GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

QUIET HOURS: 10:00 PM-8:00 AM. Please be considerate of neighbors at all times.

CHECK-OUT: 12:00 NOON • **CHECK-IN:** 1:00 PM
NO TENTS, EZ-UPS, CANOPIES, TARPS OR PARTY ENCLOSURES.

VISITORS: All guests & visitors must be registered at office BEFORE going to a site. Maximum number of persons at site is 6, including children. Fees may apply.

PARKING: Do not park extra vehicles in empty RV sites or on roadway. Keep RV on assigned pad with no part of RV extending over the grass.

TRAFFIC: Please observe the 5 MPH speed limit and the one-way traffic arrows in the park. The speed limit applies to **all vehicles**, including motorized and battery-operated bikes, scooters, and hover boards.

PETS: Must be on leash at all times (8ft max). PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR PETS. Doggie bags are provided throughout the park. Please use only the designated pet area for your dog. Please do not leave pets outside unattended or allow them to bark excessively. No dogs allowed in any buildings. **Breed restrictions: Insurance does not permit full or mix Pit Bull, Rottweiler, Chow, Doberman or American Staffordshire Terrier.** Vicious or aggressive pets of any breed are not permitted in the park.

RESTROOMS/SHOWERS & LAUNDRY: NO PET WASHING. **NO RINSING OF BEACH SAND IN EITHER BUILDING.** Please help keep both areas clean for all guests. **Please do not give out the bath code to anyone.**

CHILDREN: Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Playground is located near the flag pole/Harbor office adjacent to the park.

PRIVACY: Please respect your fellow campers and do not cut through campsites.

BIKES/SCOOTERS/SKATEBOARDS/ETC: Safety equipment required by State of California. Riding permitted on asphalt only. **NO RIDING AFTER DARK.** Motorcycles are welcome but must be quiet. Bicycles should be locked and secured at night. Heavy duty bike locks are available in the office.

GARBAGE: Please deposit your bagged garbage in the dumpster. See map for location. Do not leave garbage at your site out overnight for any reason, as critters will be attracted by it.

RECYCLE: Located next to dumpster; glass, plastic, aluminum, cardboard, tin cans.

LAUNDRY ROOM: Open 24 hours. **Please do not put household garbage or dog waste bags in the laundry room trash can.** Quarters are available in the office.

CAMPFIRES: Permitted in approved containers. These must be raised off concrete and a safety screen used. Community fire pit at the end of park is for the enjoyment of **ALL** guests. No fire pits on the grass.

BBQ: Use with caution, not to be placed on picnic tables.

FLAGS & BANNERS: American flags only, flown no higher than RV.

AWNINGS, HOOKS, CLOTHESLINES, ETC.: Do not drive any hooks, stakes, poles, etc. into ground. No patio rugs, mats or pet beds on the grass. NO clotheslines are permitted.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed in any of the buildings or within 20' of buildings. Please be considerate of your neighbors when smoking at your RV site.

HANDICAP: All sites and buildings are handicap accessible.

NO WASHING VEHICLES, SERVICING OF RV'S BY PERMISSION ONLY.

...and the scenic wonders of the central coast. We are proud to be a part of the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary. Covering 276 shoreline miles, the Sanctuary was set aside as a protected area in 1992. It extends from the Farallon Islands, off the coast of San Francisco, and continues south along the coast as far as Cambria. We honor a long-term commitment to protect these waters and the abundant wildlife for future generations.

Just off shore is one of the world's deepest underwater canyons, creating a habitat for a wide variety of marine life. The Monterey Bay Aquarium provides a breath-taking glimpse into parts of that world. Along our beaches you can enjoy viewing sea lions, elephant seals, and otters, as

well as explore fascinating tide pools. Whale watching is a favorite day trip, especially in January, when the migration reaches its peak. The fishing is excellent and the surfing can be "awesome."

From the southern tip of Monterey County, east to the farmlands of the Salinas Valley and San Juan Bautista, and to the northernmost tip of Santa Cruz County, you can visit farmlands, beaches, forests, artists' studios, art galleries, museums, antique shoppes and farmers' markets. We invite you to ride the roller coaster at the Santa Cruz Boardwalk, spend a day on a nature tour through redwood and pine forests, explore Elkhorn Slough, or just relax on the beach. It's all here for you to enjoy and to cherish.

