## SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK, NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY

### PARK HOURS:

7 am to 9 pm Sun-Thurs. 7 am to 10 pm Fri, Sat, and days before holidays.

Gates locked at closing.

### STATION HOURS:

8 am to 5 pm Sun-Thurs • 8 am to 8 pm Fri and Sat.

### CHECK-OUT: 1 PM / CHECK-IN: 2 PM • QUIET HOURS: 10 PM TO 6 AM

Late arrival (after park gate locked) access by campers with reservations – call 985-869-7275 before station closing. Campers are required to lock the entrance/exit gates behind them during the overnight hours.

### DAY USE VISITORS:

Parking/Beach Access- Proceed to STOP sign, then turn left. • Day Use Visitor Parking Allowed in Area Adjacent to East Bathhouse and Visitor Center. • Day Use permit expires at closure. Day Use visitors must exit park 15 minutes before closure.

## RIP CURRENTS

### Know your options



Rip currents are powerful currents of water moving away from shore. They can sweep even the strongest swimmer away from shore. If at all possible, swim near a lifeguard.

### IF CAUGHT IN A RIP CURRENT

- ◆ Relax, rip currents don't pull you under.
- ◆ Don't swim against the current.
- ◆ Swim out of the current, then to shore.
- ◆ If you can't escape, float or tread water.
- ◆ If you need help, yell or wave for assistance.

### SAFETY

- ◆ Know how to swim.
- ◆ Never swim alone.
- ◆ If in doubt, don't go out.
- ◆ Swim near a lifeguard.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

### ALL Louisiana State Laws/Statutes/Ordinances Strictly Enforced. Violations will result in fines and immediate eviction from park.

- Observe all directional, traffic, and warning signs.
- Speed limits are strictly enforced:
  - Park – 15 MPH
  - Campground – 5 MPH
- No parking or driving on the beach, grass or sand, or walking on the levee – RESPECT THE DELICATE ECOSYSTEM.
- ATV usage is not allowed in the park. Golf cart use is allowed by overnight guests. Passes must be purchased at the entrance station.
- Motorized boats are not allowed in the lagoon, or between the beach and rock jetty.
- CLOSED AREAS ARE OFF LIMITS, including rock structures, jetties, underneath or east of the Gulf Fishing Pier.
- No littering – dispose of trash/waste properly:
  - Paper, cloth, cans, cigarette butts, “household waste,” place trash in bags – trash receptacles.
  - Seafood debris - return to Gulf waters.
  - Fish cleaning allowed only at fish cleaning stations.
  - RV waste water – dump station near campground. Do not dump wipes, towels, utensils, cloths, etc.
- All pets must be on a leash; pets are not allowed on the beach or in park buildings. Pet waste must be picked up; bags are provided throughout the campground.
- Alcohol consumption is allowed within the limits of Louisiana law. No open containers; no underage drinking. DO NOT consume alcohol and swim. DRINK RESPONSIBLY.
- Glass containers are not allowed within the park.
- Please leave all park property in its place. Do not attach anything to the trees or any other vegetation in the park.
- Fires are permitted only in designated fire rings.
- Cooking is not allowed on wood structures.
- Relocating the picnic tables and fire rings is not allowed.
