and picnicking surrounded by Spanish moss-draped live oaks. Trails wind through maritime forests and over salt marshes allowing visitors to watch for deer, fiddler crabs, raccoons, egrets and migrating birds such as colorful painted buntings. An observation tower provides another chance to watch for wildlife on this barrier island. Most facilities are ADA accessible.

Activities and Facilities

Camping — The park offers 87 tent, trailer or RV campsites with water/electrical hook-ups, picnic tables and grills. Campfires should be built in fire rings. Restrooms provide showers and washers/dryers. Campsites are dog-friendly, and ADA sites are available.

Camper Cabins & Yurts — Three camper cabins have a queen bed and sleeping loft, small kitchen, bathroom and A/C. Cabin B is ADA and dog-friendly. Three yurts have bunk beds, a fold-out sofa and A/C. Yurt 1 is ADA and dog-friendly. A bathhouse is a short walk from yurts. Linens are provided.

Picnicking & Group Shelter — Five picnic shelters may be reserved for small gatherings. A large group shelter with capacity for 150 is perfect for large celebrations such as family reunions. It is equipped with a range, refrigerator, restrooms, grill, tables and chairs, and oyster cooking shed. Reservations are required.

Fishing, Boating & Swimming — Rodney J. Hall Boat Ramp is one-half mile from the park at 25 Diamond Causeway. Tybee Island beaches are 26 miles away.

Nature Trails — The Sandpiper Loop, Avian Loop and Connector Trail (each 1 mile long), and the 3-mile Big Ferry Trail wind through salt marshes and maritime forests, and both offer boardwalks and observation platforms. Skidaway Island State Park is part of the Colonial Coast Birding Trail and painted buntings are frequently spotted by guests during the spring and summer.

ParkPass - A parking fee is required at all state parks.

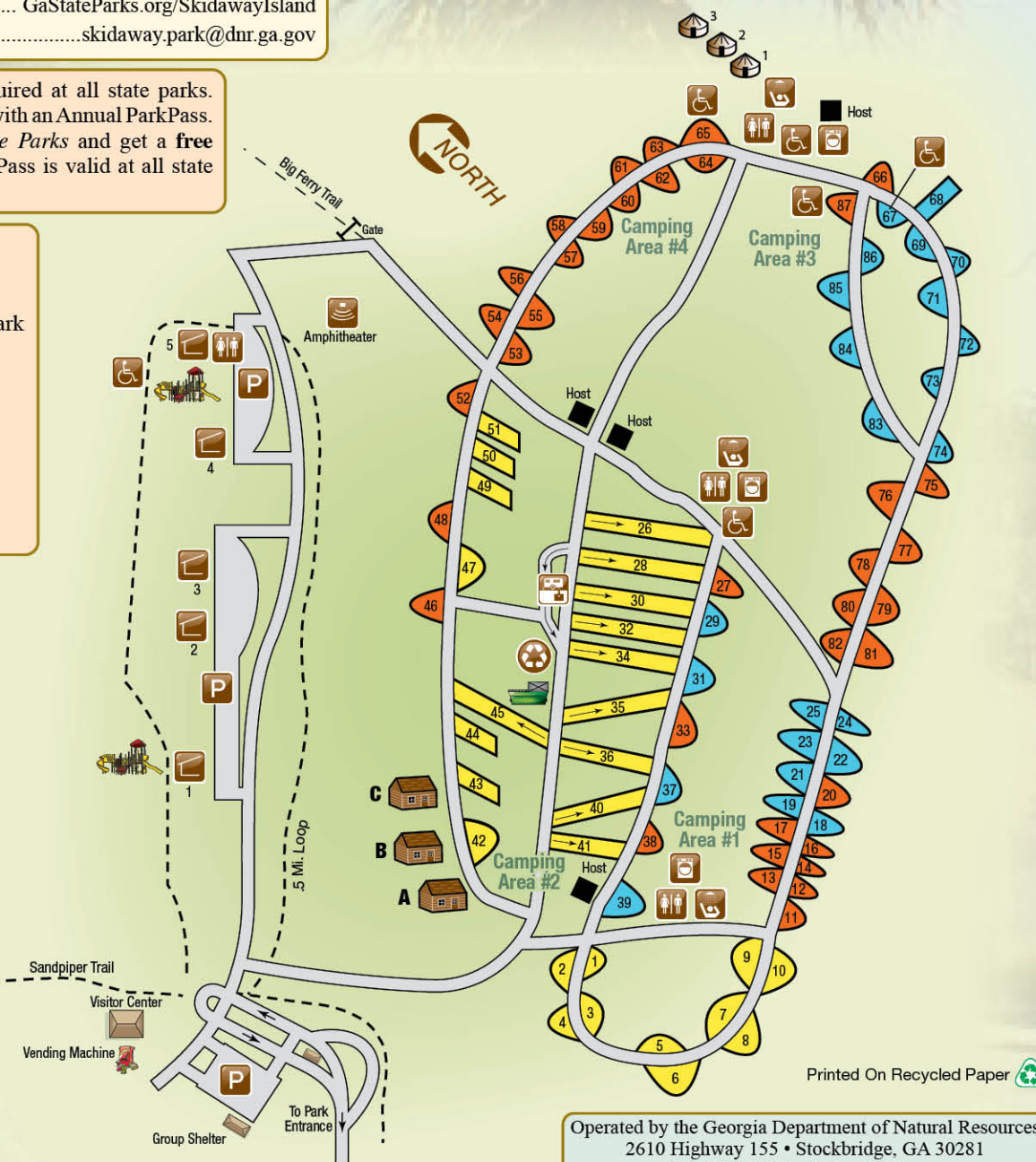
