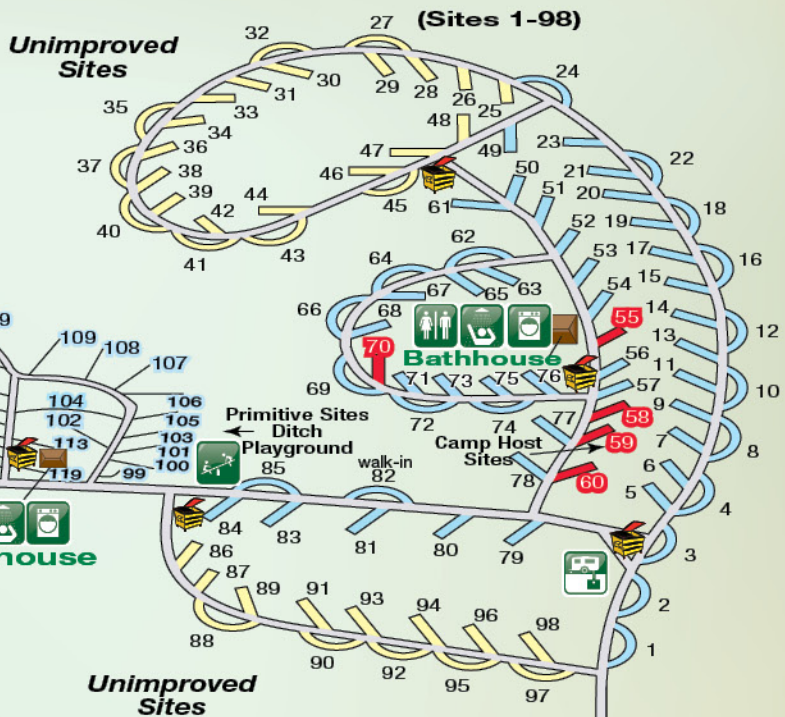



Fontainebleau State Park was originally developed in the 1930s. The 2,800 acres on which the park is situated were originally part of Bernard de Marigny's plantation and sugar mill, the remnants of which can still be seen on the park grounds. The park features excellent day-use facilities including a beach area on Lake Pontchartrain, picnic sites, a nature trail and covered pavilions. Overnight camping and group camp facilities are also available.

Park Information

ENTRANCE STATION HOURS: 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday,
8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Friday, Saturday and the day before holidays.

PARK GATES are locked at night for the visitors' safety and park security. Overnight guests are required to lock the gate when leaving and entering the park after hours.

SPEED LIMIT is 15 mph throughout the park. 10 mph in campground.

USE OF PERSONAL GOLF CARTS on State Park Property – \$10/cart per day; \$100 annual permit available. Proof of cart insurance required; must be operated by a licensed driver.

TRASH: All trash must be taken to the trash containers throughout the campgrounds.

FIRES: Campfires are permitted at each campsite. Please use fire rings where provided.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed inside buildings.

FIREWOOD COLLECTION is limited to fallen, dead timber. No chainsaws allowed.

PETS: Pets must be kept on a six-foot or shorter leash or in a kennel and may not be left unattended in the park.

Pets are not allowed inside any park buildings.

QUIET HOURS: 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

CAMPERS UNDER 21 must be accompanied by an adult.

LENGTH OF STAY is limited to 14 nights per visit (for overnight accommodations including campsites, group camps and lodge).

CHECK-IN time is 2:00 p.m. for campsites. **CHECK-OUT** time is 1:00 p.m. for campsites.

CHECK-IN time is 3:00 p.m. for Group Camps, Lodges and Cabins. **CHECK-OUT** time is 11:00 a.m. for Group Camps, Lodges and Cabins.

Fishing - There is a two-acre brackish water fishing pond and access to brackish fishing along the sandy beach of Lake Pontchartrain in the day-use area. Persons 16 or older must have a valid Louisiana fishing license.



Swimming - Visitors may swim at their own risk in Lake Pontchartrain from sunrise to sunset.



Hiking - The park's trail system provides a 1.2-mile nature trail and a 4.8-mile hiking trail. The Tammany Trace, a 31-mile protected trail, is accessible from the park.



Picnicking - There are numerous picnic tables and barbecue grills within the day-use area. Two public pavilions are located near the lakefront.



Rental Facilities - The park offers day-use and overnight rental facilities. A rental pavilion is in the day-use area. Group Camp number 1 is on the Group Camp road. Group Camp number 3 and the Lodge are in the eastern section of the park and are accessed from Highway 190. Cabins available.
