



Building & Maintaining Your Campfire

1. Use designated fire pits only.
2. Keep anything combustible at least 10 feet away from the fire pit.
3. Clear the area of leaves or other debris that may catch fire.
4. Never start a fire with any flammable liquids such as gasoline or lighter fluid. Use crumpled paper or store-bought firewood covered with small sticks for burning.
5. Keep flammable items at least 10 feet away from the fire. This includes aerosol cans and pressurized containers.
6. Keep water or a fire extinguisher and a shovel, if you have one, nearby in case the fire gets out of hand.
7. Do not light fires on windy days or nights. Put the fire out at the first sign of increased winds.
8. Obey any local burn bans.
9. After lighting the fire, do not discard the match until it is cold. Douse with water to be sure.
10. Use only the amount of wood necessary to keep the fire burning under control.
11. Stack extra firewood upwind, away from the fire.
12. While the fire is burning, be sure there is a responsible adult in attendance of the fire at all times.
13. Keep children and pets away from the fire pits and never leave them unattended, even after the flames are out, as there is still a chance of a child or a pet getting burned.
14. Never allow hot dog or marshmallow roasting without adult supervision, and be sure there is plenty of space between campers while roasting.

Putting Out Your Campfire

1. Drown the fire with water. Make sure all embers, sticks, and logs are wet.
2. Stir the remains, add more water, and stir again. Be sure all burned material has been put out and cooled. Feel above the fire with the back of your hand to make sure it is out cold.
3. Before you leave the fire pit, be sure all embers, sticks and logs are completely extinguished. Never go to bed and allow the fire to burn itself out.
4. Never remove any ashes from the fire pit.
5. Never leave children or pets unattended near a fire pit even if you believe the fire is out cold.

CHECK-IN TIME: 2:00 p.m. Lodges 4:00 p.m. • CHECK-OUT TIME: 11:00 a.m.
SPEED LIMIT is 5 MPH • QUIET HOURS: 10:00 p.m. – 8:00 a.m. STRICTLY ENFORCED

- **Maximum of six people, one camping unit and one vehicle per site.**
- **WI-FI:** Free basic Wi-Fi is available, it will allow you to do web searches or send and receive email. Streaming videos/audio is not allowed and may disrupt your service for up to 24 hours.

The user name and password must all be lower case.
- **SAFETY:** For everyone's safety, please do not ride bikes, skates or skateboards down the main hill or in the front parking lot area. Riding after dark is unsafe and is not permitted.
- **TENTS:** Tents are allowed in designated areas only, please check with the front desk for available locations. A \$20 per night fee will be assessed for tents in non-designated areas.
- **GUESTS:** Guests visiting for the day must check in with the registration office; guest fees apply.
- **CHILDREN:** Parents are responsible for supervision and safety of their children at all times.
- **SITES:** Please keep your site neat and tidy. Washing or maintenance of vehicles is not permitted.
- **PETS:** Pets must be on a leash and quiet at all times. Please do not leave pets unattended while you are away from your site. For the health of others, please clean up after your pet.
- **TRASH:** Place bagged trash curbside in the morning and guest service will pick up daily before 11:00 a.m. Please do not leave trash out overnight or burn in fire rings.
- **RECYCLING:** Recycling containers are located at the Sand Shack, Dump Station and Pool Area.
- **POOL:** WARNING! NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY! Pool hours change seasonally following the store operating hours. Children under the age of 14 must have adult supervision.
- **PARKING:** Guest parking is located in the registration area. Please do not park in vacant sites.
- **FIREWORKS:** Fireworks or firearms are not permitted on this KOA Campground.
- **MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** You must have a valid driver license to operate any motorized transport in the campground.
- **SECURITY REMINDER:** Please keep vehicles and bikes locked and valuables secured. Report any suspicious behavior. KOA or Management is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- **OBJECTIONABLE CONDUCT:** Objectionable conduct, including excessive intoxication or rules violation, may result in termination of tenancy without a refund. Registered guest will be responsible for any damage to KOA property.

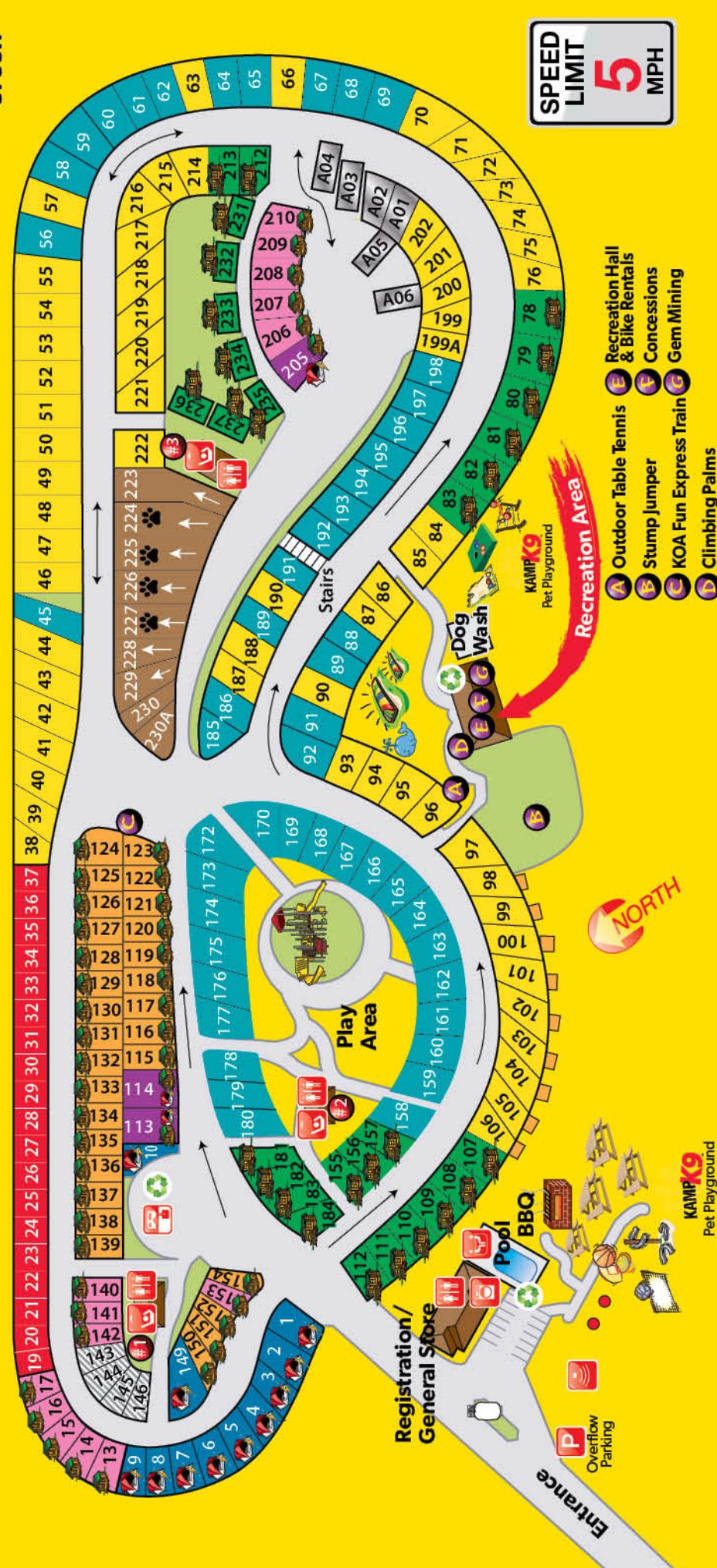
