CAMPGROUND FACILITIES

Camp Store: Featuring groceries, RV & camp supplies, firewood, ice, gifts, toys and souvenirs.

Swimming Pool: Open daily 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Under 14 years must be accompanied by an adult.

Pond: Swim at your own risk, for those who prefer to swim in a more natural setting.

River: The gentle sound will lull you to sleep, and provide daytime entertainment such as wading, swimming and tubing.

Laundry: Located in both the ladies and men's rooms and the Rec Hall.

Propane: RVs and tanks filled.

Recreation Hall: Open daily 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Located in the heart of the campground, you'll find videos games, pool tables and the site for

many of our activities. There is also a change machine.

Restrooms & Showers: Modern facilities with showers are located throughout the campground, plus one toilet facility in the river area. Showers are 25¢ per 8 mins as we are on a well system.

Dump Station: Conveniently located near the Rec Hall.

RV & Trailer Storage: Available upon request.

Cabin, Tent & Trailer Rentals: Inquire at the office for details.

Wi-Fi Available: \$1 per day per device. There are several routers throughout the campground.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Check-in 1:00 PM/ Check-out 12:00 PM (Rentals 11:00 AM) Late Departure & Early Check-in require pre-authorization and additional fee.

QUIET HOURS: 10:00 PM - 8:00 AM

- Radios turned off. Generators turned off.

- Excessive noise will not be permitted at any hour.

ALL VISITORS must register and pay the guest fee. All visitors must arrive prior to 7:00 PM and leave prior to 9:00 PM.

CAMPFIRES will be no higher than your knees, completely contained within the ring and must NOT be left unattended.

- **DO NOT MOVE FIRE RINGS** - Locations are approved by Newport Fire Department based on surrounding conditions.

- Fires must be completely extinguished before retiring for the night.

- Please **DO NOT** use fire rings as trash receptacles - we work hard to keep rodents and varmints away from our campground.

- No cutting of standing trees (live or dead) is permitted. Violators will be charged \$200 per incident.

- Firewood may be purchased at the store.

PETS are welcome as long as they are:

- Picked up after

- Leashed at all times

- Barking kept under control

- Not left unattended

- Pets are not permitted in the pool or on the pool deck. They may cool off in the river at any time or in the pond when not in use by people. Children are not to walk pets unless they are willing to clean up after them. Please use leashes no longer than 6ft.

CHILDREN:

- Parents are responsible for supervision and actions of their children

- Must be on their own site by 10:00 PM.

- Under 14 years old must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older) while swimming in the pool, pond or river.

- Under 6 years old must be accompanied by an adult in the bathroom, rec. hall and store.

Do not deface or mutilate campground property. Vandalism is cause for immediate eviction and/or prosecution.

DRINK RESPONSIBLY - No alcoholic beverages are permitted off camp site. Drunk and disorderly behavior is cause for eviction.

If you move picnic tables - please return them to the sites.

Waste water may not be discharged onto the ground. A Dump Station is available to all campers.

Campground **SPEED LIMIT** is 5 MPH. You are supposed to feel like you are going ridiculously slow!

All sites must be kept clean and orderly. Trash left will be subject to cleaning fee.

NO FIREWORKS or WEAPONS of any form are allowed: firearms, air guns, sling shots, bow and arrow, etc.

DO NOT WASH: Dishes, clothes or persons at water outlets - use dishwashing station.

DO NOT WASH: Cars, RVs or trailers at campground.

No off road vehicles of any kind may be ridden in the campground.

No chainsaws allowed.

BICYCLES: No riding after dark. Helmets required for all riders under 16 years old.


No soliciting without permission from the management.

Septic tank rinsing devices such as tank sprayers, wands etc. are not to be connected to the water system unless they are used at the Dump Station. Protect our drinking water system.

No out of state wood - Per N.H. State Law.

No plastic bags in recycling dumpster. Loose items only.

No rule covering your actions? Please note that we at the Crow's Nest Campground work very hard to promote a safe, friendly, family environment. We ask that your actions fit into that accordingly.

