## GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

### General Campsite Guidelines:

- Quiet Hours are from 10pm-8am but please be considerate of your fellow campers at all times. This includes generators.
- Campsites are rated for 1 camping unit and 1 vehicle per site. Extra parking is available at designated areas throughout the park. Parking on the grass or empty sites is prohibited.
- Please keep your campsite clean. No trash or cigarette butts on ground or in fire pits. Garbage should be placed in dumpster by the Exit.
- Mats and Rugs should not be placed on the grass and clotheslines are not permitted.
- Sewer hoses should be properly installed with no leaks.
- No refunds will be issued due to weather conditions or early departure.

### Visitors:

- All visitors must register at the office, obtain a visitor parking pass and pay a guest fee.
- Visitors must vacate campground by 10pm or be added to reservation. Number of guests should not exceed maximum site occupancy without prior approval from Management.

### Pets:

- Friendly, non-aggressive pets are welcome.
- All pets must be on a leash and cannot be left unattended.
- Please do not let your dog bark excessively.
- Owners must clean up after their pet on site and throughout the park. Waste stations and bags are provided.
- Pets are not allowed in KOA buildings, pool area or playground.
- Dog wash facility is available for a nominal fee.
- Please visit KampK9 for off leash fun!

### Pool:

- Open Year Round 8:00AM-10:00PM.
- No lifeguard on duty.
- Children under 14 must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Proper swim wear must be worn.

- Babies must wear swim diapers.
- No running, pushing or diving allowed.
- No glass containers.
- No smoking.

### Restrooms & Laundry:

- Please help us maintain our facilities and contact the office if there is a problem that needs our attention.

### Smoking/Vaping:

- Not permitted in resort cabins, pool, playground, dog park or any other facilities.
- No cigarette butts on the ground please.
- Please no smoking or vaping.

### Vehicles:

- Drive with caution at all times to protect children, pets and wildlife.
- Speed limit is 5MPH in the park and 15MPH on entrance and exit roads.
- Golf carts must be registered, provide proof of insurance and be driven by licensed drivers only with a signed golf cart agreement.
- No ATVs are permitted to be driven in the park.
- E-bikes are permitted but must obey speed limits.

### Fishing & Wildlife:

- Fishing is catch and release only.
- Bait & tackle is available for purchase in the General Store.
- Please do NOT feed any wildlife including the ducks.
- Garbage should not be left out on site, as it attracts pests and wildlife.

### EV Charging:

- EV Charging is available at the General Store for a nominal fee. Electric Vehicles may NOT be charged on campsite electric pedestals.

### Weapons/Firearms:

- May NOT be displayed or discharged on resort property.