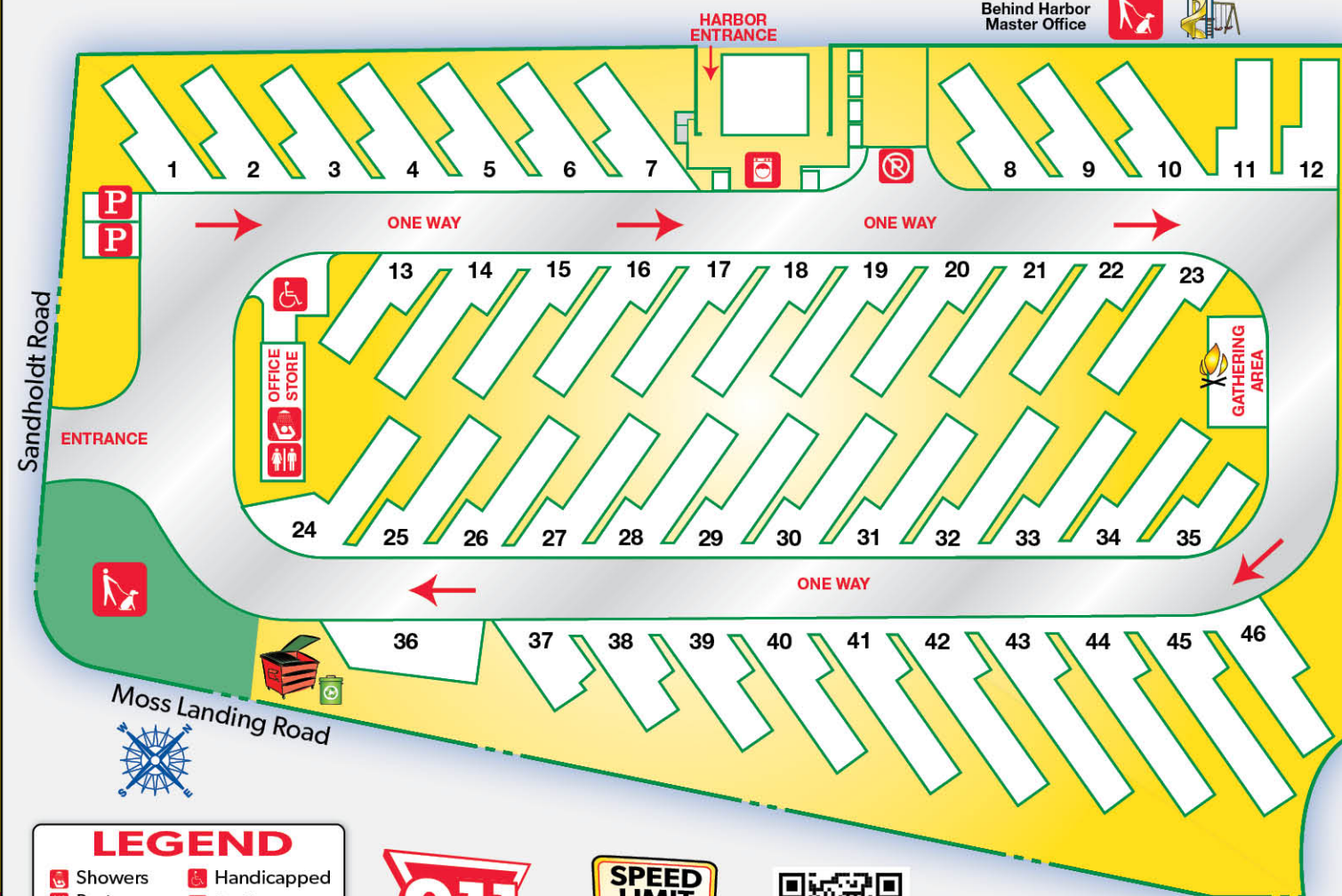