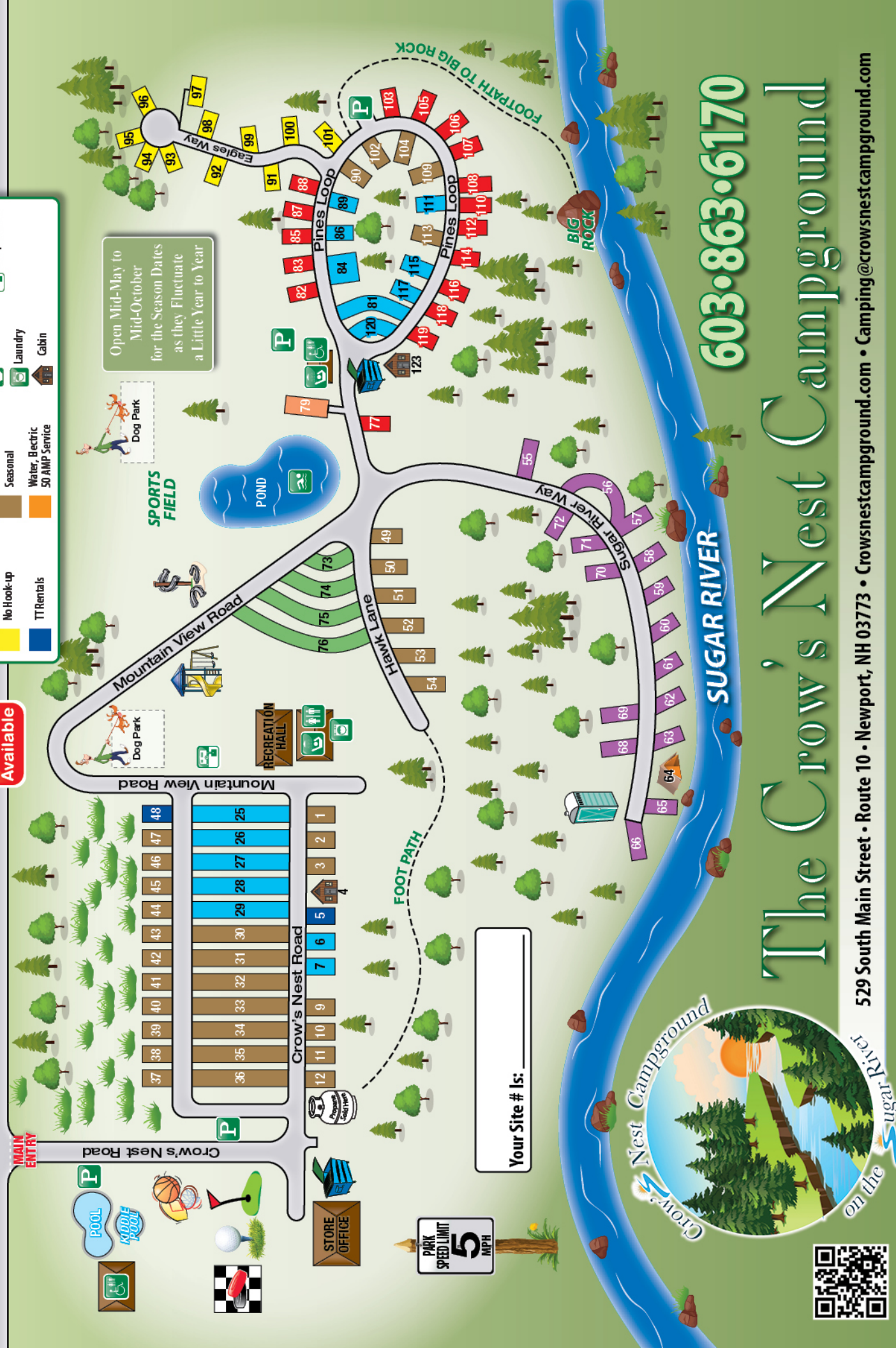
