Finally, Utah holds a few notable records and is home to unusual and fun facts that are globally recognized.

- State Bird - California Gull
- State Tree - Colorado Blue Spruce
- State Flower - Sego Lily
- State Fish - Bonneville Cutthroat Trout
- State Fruit - Cherry
- State Animal - Elk
- State Fossil - Allosaurus
- State Insect - Honey Bee
- State Rock - Coal
- State Gem - Topaz

- The name Utah comes from the Native American Ute tribe, which means "people of the mountains."
- Utah is one of the four corners states
- The Great Salt Lake is seven times saltier than the Ocean.
- One of the most unique places in Utah is the Bonneville Salt Flats, named after the ancient sea that covered the area. Stretching over 30,000 acres, the white salt is millions of years old. Thousands of tourists, filmmakers, and land speed racers make it famous throughout the world.
- Because it is centrally located in the Intermountain West, Utah is often called the "Crossroads of the West." Its geography has three major land areas: the Rocky Mountains, the Basin and Ridge Region, and the Colorado Plateau.
- Utah has five national parks.
- Arches National Park contains more than 2 000 natural sandstone arches.
- The First Transcontinental Railroad was completed in Promontory, Summing, Utah, in 1869.
- Utah is the second driest state in the Union, with 300 days of sun per year.
- The red/green traffic lights were invented in Salt Lake City, Utah in 1912.
- Utah has an official state cooking pot, the Dutch oven.
- Up until 1869, Salt Lake City was called Great Salt Lake City.
- Utah Jazz and Real Salt Lake are the only two professional teams in Utah.
- Approximately 75 million years ago, Utah was part of a landmass called Laramidia. This land mass was hot, swampy, and full of dinosaurs, which makes Utah one of the best places in the U.S. to find dinosaur fossils. In fact, the world's largest raptor lived in Utah. Known as the "Utahraptor," it measured over 23 feet long, making it larger than any other known raptor.

