This southwest Georgia park is on beautiful Lake Seminole, a 37,500-acre reservoir known for excellent sport fishing and boating. The lake is shallow, but natural lime sink ponds have left areas of cool, clear water with a variety of fish. The threatened gopher tortoise, Georgia's state reptile, makes its

home along a 2.2-mile nature trail designed to interpret the wiregrass community habitat. The park is located near one of Georgia's largest wildlife management areas, providing great duck and deer hunting. 14 Cottages and many campsites are situated on the water's edge, offering excellent lake views.

Activities and Facilities
Camping - The camping area offers 50 tent and RV sites, all with water and electrical hook-ups, picnic tables and grills. Comfort station has hot showers, flush toilets, electrical outlets, washer and dryer. One sanitary disposal station is in the campground.
Cottages - The park provides 14 cottages fully equipped with stove, refrigerator, cooking and serving utensils, towels and linens. Each cottage has two bedrooms and two bathrooms and is heated and air conditioned. 1, 2, 13 and 14 have electric fireplaces. Visitors will enjoy the screened porches overlooking the lake. Four pet-friendly cottages (3, 4, 5, 6) are available with advance reservations only. Dish Network and TV are provided.

Picnicking - The park contains several picnic sites and four covered shelters. Shelters are reservable and are available on a first-come, first-served basis if not reserved. Please use designated areas only.
Group Shelter - A large enclosed shelter can be rented for family reunions and other large groups. Features include a range, refrigerator, grill, sink, restrooms, tables and chairs for 200. The building is heated for winter use and air conditioned for summer use.
Fishing - Park waters are open for legal fishing throughout the year. Persons age 16 or older must have a valid resident/non-resident fishing license. Bank fishermen not registered as overnight guests must be off the premises no later than 10:00 p.m. A fishing dock and boat launching ramp are provided.

Boating - Private boats are permitted on park waters without horsepower restrictions. Water skiing is permitted. All boaters must check with the park office for rules and boating hours. All boats must comply with the Georgia Boating Safety Law.
Swimming - Swimming and inflatable floats are permitted at the beach. No lifeguards are on duty; swim at your own risk.
Gift Shop - Located in the park office.
Miniature golf plus canoe, kayak and paddle boards.
All vehicles and camping equipment must park on space provided.

Go through one traffic light, over railroad tracks, then turn left at the first street. Go one block to a stop sign, turn right and follow the blue signs to Donalsonville Hospital.

Campground Rules
 All campers must register prior to occupying any campsite unless instructed otherwise by staff. Registration is required by 10:00 a.m. following late arrival. Check-out time is 12:00 p.m. Check-in time is 1:00 p.m.
 1. Campers may register only if they have all camping equipment with them ready to set up. Campsites cannot be held for any reason. **Campsites must be occupied by an adult overnight. Unattended equipment is subject to removal and fees will be forfeited.**
 2. Tents are not permitted to be set up behind or between campsites. All equipment must be set up on the gravel or tent pads.
 3. Site occupancy limits are **strictly enforced**. If a campsite is deemed to be over-occupied, you will be asked to remove vehicles, equipment and/or people. Campsite occupancy is limited to one immediate family or six persons per campsite. No doubling up on campsites. When the campground is full, no additional units are permitted. One of the following groups of camping rigs is allowed, provided the campsite will accommodate it: Campsites may not exceed one (1) motorhome, fifth-wheel, travel trailer, pick-up truck with mounted camper or pop-up and one (1) tent. Two (2) tents may occupy one (1) site. Only one (1) additional vehicle is allowed. In addition to the above, golf carts are allowed with an additional park pass. One boat trailer per site is authorized, provided the site is large enough.
 4. Campfires are to be built only in established fire pits and must be completely extinguished prior to retiring for the evening. Campfires should be attended to continuously.
 5. **Pets are allowed on a leash no longer than six feet.** Pets must be attended by their owners at all times or owners may be asked to leave the park.
 6. Gray water must be dumped in the RV dump station. **No gray water may be dumped in the campsite or immediate area.**
 7. No person under the age of 16 years shall operate or be a passenger on a bicycle unless he/she is wearing a helmet.
 8. Using roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, roller skis, coasting vehicles, or similar devices is prohibited, except in designated areas.

All noise-making devices (TVs, radios, musical instruments) should be kept at very low levels so not to disturb others.
 Quiet hours begin at 10:00 p.m. No traffic permitted after 10:00 p.m. Park gates are locked at 10:00 p.m. All visitors must leave the park prior to 9:45 p.m., and all group gatherings must terminate by 9:45 p.m.
