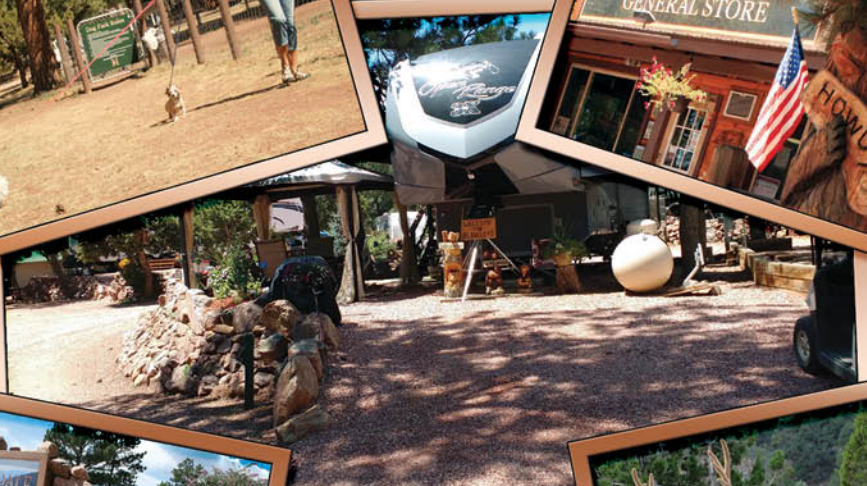

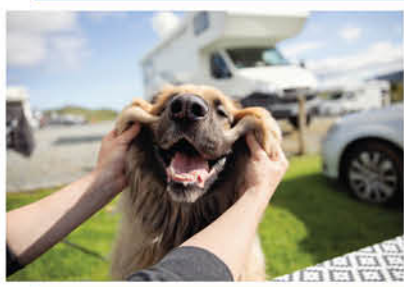

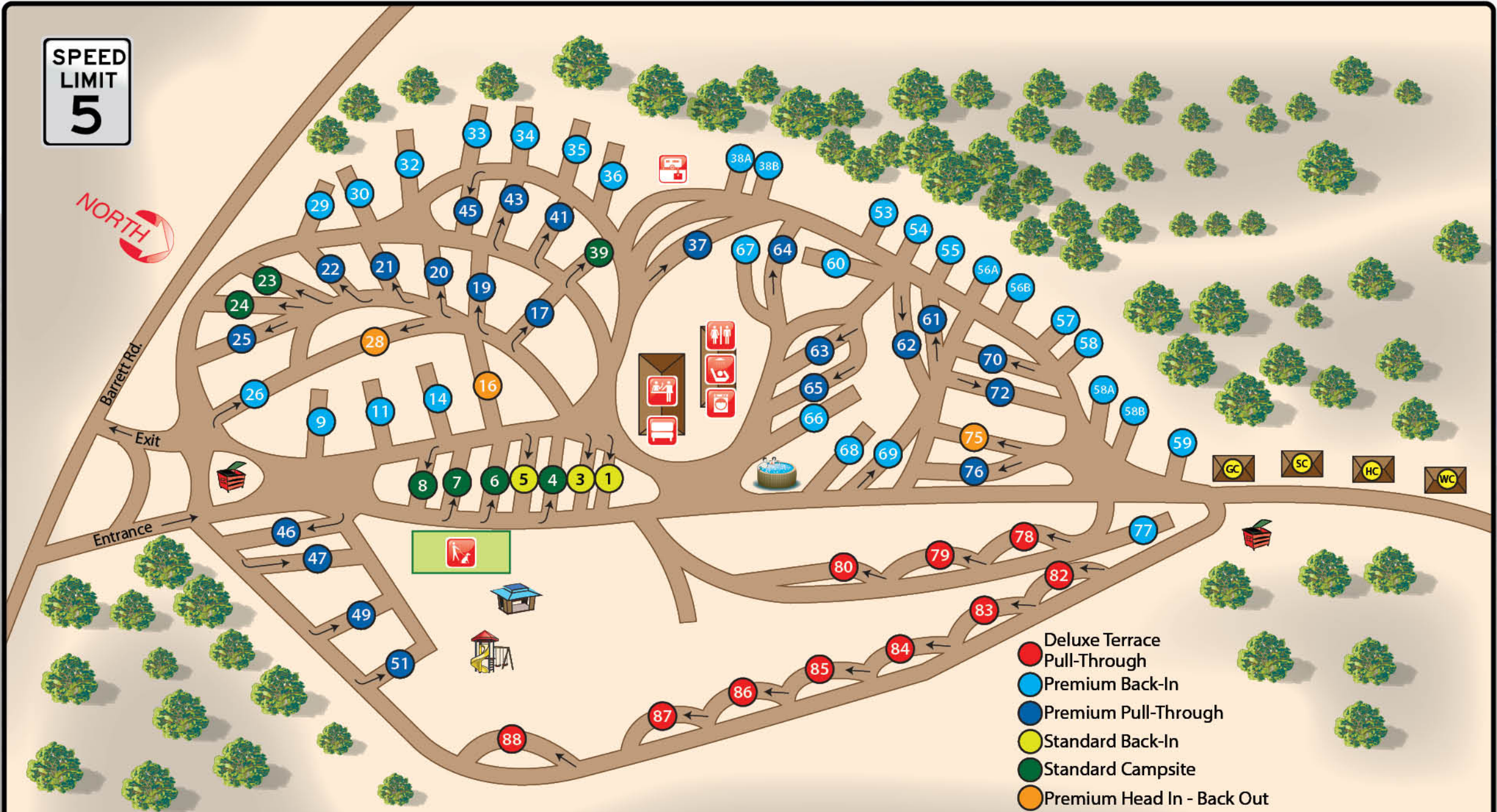

RULES, REGULATIONS & GUIDELINES



Speed Limit: The speed limit through the park is 5 miles per hour.

Smoking: We do not allow smoking in any of our buildings, this includes cabins, office, lounge, bathhouses, hot tub, laundry facilities, etc. Please dispose of cigarette and cigar waste appropriately, you can find the dumpsters both at the front and rear of the park.

Water Usage: Due to our ongoing drought conditions, no washing of vehicles is permitted. Please be mindful of water usage and help us conserve water, wherever possible.

Campfires: Campfires are only allowed in the fire rings that are provided or a personal portable propane fire ring. All campfires must be attended to at all times. Be mindful of the conditions and practice safety when it comes to your campfire. Your fire must be fully extinguished before turning in for the evening, walking away or leaving the park. Gathering firewood within the campground is strictly prohibited, however we do have wood for sale in our office, please call or text if our office is closed and you would like a bundle.

Pets: We are pet friendly to friendly pets. Be respectful of your neighbors and fellow guests by not leaving them unattended in your rig or cabin without your presence if they are known to suffer from separation anxiety. When your pets are outside, they must be kept on a leash and cleaned up after. You will find pet waste receptacles and dumpsters throughout the park to dispose of any animal waste.

Trash: There are 4 dumpsters in our campground, 2 at the front and 2 at the rear. Please deposit your trash into these receptacles before dusk and/or before you depart on your adventure. The fire rings should not be used for trash.

Hot tub: Swimsuits are required in the hot tub. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. No smoking, eating, or drinking in the hot tub. Reservations are required to use the hot tub; you can request a 1-hour time block with one of our office staff members or via text message. Please read and adhere to the posted rules.

