Facility Hours

- **Office & Camp Store:** Hours vary, our friendly team will give you the current schedule upon arrival!
- **Restrooms & Showers:** Open 24 hours a day for your convenience.
- **Laundry Room:** Open 24 hours a day (a change machine is located inside).
- **Pool & Hot Tub:** Open Mid-June through Mid-September from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM (*subject to change based on weather conditions*).
- **Quiet Hours:** 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. Thank you for helping us keep the evenings peaceful!

On-Site Dining

Enjoy freshly made meals from our campground kitchen during peak season!

- **Breakfast & Lunch:** Quick and delicious grab-and-go options are available at the coffee bar.
- **Dinner:** Order online or right at the kitchen, and we will happily deliver it directly to your site for free!

Wildlife & Safety First

Because we share this beautiful landscape with amazing local wildlife, keeping a clean camp is essential for everyone's safety.

- **Food Storage:** Please keep all food, coolers, and trash stored securely inside your vehicle or camper. Unattended coolers are subject to confiscation and fines.
- **Grills:** Please ensure it is kept clean and free of leftover food and utensils. We recommend storing it when not in use.
- **Do Not Feed Wildlife:** Please admire all wildlife from a safe distance, and never offer them food.

Weather & Environmental Care

- **Awnings:** This beautiful region is known for sudden, high winds! We highly recommend rolling your awnings in whenever you leave your site unattended.

- **Campfires:** To protect our beautiful forests from wildfires, please keep fires contained strictly within designated fire pits, and completely extinguish all embers before turning in for the night. Please check with the front desk to ensure there is no current fire ban.
- **Trash Disposal:** Help us keep the campground beautiful! Please place all trash into our designated dumpsters and do not leave trash sitting out. Large, bulky items cannot be left at the dumpsters and must be taken with you. Please note we do not offer recycling on-site, and burning trash in fire pits is strictly prohibited.

Site Guidelines & Courtesy

- **Being a Good Neighbor:** To let everyone enjoy our spectacular night skies, please turn off all outside lights by 10:00 PM. Please refrain from walking through occupied sites, and avoid letting vehicles or motorcycles idle for extended periods. Generators are not permitted.
- **Parking:** Sites are designed for one vehicle. To keep our park looking its best, please do not park on the grass at RV sites. Additional parking passes can be purchased at the main office.
- **Mats & Rugs:** To protect the grass for future campers, mats and rugs are not allowed on lawns.
- **Tents:** Tents are permitted exclusively on designated tent sites and RV sites equipped with tent pads.
- **Vehicle Washing & EV Charging:** To conserve local resources, vehicle washing and EV charging of any kind (including the use of charging converters) are strictly prohibited on the campground properties.

Pet Guidelines

We love our furry campers! To keep all pets and guests happy:

- **Leashes & Play:** Pets must be on a leash at all times unless they are playing inside our designated KampK9® park.
- **Clean Up:** Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets everywhere on the property, including inside the dog park. Failure to clean up will result in a \$50 fee.
- **Restricted Areas:** For health and safety, pets are not allowed in the restrooms, laundry room, or pool area (certified service animals are always welcome).
- **Pet Sitting:** Need to explore pet-free for the day? Local pet sitting and kennel information is available at the front desk!
