Please Follow these Park Regulations in order to Preserve and Protect the Park Environment.

PRESERVE THE HABITAT
 Don't remove plants, nuts and berries; animals depend upon them for their food supply. Leave wildflowers for others to enjoy. Trees and shrubs, even when deadwood, provide shelter for animals and return humus to enrich the soil. Please ask the Park Manager or Park Ranger before collecting firewood for campfires. (Park Regulation 725:30-4-1)

Proper use of campfires; restrictions. (Park Regulation 725:30-4-7)

Fireworks are prohibited. (Park Regulation 725:30-4-21)

Keep all pets on a leash. (Park Regulation 725:30-4-9[2])

Don't dump waste, sewage or grey water on the ground. Use appropriate disposal facilities. (Park Regulation 725:30-4-8[5])

Don't bring any glass containers or glass material in a designated swimming area. (Park Regulation 725:30-4-26)
