

WELCOME TO TIMBERLAND LAKE CAMPGROUND

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to Timberland Lake Campground and thank you for your patronage. Please help do your part to have a safe visit. Rules and regulations governing the campground are outlined within and should be strictly adhered to. Any infractions of these rules may result in the eviction of the perpetrators, without a refund. Please understand the management is under no circumstances responsible for personal injury to any individual or responsible for loss or damage to any personal property.

CAMPGROUND POLICIES

These rules are not meant to impose hardship, but rather to protect our campers and conform to local and state laws. This is privately owned property and we reserve the right to select our clientele and visitors.

GENERAL RULES

All trash must be taken to containers at front gate. No bulk items!

1. Alcohol and beer permitted on your site only. Positively no heavy drinking or indecent language, no driving while intoxicated. **Drunk driving laws are in effect on private property.**
2. Pets must be leashed and on your site. No walking within the white fenced area. Do not leave pets unattended, and clean up after your pets. Campers must have a copy of license and shot record.
3. No cutting of firewood, injuring or removing of any trees, bushes, or plants dead or alive. Nothing can be hung on any trees dead or alive.
4. Quiet time is 11:00 PM - 8:00 AM.
5. Outside speakers are not permitted. Radios must not disturb neighboring campers.
6. No one is to enter a site unless invited.
7. Campers are responsible for having visitors register and pay fees at camp store. Anyone that is not registered will be charged double the fee.
8. All children must be on their campsite by 11:00 PM unless accompanied by a parent. No minors under 21 are to be left alone on the campground without a responsible adult in charge.
9. If a check is returned to us from the bank, there is a \$25.00 charge.
10. No unlicensed, unregistered or uninsured motor vehicles allowed on the campground.
11. No hunting or trapping of animals on campground.
12. No camper shall build any structure or fence.
13. All children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by a parent while using toilet facilities.
14. Vehicles parked on sites may not protrude into roadway. Cars which do not fit on site must be parked in parking lot. Car tag must be visible from road.
15. Campers are responsible for the actions and safety of their children and for damages caused by any member of their party. No camper may enter any storage area.

16. Anyone caught stealing from anywhere on the campground will be asked to leave with no refund.
17. Anyone caught defacing any property on the campground will be asked to leave with no refund.
18. Licensed motorcycles ridden by licensed drivers may be ridden to and from site only. No pleasure driving around park. Mini bikes and ATVs or any other gas powered transportation are not to be driven or started on campground. Electric golf carts may be used by licensed drivers between 8:00 AM and 11:15 PM only. Riders may not exceed maximum seat capacity. Must give store copy of insurance, sign a waiver and be inspected by store. Lights required after dark.
19. No vehicles are to be washed on campground.

SAFETY RULES

1. Drive slowly and be careful; 5 MPH speed limit.
2. Small children at beach or spillway must be with an adult.
3. No people or pets in lake.
4. No lifeguard on duty. An adult (21 or over) must accompany children under the age of 16. Everyone must wear a bathing suit (white t-shirts only). No diapers; swim diapers only.
5. While boating, everyone must wear a life jacket; no boating after dark.
6. Bikes, scooters or skateboards are not permitted in playground area or to be used after dark. Helmets are required as per New Jersey state law. Bike must be placed in bike rack.
7. Do not discharge weapons or explosives of any type. This includes firearms, air guns, archery equipment, sling shots, fireworks and paintball guns.

GOVERNMENT RULES

1. Sorry, no firewood may be brought into campground. Campfires are permitted in fireplace only and not to exceed 20 inches, by order of state fire warden. Violators can be fined \$400 for each offense. All fires must be out cold by midnight or at any time when you leave your site. No unattended fires allowed at any time. No burning garbage.
2. Absolutely no smoking on trails or in wild areas.
3. Do not wash clothes, dishes, pots, pans, or utensils in bathrooms. No washers or dryers.
4. Only non-barbed hook fishing permitted. Return all fish to the lake immediately (catch and release). Everyone 16 years and older must have a New Jersey fishing license.
5. Campground may not be used as a legal address. No children may be registered for school or attend school from the campground.
6. All campers and guests agree to be subject the New Jersey Campground Law Chapter 299, which is posted in the camp store.

Management is not responsible for lost or stolen property, or for personal injury. **Refund Policy:** No cash refunds will be given; camping certificates may be offered at the discretion of management.
