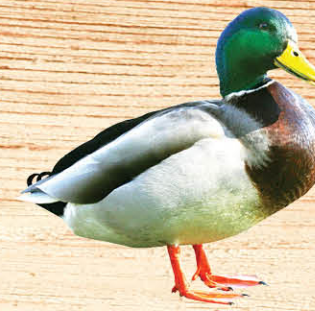

## Park Information

**Entrance Station Hours:** Sunday thru Thursday 8:00 AM to 5:30 PM / Friday & Saturday 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM  
**Park Gates:** 7:00 AM to 9:00 PM - Sunday to Thursday. 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM on Friday, Saturday and the day before a holiday. Park gates are here for visitors' safety and park security. Overnight guests are required to lock the gate upon leaving and entering the park after hours.

**Speed Limit** is 15 MPH throughout the park; radar enforced, 5 MPH at gate entrance.

**Use Of Personal Golf Carts** on State Park Property – \$10/cart per day; \$100 annual permit available. Proof of cart insurance required; must be operated by a licensed driver.

**Trash:** All trash must be deposited in the trash containers provided throughout the park.

**Fires:** Campfires are permitted at each campsite in the fire ring provided.

**Pets:** Pets must be kept on a six foot leash or crated and may not be left unattended in the park. Pets are not allowed inside any park buildings except for pet-friendly designated cabins.

**Quiet Hours:** 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

**Camper's under 21** must be accompanied by an adult.

**Length of stay** is limited to 14 nights.

**Check-in time** is 3:00 PM for cabins, group camp.

**Check-in time** is 2:00 PM for campsites.

**Check-out time** is 11:00 AM for cabins, group camp.

**Check-out time** is 1:00 PM for campsites.

**Boating:** A boat launch is available for canoes, flat bottom boats, max 14 foot, with small motors and pirogues. Large boats and jet skis are not allowed to launch from park.

**Canoes:** Canoes can be rented at the park. Contact park staff for more information.

**Camping:** The park has two camping areas, improved and unimproved. The 30 improved RV sites have electrical and water and sewer hookups. The 20 unimproved tent sites provide water and a 12' by 12' sand tent pad. All sites have a paved parking pad, picnic table, fire ring, grill and lantern post. A comfort station is provided for campers and includes restrooms, showers, vending machines and laundromat. Each camping area has two handicap-accessible sites.

**Cabins/Group Camp:** The park has 14 two-bedroom cabins that sleep up to eight each and a group camp that sleeps up to 52. The group camp and two cabins are handicap-accessible.

**Fishing:** Persons 18 years of age or older must have a valid Louisiana fishing license.

**Nature Trails & Boardwalks:** Three elevated boardwalks, one gravel-lined hiking trail, and one unimproved nature trail provide five miles of trailways to explore. No bikes, skateboards, scooters, rollerblades, or skates are allowed on the boardwalks or ramps within the park.

**Nature Programs:** Check in at the Nature Center for the schedule of nature programs offered during your stay. The Nature Center is open from 9 AM to 5 PM Tuesday-Saturday (closed Sunday & Monday). Call 225-294-2218 for more information.

**Picnicking:** Picnic tables are located outside of the Nature Center and under the two picnic shelters near the Gum/Cypress Swamp pavilion. Picnic shelters can be rented for day use. The covered pavilions at each trailhead are available at no charge on a first come first served basis when nature programs are not scheduled, however can be reserved for a fee.

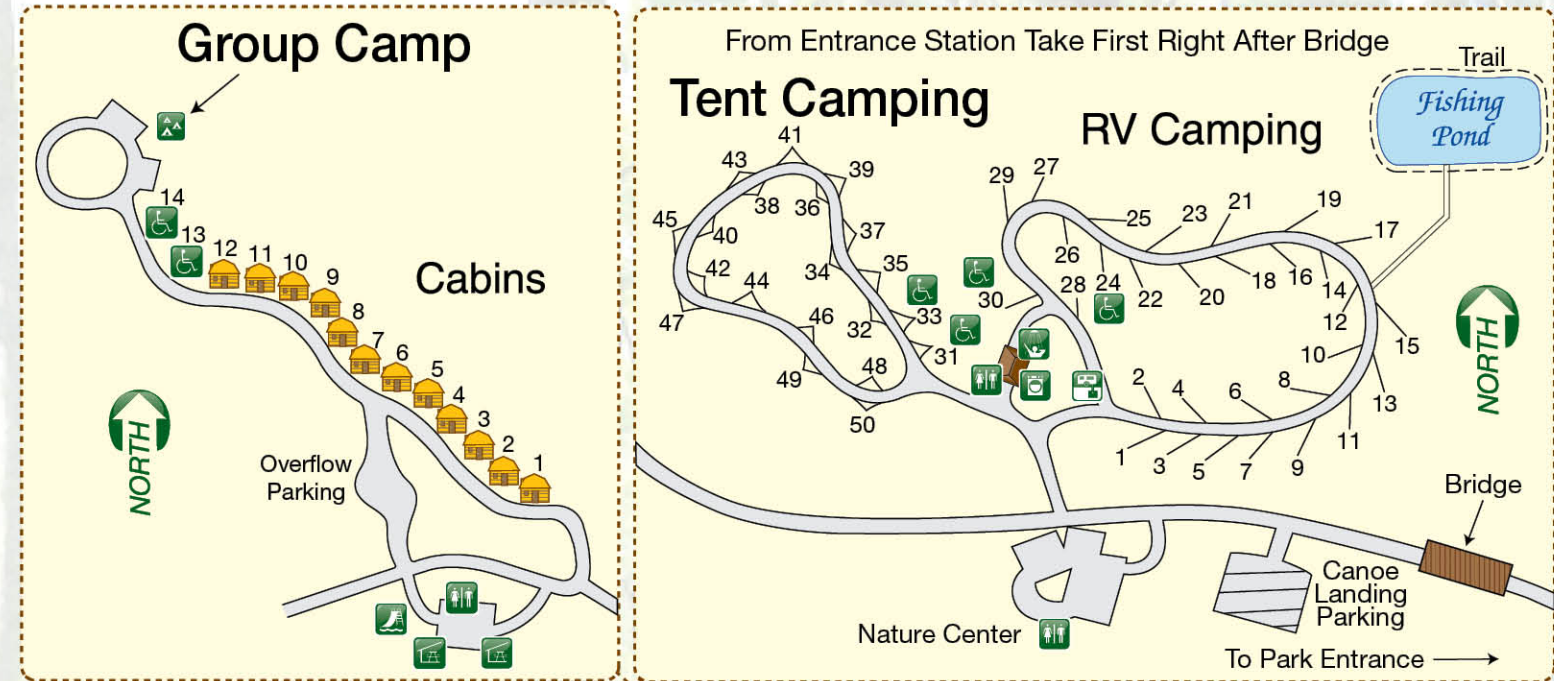
