Activities and Facilities

Cottages — Four two-bedroom cottages, the three-bedroom Burnham Cottage and the one-bedroom Hawk's Nest Cottage are fully equipped with kitchen supplies and bed/bath linens. The Burnham Cottage features a master bedroom with fireplace and a rocking chair porch. Dogs (2 dog max) are allowed only in dog-friendly cottages (#1 and #4). Additional dog fees are required.

Camping — All sites feature water and electric hookups, picnic tables and grills. A comfort station with hot showers, laundry facilities and a playground are centrally located. Pets are allowed on a 6-foot leash.

Heritage Farm — This living history farmstead includes a blacksmith shop, tobacco barn, corn crib and many other buildings.

Pioneer Campground — Large groups such as Scouts can use these two camping areas that each have water, a privy, tables, lean-to-shelter, and fire ring with a grill.

Group Shelter — An enclosed shelter (capacity 127) is available for reunions, company picnics, weddings and other events. A BBQ shelter is located behind this facility.

Group Lodge — Guest lodge can accommodate 40 guests and includes hot showers, a kitchen and dining area. Linens are not provided.

Picnicking — Seven open-air picnic shelters may be reserved for a fee or are available on a first-come basis. Numerous picnic tables and grills are located throughout the park.

Fishing — The Seventeen Mile River and a four-acre lake are open for fishing. Anglers 16 and older must have a valid resident/non-resident fishing license.

Horseback Riding — Visitors may bring their own horses to explore 14 miles of trails. Fee charged.

Hiking — Four miles of trails meander through pitcher plant bogs, a wiregrass community and wetlands. Visitors may see gopher tortoises, indigo snakes, pileated woodpeckers, armadillos, deer, fox and alligators.

ParkPass - A parking fee is required at all state parks, and proceeds go toward park maintenance. Frequent visitors can save money with an Annual ParkPass. The daily ParkPass is valid at all state parks visited that day.



One of southern Georgia's "best kept secrets," this park is known for interpretation of agricultural history at its Heritage Farm with log cabins, a corn crib, tobacco barn, cane mill, barnyard animals and other exhibits. Seventeen Mile River winds through a cypress swamp where the park hosts rare and endangered plants. The threatened indigo snake and gopher tortoise make their homes in this wiregrass community. Overnight accommodations include camping, cottages and the Burnham Cottage, an elegantly decorated 19th century cabin perfect for romantic getaways. The park was donated to the state by a group of Coffee County citizens in 1970 and is named after General John Coffee, a planter, U.S. Congressman and military leader.