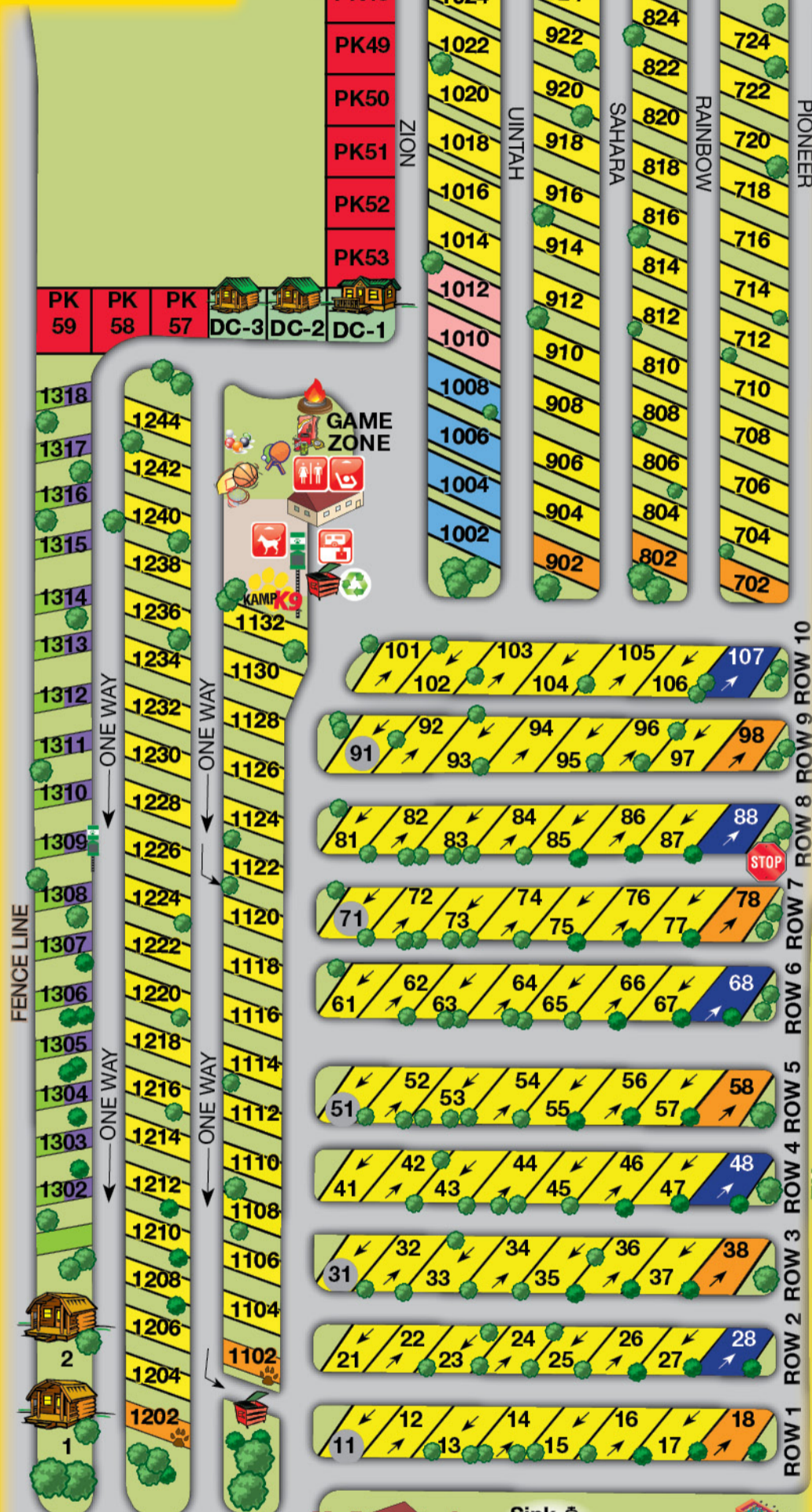

**PARK RULES / CAMPER ETIQUETTE**

- CHECKOUT:** 11am. If you need a late check out, please come to the office prior to 11am. \*Late check out fee is \$15 until 1pm. A full day will be charged after, based on availability.
- SWIMMING POOL:** Hours are from 9am to 9pm. No Lifeguard. Swim at your own risk. State Law requires an adult to supervise any child under 14 years old. No Kiddie pools or Trampolines allowed.
- VISITORS:** All Guests must check-in & pay \$5.00 per day to use facilities. Visitors must park in visitor parking, and walk in to your site. Visitors must be accompanied by registered guest at all times.
- VEHICLES:** 1 vehicle per site. **Do not park vehicles in empty sites, on grass, or in roadways.** No repairing or washing vehicles at any time.
- PETS:** Should be leashed and cleaned up after immediately. They must be supervised at all times. No pet fences! No excessive barking.
- SPEED LIMIT:** 5.5 MPH SLOW, WATCH FOR CHILDREN @ PLAY.
- FIRES:** Fires allowed only in fire pits with screens, fire pits must be on a hard surface, not allowed in grass or on table tops. No grills on tables.
- SITE APPEARANCE:** NO Clotheslines allowed outside, No Rugs, No Protest, or offensive signage allowed, No Flags allowed on sites. Laundry should be dried in a dryer and not seen by neighbors.
- TRASH:** All trash must be taken to dumpsters, do not litter: Pick up your butts, dog poo and trash. **Pack it in, pack it out.**
- WALKING:** Use camper etiquette, walk around not through neighbor's sites.
- CHILDREN:** Parents are fully responsible for their children. Children must be watched and picked up after at all times.
- ELECTRIC VEHICLES:** No EV charging allowed. RV Pedestals are only rated for RVs and EVs will burn them up causing you to be financially responsible for all damage to all power lines damaged by your EV.