Laundry Room: Our laundry facility is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Please do not leave your laundry unattended, and when finished remove it from the machines in a timely manner for other patrons to use the facility. Please do not hang laundry at your campsite.

Hours: While our office hours vary from season to season, our general phone hours are from 8am to 9pm. Outside of our general phone hours, we continue to monitor phone calls and text messages. In the event of an emergency, please dial 911.

Trees, Vegetation and Landscaping: Please help us protect our natural resources! Do not hang anything from, tie anything to, climb on or cut our trees. Please do not climb on our rock walls or rearrange any of our meticulously placed rocks and landscaping.

Hiking: Please be respectful of our neighbors and do not cross any boundaries onto adjacent properties. Please stick to the prepared trails and do not remove or disturb any of our precious natural resources.

Wildlife: We have a wide and varied range of local wildlife that frequently pass through or visit our campground. Please respect them and do not chase after, disturb, feed or otherwise attempt to physically interact with our friends. Please be patient with them and enjoy the natural splendor they present as they coexist with us here at the campground.

Firearms: Discharging and/or displaying firearms is prohibited. Offenders will be asked to leave immediately.

Vehicles: We require vehicles to stay on the roads and designated areas only. We do not allow off-road driving on our land without special accommodations or approval.

All-Terrain Vehicles: ATVs and Golf Carts are allowed to be used by customers if prior permission is given by the office. These vehicles must stick to the designated roads and paths and are required to abide by the 5 mile per hour speed limit.

Guests: All parties are responsible for their guests and may be held liable for their actions.

Check-In Time: RVs - 12PM, Cabins 2PM

Check-Out Time: RVs - 11AM, Cabins 11AM
