GUIDELINES FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY & ENJOYMENT

Grass: No parking on grass. No rugs on grass. No tents.

Campsites are assigned so we don't have two campers parked in the same spot. Only 1 RV per site.

Campsites are to be kept clean. All litter, trash and cigarette butts are to be placed in the dumpster.

Car/RV Washing: Do not wash cars or RVs on your site. We provide a washing area by the office. Monthly residents - RV washing permitted on site once a month.

Campfires: Above-ground fire pits only. Firewood is available in the store. Fire pits available.

Clotheslines: Not allowed on site. Please do not string lines from trees or awnings.

NO FIREARMS are to be discharged in the park.

NO FIREWORKS in the park.

Golf cars, scooters and any other motorized vehicle powered by gas, electric or propane **MUST** have a driver with a valid driver's license driving and **MUST** have liability insurance.

ANY TIME a camper's behavior is destructive or disturbing, their "party" will be escorted off the campground without a refund. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. All rules subject to change at owner's discretion.

Fireworks are prohibited in campground.

Sewer connectors required on all sites per state law.

Please read the campfire fire safety rules located at the fire pit clean out.

PET POLICIES

Pets are another responsibility that their owner(s) have voluntarily added to their lives... Not to someone else's! **NO PET FENCING.**

Pets are to be on a 6' (six foot) leash when out of their owner's unit and in visual observation. **No dog is to be left tied up and unattended outside.**

Pets are not allowed in any building, the playground, flower beds or other campsites. (Service dogs are the exception.)

Pets do not like being left alone and will share this feeling with all their neighbors. Please keep your pet with you.

Aggressive dogs of any breed are not welcome at any KOA. If your dog exhibits behavior that is protective and unfriendly to other dogs and strangers, the owner/manager will ask you to please find other camping accommodations.

It is the owner's job to clean up after ALL of their pets' "messes." **PLEASE SCOOP THE POOP THROUGHOUT THE PARK.**