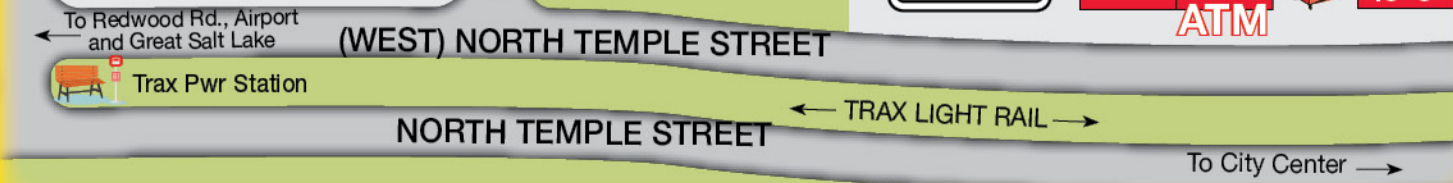

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Known as the "Crossroads of the West", Salt Lake City is a bustling metropolis set in a gorgeous mountain setting that will surprise and charm you. Nestled in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains, and next to the largest inland lake in the western states – the Great Salt Lake – this lovely region was home to the Ute, Paiute, and Shoshone Indians before the Mormon pioneers entered the Salt Lake Valley in 1847.

**This Is The Right Place!** This phrase was first made by Brigham Young (Utah's first Governor and Second President of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints) as the Mormon pioneers entered the valley. Thus began the emigration and settlement of approximately 70,000 people who were escaping religious persecution and found refuge in a new land.

Utah became a territory in 1850, and was made the 45th state in the nation in 1896. Today approximately 61.5% of Utah's 3.1 million plus residents are members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, or "Mormons", and approximately 48.91% of Salt Lake County are "Mormons". (AP News Service)

In 1869 the first Transcontinental Railroad was completed nearby, linking the country and turning the area into a boom-town fueled by its profitable mining industry which still is an important facet of our economy today. The Bingham Canyon Mine (commonly known as Kennecott Copper Mine) is the deepest open-pit copper mine in the world. The Bingham Canyon Copper Mine will be open for visitors once again in May 2019.

If you are an outdoor enthusiast, this is indeed the right place for you! We delight in the distinction of having five National Parks within a few hours' drive from the city, providing beautiful views and vistas for all to enjoy. Our surrounding mountains have 10 world-class ski resorts sporting the "Greatest Snow on Earth" (with even more resorts scattered across the state) for friends who love the slopes. Remember Salt Lake City was the Host of the 2002 Olympics and will be vying to be an Olympic Host City again in the near future.

Utah - known as the Beehive State – with our State's Motto: "Industry" - is reflective of the work ethic here. The greater Salt Lake area, including Park City and Provo, is currently known as "Silicon Slopes" - a hub for Silicon Valley, our tech

industry is growing and thriving. Our state bird the Sea Gull is famous for saving the pioneers' crops during a cricket invasion. Our state tree is the Quaking Aspen because we have the largest quaking aspen grove in the world (known as Pando). And our state insect is the Honey Bee, taking us full circle back to the Beehive State.

Utah is home to the Family Genealogy Library, the beautiful LDS Temple Square and the spectacular Mormon Tabernacle Choir. While in Salt Lake we encourage families to enjoy a Utah Jazz basketball game or a Real Salt Lake soccer game. Come visit our outstanding universities or utilize our first-class hospitals. Salt Lake also offers a world class ballet with Ballet West and other outstanding performance arts organizations. Whether you are here to enjoy our award-winning dining scene or attend our museums, take in a film at the Sundance Film Festival, or visit the Great Salt Lake and enjoy a breath-taking sunset there is something here to delight and amaze everyone.

Come camp with us at the Salt Lake KOA Holiday year-round to appreciate all that our area has to offer.

Salt Lake City streets are on a grid system with Temple Square as zero. The street numbers become higher as you move away from Temple Square in any direction. Each city block increases numerically in 100 increments. Eight city blocks equals 1 mile.
