

# Policies for Your Comfort and Protection

The Pumpkin Patch RV Resort wants you to have an enjoyable visit. Our policies are designed to promote a relaxed and enjoyable environment for all who are staying with us.

- 🍂 **Check-in time is 1:00 PM** (when possible).
- 🍂 **Check-out time is 11:00 AM.**
- 🍂 **Rates** are based on 4 people and 2 pets (any additional \$2.00 each per day).
- 🍂 **Vehicles:** Only one (1) additional vehicle per campsite. All other vehicles must obtain a car pass. Mini-bikes and dirt bikes are prohibited. Scooters or other ATVs must receive prior approval.
- 🍂 **All visitors** must stop at the office each time in. Visitors must park vehicles in the visitor's parking area.
- 🍂 **Quiet time** is 10:00 PM (11:00 PM Friday and Saturday) to 7:00 AM. During this time, there should be no loud radios, TVs or other loud noises that can disturb other campers.
- 🍂 **Speed limit** on all roads in the Resort is **5 mph maximum speed at all times.**
- 🍂 **Wastewater** (gray or black) is not permitted on the ground. Sewer donuts must be used (Maine State Law).
- 🍂 **Washing of RVs incurs a \$10.00 fee, autos on site \$5.00.** Water and electricity are natural resources. Please use them wisely.
- 🍂 **No power splitters** are allowed.
- 🍂 **Picnic Table:** One (1) per site.
- 🍂 **No Grills on Picnic Tables, Please.**
- 🍂 **Satellite dishes** may be put on your site in a neat setting. Connecting cables should be kept to a minimum due to mowing. Dish should be set up on the pad. We are not responsible for cut cables.
- 🍂 **Trash** should be placed in a Dumpster at all times. Please **do not** leave it outside on your site.
- 🍂 **Alcohol** must be confined to your campsite.
- 🍂 **Cigarettes:** Campers enjoy the outdoors and enjoy its beauty. Please discard butts properly. All buildings are smoke free.
- 🍂 **Mail:** You may have your mail sent to the Resort by using the address on the other side of this Guest Services Guide.
- 🍂 **Clotheslines:** Clotheslines are not permitted to be tied by a rope from trees; to your RV, awning, or to freestanding poles. A temporary clothesline mounted to your RV is acceptable.
- 🍂 **Small children** must be under parental supervision at all times.
- 🍂 **All pets must be** kept on a leash. Please clean up after them and dispose of their waste **only in the Doggie Dumpster!** Do not leave dog droppings along the roadways. Please, no barking dogs!
- 🍂 **Laundry:** Washers cost \$2 to use for 30 minutes, and Dryers \$2 to use for 45 minutes. Change in quarters is available at the office.
- 🍂 **Camp at your own risk.** The management assumes no responsibility for property loss or damages.
- 🍂 **No refunds after check-in.**


